The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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<b>Agenda Item No. 01</b>	<b>Residential Apartments Construction Project by Sri. M. Srinivas and Others, Survey Nos. 515, 516, 517, 518, Kukatpally, Medchal- Malkajgiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.</b>
<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/INFRA2/411220/2022 (EC)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Sampath Kumar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 9,678.1 Sq.m. and Net plot area is 6,758.6 Sq.m., out of which green area is 746.0 Sq.m. (11.0 %).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 42,685.6 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 215 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Single Block (B + 3S + 11 upper floors) including Amenities.

It is also noted that parking area to be provided is 13,187.5 Sqm. (44.7 % against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.50.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.118.1 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 3.8 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.14.8 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.35.3 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/MIN/411036/2022 (EC)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri K.Satyanarayana and Sri M. Venkatesham of M/s. Global Enviro labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 22.07.2003 in favour of Sri Syed Fazil for a period of 20 years i.e upto 21.07.2023. Later, the lease was transferred on 20.07.2017 in favour of the proponent for unexpired period i.e., upto 21.07.2023. Subsequently, renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 02.05.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.13 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Gudur (V) exists at a distance 1.3 km; nearest water body i.e water pond & Yelimineti Vagu exists at a distance of 0.5 km; Nearest RFs are Gumadavelli RF & Patelgiri RF exists at 3.6 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 33,977.70 TPA of Quartz and 33,321.60 TPA of Feldspar and the life of mine is reported as 83 years for Quartz and 42 years for Feldspar.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 8.70 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.07 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 09.11.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2003-04 to 2022-23 (upto 08.11.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued for Feldspar during the period 2003-04; 2004-05 to 2006-07; 2013-14 to 2022-2023 (upto 08.11.2022) and for Quartz during the period 2004-05 & from 2013-14 to 2022-23 (upto 08.11.2022) and Nil during the period 2007-08 to 2012-13 for Feldspar and Nil during 2005-06 to 2012-13 for Quartz.

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The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt. 29.10.2022 issued by the Head Master (FAC), ZPHS (Boys), Kandukur Mandal, Rangareddy District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 40,000/- for various needs of the students of the school.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Rakesh Saboo; and Sri P.V. Raju of M/s. Pridhivi Enviro Tech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- M/s. Radha Smelters Ltd., established the industry in the year 2008 and started operations in 2008. The unit is involved in manufacturing MS Billets/ Ingots and TMT Bars.
- The unit is operating with valid consents of the Board. The current CFO of the Board is valid up to 31st July 2023.
- The unit obtained environmental Clearance for their expansion activity from SEIAA with vide order dated 26.04.2018 and subsequently obtained amendment of existing EC with vide dated 27.03.2021 to M/s. Radha Smelters Ltd.,
- The unit obtained name change for Environmental Clearance from SEIAA vide order dated 22.06.2021 from M/s. Radha Smelters Ltd., to M/s. Radha Smelters Private Limited.
- The industry has taken Additional land of 6.18 acres for which EC Amendment has been taken for inclusion of the Additional land and Survey Numbers with vide order dated 04.08.2021.
- Now, the industry proposed to establish 3rd rolling mill by keeping the rolling mill 1 and 2 as stand by. The capacity of new rolling mill proposed will be 1800 TPD capacity but proposed to run the mill with sanctioned capacity of 1188 TPD only and will not exceed the capacity granted in the Environmental Clearance.
- Proposed to install reheating furnace of capacity 35 TPH by keeping the existing reheating furnace as standby.
- This application is made for EC Amendment for inclusion of proposed rolling mill and reheating furnace.

Hence, it was requested to issue EC (Amendment) with the following changes:

After detailed discussion, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Yashwanth and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed that, earlier an old shed of Re-rolling mill exists in the site. In this regard, the project proponent informed that it will be dismantled as per Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 and proposed project will be taken up.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 11,416.9 Sq.m; Out of which green area is 1,161.3 Sq.m. (10.2 %).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 60,801.6 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 276 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 2 Blocks (2C + S – 12 upper floors) and Amenities block (2C + G + 3 floors).

It is also noted that parking area to be provided is 18,305.0 Sqm. (43.1 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.90.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.205.9 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 5.0 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.19.7 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.49.6 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Venkatesh; and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 5,388.42 Sq.m and Net plot area is 5,328.61 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 538.1 Sq.m. (10.10 %).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 29,823.73 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 154 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are C + 2S + 10 upper floors with Club house in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the block.

It is also noted that parking area to be provided is 8,138.65 Sqm. (37.53 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 43.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 75.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 9.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

<b>Agenda Item No. 06</b>	<b>5.42 Ha. Building stone and Road Metal of M/s. Sai Shekthi Constructions, Sy. No. 589/1 of Kalyapur Village, Renjal Mandal, Nizamabad District. - TOR Violation - Reg.</b>
<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/MIN/407626/2022 (TOR Violation)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Rajashekar Reddy; and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted on 03.10.2015 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years i.e upto 04.03.2031. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 17.10.2022 of ADMG, Nizamabad District informing that there is another quarry lease (4.0 Ha. – lease granted before 09.09.2013) existing within 500m from proposed quarry. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.42 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 9.42 Ha. and Net cluster area is 5.42 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,20,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building stone and Road metal. The proponent started & carried out mining operations during 2016-17 to 2021-22 without obtaining EC, as per lr. dt. 17.10.2022 of ADMG, Nizamabad District.

