The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 15.04.2023

Agenda Item No. 01	1.0 Ha. Building Stone and Road Metal Quarry of The Asst. Director of Mines and Geology, Adilabad, Sy.No.137(GL) of Sunkidi village, Talamadugu Mandal, Adilabad District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/421289/2023 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri A.Ravi Shankar and Smt. Lochana of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the project proponent informed the following:

- The Asst. Director of Mines and Geology, Adilabad, had identified the mineral bearing area for auction proposed quarry lease for Rough Stone & Road metal over an extent of 1.0 Hectare in Sy.No.137 (G.L) of Sunkidi village, Talamadugu Mandal, Adilabad District, Telangana (TS) as per instructions of the Director of Mines & Geology, Hyderabad vide memo no 1576586/P/2022, Dated 14.06.2022 in the connection of orders issued by the state Government of Telangana vide G.O.Ms.No.26.Inds.,& Comm.,(Mines-1) dated:31.03.2022 for grant of leases minor minerals except ordinary sand reserved under 9-A through auction except otherwise providing by amending Rule 4, Rule7,Rule 12 and Rule13 of Telangana Minor mineral Concession Rule,1966 reserved under Rule 9-A through Auction.
- The Asst. Director of Mines and Geology, Adilabbad, submitted the proposals for recommending for Auction proposed mineral bearing area for Rough Stone and Road Metal over an extent of 1.0 Ha., in Sy.No. 137(G.L) of Sunkidi village, Talamadugu Mandal, Adilabad District in the state of Telangana(TS), filed by the applicant as Assistant director of Mines and Geology, Adilabad.
- After careful examination of the proposals of the Assistant Director of Mines and Geology, Adilabad, in principle, it is decided for Auction Proposed Mineral Bearing Area for Rough Stone & Road Metal over an extent of 1.0 Ha., in Sy.No. 137/1(G.L) of Sunkidi village, Talamadugu Mandal, Adilabad District in the state of Telangana (TS), filed by ADMG, Adilabad, for a period of 20 years.

The proponent has submitted mining plan approval letter dt. 08.02.2023 issued by the DDMG, Nizamabad to ADMG, Adilabad.

The project proponent submitted a copy of lt. dt.14.02.2023 of ADMG: Adilabad Distict that there is one quarry lease exists within 500m from proposed mine lease area. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. Total cluster area is 4.824 Ha and Net cluster area is 4.824 Ha which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Sunkidi (V) exists at a distance 2.48 km (E); nearest water body i.e water body exists at a distance of 121 m (SW) and Nearest RF i.e., Thamsi RF exists at a distance of 3.835 km from mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 26,688 m³/annum of Rough stone & Road Metal and life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 35.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.6 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.7 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/421308/2023 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri K.Venugopal Rao and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the intial lease was granted on dt.15.07.2008 in favour of Sri. M. Damoder Reddy for a period of 10 years i.e., upto 14.07.2018. Later, 1st renewal of the lease was granted on 07.01.2023 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Devanur (V) exists at a distance 1.69 km (N); nearest water body i.e., Dharmasagar Cheruvu exists at a distance of 0.22 km (W) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 21,060 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road metal and the life of mine is reported as 6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 25.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.58 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.12.01.2023 of ADMG, Hanumakonda District, furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2008-09 to 2022-23 (upto 09.01.2023). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2008-09 and 2010-11. And nil during 2009-10 and 2011-12 to 2022-23 (up to 09.01.2023). However, the ADMG has informed that the lease was expired on 14.07.2018 and mining was not carried out after expiry of lease period.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.20.02.2023 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Dharmasagar Mandal, Hanumakonda District stating that the proponent has donated material of cost Rs. 1,00,000 /-.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P.Krishna and Sri P. Hrai Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the intial lease was granted on dt.28.10.2009 in favour of Sri. P. Pramod Kumar for a period of 10 years i.e., upto 27.10.2019. Later, 1st renewal of the lease was granted on 26.10.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Rangapuram (V) exists at a distance 1.0 km (ENE); nearest water body i.e., Lake near mine exists at a distance of 0.75 km (E) and Nearest RF i.e., Parvatapuram Forest block exists at a distance of 1.06 km (S) and Kisaragutta RF at a distance of 2.0 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,79,400 TPA of Building Stone & Road metal and the life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.0 Lakhs/annum.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 15.04.2023

The SEAC observed from KML file that the mining is done outside the mine lease area. The project proponent informed that previously the co-ordinates of mine given by ADMG was incorrect. And now, the co-ordinates were adjusted. Subsequently, ADMG, issued a lt.dt.13.04.2023 informing that they have not carried out mining operations.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.13.04.2023 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District, furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2009-10 to 2023-24 (upto 12.04.2023). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2010-11 and 2016-17. And nil during 2009-10 and 2017-18 to 2023-24 (up to 12.04.2023). However, the ADMG has informed that the lease was expired on 27.10.2019 and mining activity was not done after lease expiry.

