The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

The representative of the project proponent Sri T. Lazar and Sri Lakshmi kanth Reddy of M/s. Vison Labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier, they obtained Building permit order dt. 13.11.2020 from GHMC for Commercial Building (3C + G + 4 Floors) with Builtup area of 18262.7 Sq.m.

Now, the present proposal is for expansion of EC with Total Builtup area of 36,196.55 Sq.m. for construction of Residential Apartments. The proponent also informed that the project is under excavation stage. Hence, it was requested to issue Expansion of EC.

The details of project, after proposed expansion is as follows:

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 4903.87 Sq.m., Net plot area is 4699.31 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 475.00 Sq.m. (10.11%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 36,196.55 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 70 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 2B + S + 12 Floors + Terrace.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 9,634.59 Sq.m., (36.27% against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 99.0 Cores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 149.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 40.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Venugopal and Sri Kushal Bodhankar of M/s. KKB Envirocare Consultants Pvt.Ltd., attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 15.11.2017 for Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (API) Intermediates manufacturing unit.

Now, the proponent informed that due to change in market demand they proposed few modifications w.r.t Products and coal fired boiler as following:

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC.

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| Agenda Item No. 03 | Software Research and Development facility by M/s. Microsoft India (R & D) Private Limited, Sy. No. 210/1 and 203/P, Manikonda Jagir, Gachibowli, Rajendranagar (M), Rangareddy District. - Environmental Clearance Violation-Reg. |

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raghavendra and Sri Kushal Bodhankar of M/s. KKB Envirocare Consultants Pvt. Ltd., attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed that Ac. 54.08 of land was allotted by APIIC to them on 05.09.2003 and subsequently, they started construction in the year 2003 and completed the Building-1 in 2005 & Building-2 in 2006 before the EIA Notification, 2006. They have obtained CFO for Building-1 & Building -2 from APPCB. It was also informed that construction for Building-3 & MLCP was started in August, 2006 and completed in the year 2008. They have also obtained occupancy certificate for the same from APIIC on 17.04.2008. However, it was informed that as no approvals for Building-3 & MLCP were obtained unlike Building-1 & Building-2, they have submitted the application as a violation case. Further, it is noted that technical approval of building permissions for Building-3 & MLCP were issued vide lrs. dt.26.03.2008 by the Cyberabad Development Authority.

The SEAC noted that the present project is for Building-3 & MLCP Construction project in a total plot Area of Ac.9.5 with total builtup area of 92,917.0 Sq.m. But, it was observed that the proponent started construction of the project in August, 2006 without obtaining prior EC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs under violation on 23.12.2019 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 38,445.14 Sq.m. (9.5 Acres), Out of which green area is 2.47 Acres (26%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 92,917 Sq.m. The project consists of Building-3 & Multi Level Car Parking (MLCP). The no. of floors proposed for Building-3 are (Lower Ground Floor + Ground Floor + 8 Floors + Terrace) and for MLCP (6 Levels + Terrace).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 37,176 Sq.m., (66.69% against required 66%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 245.88 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 585.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 149.0 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that it is a project under violation and hence considered the proposal as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. processing of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. As per the guidelines of the SEIAA for construction projects involving violation, the rationalized project cost for total built up area of 92,917.0 Sq.m. is Rs.92.917 Crores.

The amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan is worked out to be Rs. 92,92,000/- and the details are as following:

The SEIAA addressed a letter to the State Government to take action against the project proponent under the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and further no consent to operate to be issued till the project is granted EC. But, the SEAC observed that the proponent has not provided any evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raghuram Reddy and Sri Chandrashekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 12,645.73 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 1306.31 Sq.m. (10.33%)

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It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 64,236.18 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 420 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are C + S + 10 Upper Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 15,796.59 Sq.m., (32.61% against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 65.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 98.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 16.5 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative Sri Chandrashekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad, attended before the SEAC and informed that there are few modifications in the proposal after uploading documents and hence they are withdrawing the proposal.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Chandankumar and Sri Chandrashekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 27.08.2008 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Peddapuram exists at a distance 1.0 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Field channel exists at 0.58 km (S) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 20,424 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 26 years @ 18,796 m³/annum.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.56 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.62 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 12.05.2022 of ADMG, Peddapalli District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2008-09 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2008-09 to 2021-22.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.13.06.2022 issued by Grama Panchayath, Peddapur Village, Julapally Mandal, Peddapally District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 40,000/- for repairing of the roads and other developmental activities.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

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| Agenda Item No. 07 | 1.00 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Project of M/s. Venkateshwara Metal Suppliers, Survey No. 926, Peddapur Village, Julapally Mandal, Peddapally District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg. |
| Proposal No. | SIA/TG/MIN/280107/2022 (EC) |