Nearest human habitation is Kisan Tanda (V) exists at 1.1 km; Nearest water body i.e a canal exists at 0.47 km and nearest RF is Abbapuram RF exists at a distance of 0.1 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October – December 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Building Stone and Road Metal Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from October – December 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

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After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from October – December 2022 as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for “Mining of Minerals” along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Neelam Guruvaiah Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- Earlier, the DEIAA, Rajanna Sircilla District, issued EC on 16.05.2017 for mining 60,247.20 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Road Metal & Building Stone with validity upto 5 years.
- Due to extension of Battala Cheruvu Reservoir for a safety margin of 50m. Part of the quarry lease was surrendered over an area of 0.78 Ha. with balance mine lease area of 3.67 Ha. vide Procds. Dt.19.07.2022 of DDMG, Warangal District.
- Now, they are applying for fresh EC as the mine lease area has decreased from 4.45 Ha. to 3.67 Ha.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 15.03.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years i.e upto 14.03.2026. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 16.12.2022 of ADMG, Rajanna Sircilla District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from proposed quarry. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.67 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Mustafanagar (V) exists at a distance 1.08 km; nearest water body exists at a distance of 50m; Nearest RF is Machareddi RF exists at 0.37 km (W) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 60,045 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Road Metal & Building Stone and the life of mine is reported as 16 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 6.66 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.07 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 16.12.2022 of ADMG, Rajanna Sircilla District furnishing the details of production during the period from 2015-16 to & 2022-23. It is observed from the letter that production was carried out during the period from 2016-17 to 2021-22 (upto 15.05.2022) and Nil during the period 2015-16 & 2022-23.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.25.10.2022 issued by the Sarpanch, of Grama Panchayath, Mustafanagar (V), Gambhiraopet (M), Rajanna Sircilla District, stating that project proponent donated material of worth Rs. 2,00,000 /- for construction of temples, roads and ganesh idols in the village.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Srinivas Reddy and Sri Shyam Sunder of M/s. M/s. JM Enviro Net Pvt. Ltd., attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- Lease Grant order for limestone mining over an area of 417.95 ha. vide proceeding no. 667/M2/2008 dated 07.02.2015 has been extended from the period of 20 years to 50 years i.e., from 29.09.1981 to 28.09.2031 as per MMDR act 1957 and amendment thereof.
- Lease Grant order for shale & clay mining over an area of 55.82 ha in vide proceeding no. 2819/M2/1998 dated 11.02.1999 for the period of 20 years i.e., from 11.02.1999 to 10.02.2019.
- M/s. Rain Industries limited (RCL) obtained Environmental Clearance for enhancement of limestone production from 9,40,000 to 13,00,000 TPA with Mine lease are 473.77 ha (417.95 + 55.82) in Ramapuram (V), Mellacheruvu (M), Nalgonda District from Ministry of Environment and Forest vide order no: J-11015/144/2003-IA.II (M); dated 22.08.2007. Further the RCL obtained EC for expansion of integrated Cement Plant from 1 MTPA to 1.5 MTPA and captive Limestone mine of 417.95 Ha from 1.3 MTPA to 1.6MTPA vide order dt.27.10.2010.
- 55.82 Ha ML was operated for Shale without EC for shale mining. Hence, this proposal is being applied under violation category.
- Meanwhile, Rain Cements Limited applied for Renewal of Quarry lease. The DMG has directed RCL to submit Scrutinized Quarry Plan along with Environmental Clearance and Consent for Establishment Telangana State Pollution Control Board vide letter no. 237530/R2-2/2019 dt 10-12-2019.

The SEAC noted that initially the lease of Ac.137-35 Gts was granted in favour of M/s. Priyadarshini Cements Ltd., on 31.08.1998 for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred on 28.08.2006 in favour of M/s. Rain Industries Ltd., for un-expired portion of lease period upto 10.02.2019 along with other lease of Ac.1032-13 Gts (Limestone). Later, the above leases were transferred to M/s. Rain Cements Ltd., Subsequently, 1<sup>st</sup> renewal of lease for Shale & Clay was granted (in-principle) over an extent of Ac. 137.35 Gts. on 30.03.2019 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 55.82 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted on 19.02.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 02.11.2022 of ADMG, Karimnagar District informing that there are another 5 quarry leases (13.80 Ha.; 4.0 Ha. & 4.0 Ha. – EC's were granted before 15.01.2016) and (6.0 Ha. & 4.78 Ha. – leases granted after 09.09.2013 & EC's were granted after 15.01.2016) existing within 500m from proposed quarry.
