The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Pandu Ranga Rao and Sri D. Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 19.60 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as above 8.0m (minimum 8.5m & maximum 15m) as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report submitted by the project proponent.

It is proposed to mine 3,91,972 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Tekulagudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.70 km (E) & Nugur RF @ 1.88 km (E) exists from the boundary of the sand reach.

The SEAC observed from the KML file dt. 28.11.2022 that the proposed mining area is attached with waterbody. However, the project proponent submitted the latest satellite image dt.21.02.2023 i.e from the image no waterbody is observed.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference and undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Divakar and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they obtained EC vide order dt. 01.02.2018 from the DEIAA, Warangal Urban District, TS, MoEF&CC for mining of Building Stone & Road Metal with validity upto 31.01.2023. It was informed that they also obtained CFE vide order dt.07.04.2018 and CFO vide order dt.07.04.2018 valid upto 28.02.2023 for the project.

Now, the proponent applied for fresh EC on 02.03.2023 with production capacity i.e 6,922.8 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and life of the mine is 22 years. Hence, it was requested to issue fresh EC as the mine was not in operation after expiry of the EC.

The SEAC noted that the lease was initially granted on 19.04.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, the lease was executed on dt.11.05.2018 for a period of 20 years i.e upto 10.05.2038. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 0.472 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha.

The nearest village is Gatlanarsingapur (V) exists at a distance 1.3 km; nearest water body i.e Cheruvu exists at a distance of 63m and nearest RF i.e., Akunur RF exists at a distance of 2.9 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 6,922.8 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Metal & Stone and the life of mine is reported as 22 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 10.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.50 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.63 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.01.02.2023 of the ADMG: Hanumakonda District furnishing the details of year-wise production details for the period from 2018-19 to 2022-23 (upto 31.01.2023). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production was carried during the period from 2018-19 to 2022-23 (upto 31.01.2023). Further, it is also observed that the quarry operations were stopped on 31.01.2023.

The proponent informed that they have done CSR activities in the nearest village and submitted a copy of Certificate dt.02.02.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Mulkanoor Village, Bheemadevarapally Mandal, Hanmakonda District informing that the proponent has donated Mini water tank for facility of drinking water.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of fresh EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri T. Kranthi Kumar and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted (in-principle) on 03.02.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years upto 02.02.2031. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was

granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.10.11.2022 of ADMG, Warangal District informing that there is another quarry lease of M/s. Om Sai Stone Crusher (1.0 Ha. - lease granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 3.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 4.0 Ha. and Net cluster area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. and thus the project has to be considered under B2 Category. But, since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 69,772.80 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Road Metal & Building Stone. The proponent carried out mining operations from 2016-17 without obtaining EC as per lr. dt. 10.11.2022 of ADMG, Warangal District.

Nearest human habitation is Battu Tanda (V) @ 0.88 km (S); Nearest water body exists at 0.35 km (E) and Nearest RF is Surpalli RF exists at a distance of 8.0 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they are collecting the baseline data from March – May 2023 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Road Metal and Building Stone. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from March – May 2023 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the above baseline data, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Sk. Akbar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was granted on dt.06.05.2006 in favour of Sree Hanu Deepika Granites for a period of 20 years i.e upto 05.05.2026. Then, the lease was transferred on 12.12.2017 in favour of M/s. Hanvi Granites (P) Ltd., for a period upto 05.05.2026. Subsequently, the lease was again transferred on 28.01.2020 in favour of the proponent for un-expired period of lease i.e upto 05.05.2026. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Patelgudem (V) exists at a distance 0.67 Km (SE); nearest water body i.e water body (Cheruvu) exists at a distance of 0.52 km (S) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 2,119.5 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 12 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 15.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 1.50 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.76 Lakhs/annum.

It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2006-07; 2007-08; 2019-20 and during 2021-22 and Nil during the period from 2008-09 to 2018-19; 2020-21 & 2022-23 (upto 15.10.2022).

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.12.01.2023 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Nancharimaduru Village, Thorrur Mandal, Mahabubabad District stating that the proponent has donated Rs.25,000/- for developmental activities in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Smt. Santhoshi and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 7,989.8 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 806.0 Sq.m. (10.1%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 46,675.5 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate total no. of 243 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Single block with 2B + S + 10 Floors including Amenities.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 14,749.9 Sq.m., (46.2 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 120.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 166.3 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 4.4 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 14.8 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 42.2 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Saddupalli which is existing at a distance of 960 m (W); nearest water body i.e water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 690 m (NE) and nearest RF i.e., Bacharam R.F exists at 2.2 km (NW) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,62,250 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone, Road Metal and Rough Stone and the life of mine is reported as 20 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.89 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.37 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 17.06.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 05.01.2023 of ADMG, Karimnagar District informing that there are three other quarry leases of (13.80 Ha. & 4.78 Ha. – EC's granted after 15.01.2016) & (4.0 Ha. – lease granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The total cluster area is 24.58 Ha. and Net cluster area is 20.58 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village is Kothagattu (V) exists at a distance of 1.1 km (SW); nearest water body i.e nearby tank exists at a distance of 0.69 km (SE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine maximum production of 7,663 m<sup>3</sup>/annum and an average production of 5,410.32 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 15 years @5,410.32 m<sup>3</sup>/annum.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.18 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 23.02.2023 of ADMG, Karimnagar District. It is observed from the document that there is no quarrying activity in the applied area.

The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 8.5m to 9.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report submitted by the project proponent.

The SEAC observed from the KML file that there was a water in the proposed site as on date 04.11.2021. However, the proponent has submitted a latest satellite picture dt. 09.03.2023, as per the latest satellite picture there is no water in the proposed site. It is further, the Committee directed the proponent not to carryout mining operation during the rainy season only.

It is proposed to mine 88,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ambatipally which is existing at a distance of 2.25 km (SE) & Nearest RF is Singaram RF @ 1.7 km exists from the boundary of the sand reach.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 22.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.38 Lakhs/annum.

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

- The Assistant Director of Mines Geology, Tandur identified the Mineral Block of Laterite over an extent of Ac. 12.00 Gts./4.86 Ha. in Sy. No. 142 (Govt. Land) of Govindapur Village, Mominpet Mandal, Vikarabad District, Telangana.
- Later Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Tandur submitted proposals of identified mineral block and requested the Department of Mines & Geology, Telangana for preparation of Scrutinized Quarry Plan vide Lr. No. 1379/MB/GOV/2022 dated 27.12.2022.
- The Mines & Geology Department, Government of Telangana through the JDMG, Hyderabad while proposing to auction Laterite mineral block over an extent of Ac. 12.00 gts. or 4.86 Hectares in Sy.No.142 (Govt. Land) of Govindapur Village, Mominpet Mandal, Vikarabad District issued Memo vide Memo No. 1818776/P/2022 dated 24.12.2022 and instructed the ADMG, Tandur to take necessary action for obtaining Approved SQP.