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Chandankumar and Sri Chandrashekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 15.10.2012 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Peddapuram exists at a distance 0.9 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Field channel exists at 0.58 km (S) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 29,028 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 10 years @ 25,488 m³/annum.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.39 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.94 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 12.05.2022 of ADMG, Peddapalli District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2012-13 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2014-15 to 2021-22 except during 2012-13 & 2013-14.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.13.06.2022 issued by Grama Panchayath, Peddapur Village, Julapally Mandal, Peddapally District stating that the proponent has donated material of worth Rs. 1,20,000/- for repairing of the roads and other devepmental works.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

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| Agenda Item No. 08 | 2.00 Ha. Road Metal & Building Stone of M/s. Sri Venkata Sai Stone Crushers, Sy. No. 248/AA/1, Ananthasagar (V), Chinnakodur (M), Siddipet District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg. |
| Proposal No. | SIA/TG/MIN/76083/2022 (EC) |

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Srinivas and Sri Chandrashekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) dt.03.06.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 28.11.2008 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years. Subsequently, it was extended on 30.10.2018 for a period of 5 years from 28.11.2018 to 27.11.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village Mallaram (V) exists at a distance 0.98 km from the proposed site; nearest water body exists at 0.13 km (WNW) from the boundary of the site.

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It is proposed to mine 84,660.0 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 20 years (@ 50,000 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 6.49 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.54 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 27.12.2021 of ADMG, Siddipet District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 28.11.2018 to 25.09.2021. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during 28.11.2018 to 25.09.2021.

The proponent submitted a copy of certificate dt. 20.01.2020 of the Sarpanch, Mallaram (V), Chinnakodur (M), Siddipet District informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 2,00,000/- for development of Village i.e., supplied soil for Graveyard, Road repair, Village Nursery and other activities.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is Low. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan is worked out to be Rs. 1,00,000/- and the details are as following:

The SEAC noted from the earlier production details that dispatch particulars were issued till 25.09.2021. But for calculation of penalty as per SOP w.r.t violation cases, it is to be considered upto date of filing of application along with EIA/EMP report i.e., 30.06.2022. The SEAC also noted that the SEIAA addressed a letter to the State Government to take action against the project proponent under the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and further no consent to operate to be issued till the project is granted EC. But, the SEAC observed that the proponent has not provided any evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit details of earlier production/dispatch particulars upto 30.06.2022 certified by the Mining Department and also to submit evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) on 07.06.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The SEAC noted that 4th renewal of quarry lease was granted by the Mining Dept., vide Procds. dt. 15.07.2008 that quarry lease was in favour of the proponent for a further period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that the project is for Black Granite Mine with present Mine Lease Area of 4.9 Ha. (after part surrender of quarry lease for 0.66 Ha. from existing quarry lease of 5.5 Ha., as per Procds. dt. 30.01.2019 of the DMG: Hyderabad) which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village Peddapuram (V) exists at a distance 0.5 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Ramappa Cheruvu exists at 0.25 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 37,100.40 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 14 years (@ 31,084.20 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 80.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 10.04 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.95 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 18.05.2022 of ADMG, Hanmakonda District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2008-09 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during 2008-09 to 2021-22.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is Low. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan is worked out to be Rs. 9,80,000/- and the details are as following:

The SEAC noted from the earlier production details that dispatch particulars were issued vide lr. dt. 18.05.2022. But for calculation of penalty as per SOP w.r.t violation cases, it is to be considered upto date of filing of application along with EIA/EMP report i.e., 01.07.2022. The SEAC also noted that the SEIAA addressed a letter to the State Government to take action against the project proponent under the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and further no consent to operate to be issued till the project is granted EC. But, the SEAC observed that the proponent has not provided any evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit details of earlier production/dispatch particulars upto 01.07.2022 certified by the Mining Department and also to submit evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation. The SEAC also informed the proponent to submit details of CSR activities undertaken by the proponent along with evidence for the same.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

Now, the proponent submitted reply and informed that they are submitting copies of documents from Dharani Portal w.r.t. land in Sy. No. 174 of Yenkaṭhala (V) stating that the said land in Sy. No. 174 of Yenkaṭhala (V) is allotted for agricultural purpose and not for rehabilitation purpose. It was informed that if land is allotted for habitation, it will be displayed as “నివాసం” under the Nature of land / Classification of Land in Dharani Portal. But, it is not displayed as నివాసం.

Hence, the distance of land allocated to the weaker sections does not apply because of the allocated land is not for the habitation. The SEAC examined the documents and observed that the nearest human habitation is located at a distance of 1.9km from the mine lease area.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.