The proponent submitted a copy of lt dt.15.12.2022 issued by the Principal MPPS, Inupamula, Kethepally Mandal, Nalgonda District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 50,000 /- for benches in classroom.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 04	1.0 Ha. Black Granite Mine of Smt. P.Nagamani, Sy.Nos. 177 & 178/AA2 of Gaigollapally Village, Kusumanchi Mandal, Khammam District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/421397/2023 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Srinivas Rao and Smt. Lochana of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they obtained EC vide order dt. 23.10.2015 from the SEIAA, TS for mining 1,481.7 m³/annum of Black Granite with validity of 6 years i.e upto 22.10.2021. It was informed that they also obtained CFE vide order dt. 03.12.2015 and CFO vide order dt.03.02.2016 which is valid upto 31.12.2020.

Now, the proponent informed applied for a fresh EC. As the production was stopped after expiry of EC. The ADMG, Khammam vide lr. dt. 20.12.2022 has informed that the production from 2021 to 2022 and 2022 to 2023 (till 20th December 2022) was mentioned as zero.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) in favour of the proponent on 15.03.2016 for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, the lease was executed on 11.05.2016 for a period of 20 years i.e upto 10.05.2036. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt.14.07.2022 of ADMG, Khammam District informing that there is another quarry lease of M/s. M&M Stone (1.60 Ha. - lease granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 2.60 Ha. and Net cluster area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The proponent informed that there is another mine which is existing adjacent to the present mine lease in the name of M/s. Sri Srinivasa Granites with an extent of 1.346 Ha. located in Sy.no. 316 & 317 of Urlugonda (V), Mothey (M), Suryapet District which was granted in the year 2018. As this quarry falls in Suryapet District hence this mine area is not included in ADMG, Khammam District cluster letter. As per the work order copy of M/s. Srinivasa Granites Mine dt. 09.07.2018 the mine lease area is noted as 1.346 Ha.

The nearest village is Lalsingh Thanda exists at a distance 0.87 Km (ENE); nearest water body exists at a distance of 0.93 km (SW) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 2,239.50 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 13 years @2,239.50 m³/annum.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.9 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.10 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.30.03.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Grama Panchayath, Kusumanchi Mandal, Khammam District, stating that project proponent donated Rs. 32,000 /- for the construction of Roads and for the development of village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P.Krishna and Sri P. Hrai Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the intial lease was granted on dt.07.01.2010 in favour of Sri. Narra Sridhar for a period of 15 years i.e., upto 06.01.2025. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.60 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Rangapuram (V) exists at a distance 1.19 km (NE); nearest water body i.e., water body near mine exists at a distance of 21 mtrs (S) and Shamirpet vagu exists at a distance of 4.3 km (NE) and Nearest RF i.e., Parvatapuram Forest block exists at a distance of 1.0 km (S) and Kisaragutta RF at a distance of 2.2 km (SW) from the mine lease area. It is proposed to mine 1,56,000 m³/Annum of Building Stone & Road metal and the life of mine is reported as 17 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.0 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.13.04.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District, furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2009-10 to 2023-24 (upto 12.04.2023). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2010-11 to 2023-24 (upto 12.04.2023) and nil during 2009-10. It is observed from the letter that due to typographical error letter date was 13.04.2022 and the It signed dt.13.04.2023.

The proponent submitted a copy of It dt. 27.07.2022 issued by the Headmaster ZPHS Ramalingampally (V), Bommalararam (M), Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent has donated C.C.Cameras worth Rs. 50,000 /- and a copy of It dt.27.07.2022 issued by the Headmaster MPPS, Inupamula, Kethepally Mandal, Nalgonda District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 15,000 /- for classroom furniture.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for rejection of EC as the waterbody is existing at a distance of 21m as against the 50m as per the guidelines.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K.Kiran Kumar and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the proponent has obtained inprincipled quarry lease for fuller earth quarry over an extent of 1.215 Ha. (Ac. 3.00 Gts) in Sy. No. 384/RU of Tharigopula Village, Dharur Mandal, Vikarabad District on dt.04.03.2020 for a period of 10 years.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 15.04.2023

The project obtained Environmental Clearance vide order dt. 02.01.2021 for a quantity of 25,000 TPA with a validity upto 01.01.2023.

The proponent informed that in the MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221(E), dt. 18.01.2021, it was mentioned that "9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid". With this notification, EC validity is extended up to one year i.e., upto 01.01.2024, as informed by the proponent. Hence, the proponent applied extension of EC within the valid period.

It is further informed that the proponent has not executed the quarry lease area. The proponent has applied for CFE & CFO. The Board has not considered CFE & CFO as the existing EC was expired.

The nearest village is Nagsanpally (V) exists at a distance 1.9 km (S); nearest water body i.e., tank near kondapur exists at a distance of 1.1 km (N) and Nearest RF i.e., Ghatkondapur RF exists at a distance of 1.3km (NE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 25,000 Tons/Annum of Fullers earth and the life of mine is reported as 2 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 2.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.25 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Basawa Govardhan and Sri Laxmikanth Reddy of M/s. Vison Labs, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 49,727.64 Sq.m., area affected by the Road Widening is 2,312.25 Sq.m. and Net plot area is 47,415.39 Out of which green area is 4,745.00 Sq.m. (10.01%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 45,245.64 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Duplex villas Construction Project to accommodate total no. of 114 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Duplex villas with (G + 2 Upper Floors) and Amenities (C + G + 3 Upper Floors).

It is also noted that adequate parking area is individual parking provided to every Villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 56.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 56.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 15.0 Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that in the KML there was a water body & Nala passing through the proposed site. However, the was verified time scale but no water body & Nala is observed. The SEAC also verified topo sheet. As per the topo sheet there is no water body & Nala with in the site area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Shivanenigudem (V) exists at a distance 1.6 km (ESE); nearest water body i.e., Narkatapallivari Cheruvu near mine exists at a distance 7.4 km (SE) and Nearest RF i.e., Shivanenigudem RF exists at a distance of 159 meters (N) and Chityala RF at a distance 3.0 km (SSE) from the mine lease area.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was granted on dt.21.05.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. 

It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 551.9 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 792.48 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

During the presentation, the SEAC observed that the waterbody is located beside the site. Subsequently, the 1st renewal of lease was granted on 29.04.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.038 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) on 27.06.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 01.12.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representations that the issues emerged during public hearing are: Lot of pollution and no proper pollution control measures implemented. (implement dust suppression methods for air and dust pollution); problem due to moving vehicles (Take appropriate speed control measures); Public hearing is not conducting properly; Conduct medical camps; Provide local employment; Conduct skill development training programme; CSR funds should be spent on effected villages; Provide PPE kits to all workers. The proponent informed: Implement all pollution control measures; Will Conduct health camps periodically; Employment will be given preference to local; Provide tarpaulin covers to the covers to trucks to avoid accidents; Greenbelt will be developed in an area of 0.18 Ha and avenue plantation along the connecting roads will be proposed (Rs. 0.71 lakhs); Adopt water sprinkling to control dust pollution; Will implement all pollution control measures as suggested by MoEF and TSPCB to ensure least negative impact; They have allocated Rs. 1.4 Lakhs under CSR activities. The proponent informed that State Government has initiated credible action against the proponent vide CC No. 68/2023 filed in the Hon'ble 1-Junior Civil Judge cum-XIV Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Hayathnagar.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is Low. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for

The SEAC considered the project as per the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 & O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. The SEAC noted that as per SOP the total Penalty (where operations have commenced without EC) is 1% of the total project cost incurred up to the date of filing of application along with EIA/EMP report PLUS 0.25 % of the total turnover during the period of violation. Further, the percentage rates, as above, shall be halved if the project proponent *suo-moto* reports such violations without such violations coming to the knowledge of the Government either on inquiry or complaint.

The SEAC noted that, a complaint was received from Save bandaravirala through mail dt.14.02.2023, which was forwarded by MS, SEIAA, TS, wherein it was stated the following:

- The villagers (Chinnaravirala, bandaravirala and Guvvaleti) are suffering with heavy dust and air pollution due to stone metal quarries, mines, stone crushers which were located in bandaravirala from last 15 years.
- This area been duped as mining area, they are facing heavy air, dust, PM10, PM2.5 pollution by these mines and stone crushers from the past 12 years which make their lives miserable and pathetic with this pollution.
- No proper information provided to them about Public Hearing.
- The EIA submitted by every mine were false as the AAQM readings are at dangerous levels as per the TSPCB reply.
- The Team Labs consultant have made false EIA

The MoEF, Regional Office, Telangana vide letter dated 20.03.2023 has forwarded the above complaint to the Member Secretary, SEIAA, Telangana for taking necessary action.

The MoEF, New Delhi, vide letter 21.03.2023 has forwarded the complaint made by Sri P.L.N.Rao, Environmental Social Worker, wherein it was stated the following:

- False information submitted in EIA report.

The project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) on 27.06.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 30.11.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representations that the issues emerged during public hearing are: Implement pollution control measures. (implement dust suppression methods for air and dust pollution); Conduct medical camps; Provide local employment; CSR funds should be spent on effected villages. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent also submitted a copy of Ir. dt.11.04.2023 of ADMG, Nizamabad District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 3.85 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. and thus the project has to be considered under B2 Category. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Ayyavarigudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.43 km (W); nearest water body i.e Kattaleru Canal exists at 2.084 km and Nearest RF is Bhimavaram RF exists at a distance of 256.80 m (S) from the mine lease sarea.

It is proposed to mine an average of 1,73,533.33 m³/annum of Building Stone and Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 8 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.50 Lakhs/annum.
