

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- State Government vide GO Ms No. 153, dt. 01.03.2002 constituted Mining Zone Committee for Ranga Reddy District. Mining Zone committee identified an area in Survey No. 268 creation of mining zone as per GoMs No. 89, dt. 22.03.2006 by the State Government.
- As per the state government orders vide G.O.Ms. No. 48, dt. 26.07.2017 for issue of Scrutinized Quarry Plan all lease holders prepared quarry plans.
- Some of the lease holders applied for EC in April 2018 through online portal. Simultaneously, SEIAA raised clarification sought through EDS for not uploading AMP and resubmitted the proposal.
- A case was filed before the Hon'ble NGT vide Original Application (O.A) No. 9 of 2022 (SZ) w.r.t. the Quarries located in above mentioned Mining Zone.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Stone & Metal Quarry with Mine Lease Area of 5.038 Ha or 12.45 Acres (6.0 Acres in Block No. 22A, 4.0 Acres in Block No. 22B and Acr 2.45 gts in Common Area). The SEAC noted that these Blocks of mine lease area are located at a distance of 35 mts from each other. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 82,145 m³/annum of Stone & Metal.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years upto 05.05.2023 and the proponent started mining operations from the year 2014-15 to 2020-21 as per lr. dt. 19.03.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Pillaipalli (V) @ 1.6 km; Nearest water body i.e., Seasonal Musi River exists at a distance of 2.7 km; Nearest RF i.e., Bacharam RF exsits at 3.5 km from the boundary of the site.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. But, the SEAC noted that the proposal was uploaded prior to issue of SOP w.r.t. Violation cases. Hence, the SEAC decided to consider the proposal in terms of S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

The SEAC noted that these Blocks of mine lease area are located at a distance of 343 mts from each other. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 7,33,300 m³/annum of Stone & Metal.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years upto 30.04.2023 and the proponent started mining operations from the year 2012-13 to 2020-21 as per lr. dt. 19.03.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Pillaipalli (V) @ 1.1 km; Nearest water body i.e., Seasonal Musi River exists at a distance of 2.5 km; Nearest RF i.e., Bacharam RF exsits at 4.1 km from the boundary of the site.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- State Government vide GO Ms No. 153, dt. 01.03.2002 constituted Mining Zone Committee for Ranga Reddy District. Mining Zone committee identified an area in Survey No. 268 creation of mining zone as per GoMs No. 89, dt. 22.03.2006 by the State Government.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Stone & Metal and Gravel/Morrum Quarry with Mine Lease Area of 20.154 Ha or Acr 49.80 gts. (24.0 Acres in Block No. 15A, 16A, 13A & 14A, 8.0 Acres in Block No. 13B & 14B, Acr 8.0 in Block No. 15B & 16B and 9.80 acre of common area). The SEAC noted that these Blocks of mine lease area are located at a distance of 419 mts, 678 mts & 54 mts from each other. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 6,09,387 m³/annum of Stone & Metal Mine and 70,480 m³/annum of Gravel/Morrum Mine.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years upto 17.04.2020 and the proponent started mining operations from the year 2012-13 to 2020-21 as per lr. dt. 19.03.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Deshmukhi (V) @ 1.3 km; Nearest water body i.e., Seasonal Musi River exists at a distance of 2.8 km; Nearest RF i.e., Bacharam RF exsits at 3.1 km from the boundary of the site.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. But, the SEAC noted that the proposal was uploaded prior to issue of SOP w.r.t. Violation cases. The representative of the project proponent Sri M.S. Raghava Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA issued EC vide order dt. 24.03.2022 for Construction of Residential Apartments with total builtup area of 3,74,611.3 Sq.m.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOCs dt. 01.03.2022 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 565.6 mts & 564.9 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 715.6 mts & 714.9 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the buildings is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

The SEAC observed that the site is adjacent to Surplus of Yellamma Cheruvu. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt. 13.04.2022 of the EE, North Tanks Division, Hyderabad of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that the applicant's site to an extent of Ac. 03-19 Gts of Sy. No. 317, 318 of Kukatpally (V&M) is partly affected in buffer of Yellamma Surplus land to an extent of Ac. 0-01.1 Gts and partly affected in Nala and its buffer of surplus of Pariki Cheruvu to an extent of Ac. 0-0.74 Gts and Ac. 0-8.8 Gts respectively leaving the balance land in Sy. No. 317 & 318 is Ac. 03-08.4 Gts as per norms stipulated in G.O.Ms.No. 168, dt. 07.04.2012 of MA&UD Dept. Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project.

Now, the proponent informed that due to changes in project profile there is increase in Site area, Built-up area, Parking area, No. of Floors, no. of units, water requirement, Wastewater generation, STP capacity, DG Sets, EMP Cost etc. It was also informed that construction is not initiated as on date. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Gouri Shanker and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 31.01.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 08.04.2022 of ADMG, Medak District informing that there are no existing and adjacent quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 2.0 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Yellakapalli (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.4 km; nearest water body i.e., Water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 290m (SW); nearest RF i.e., Yelduti RF exists at 0.3 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 71,424 m³/annum of Rough Stone and the life of mine is reported as 6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 25.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.82 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.93 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Krishna Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC observed that the site is adjacent to Cheruvu, Canal and Nala. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt. 16.03.2022 issued by the Superintending Engineer, Irrigation Circle, Hyderabad of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that out of total area of Ac 67-15 Gts, an extent of Ac 17-00 Gts (affected in FTL), Ac 06-08 Gts (affected in 30m buffer zone of Brahmanpalli Cheruvu), Ac 00-28 Gts (affected in 9m buffer zone of feeder channel), Ac 00-13.85 Gts (affected in strem portion), Ac 00-18.45 Gts (affected in 2m buffer zone on both sides of stream), Ac 00-20 Gts (affected in enlarged nala portion), Ac 00-11.85 Gts (affected in 2m buffer zone on both sides of enlarged nala portion). Therefore, the balance applicants land to an extent of Ac 41-34.85 Gts is not affected in any waterbody/nala/channel and it is free from water body as per the norms stipulated in G.O.Ms. No. 168, dt. 07.04.2012 of MA&UD Department. Accordingly, the proponent proposed the layout of the project. Further, the proponent submitted an undertaking stating that they will not discharge any treated or untreated waste water or any solid waste in the existing Brahmanpalli Cheruvu /Nala/Canal under any circumstances.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 2,43,678.9 Sq.m., Net plot area is 1,68,622.5 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 32,339.6 Sq.m. (19.2%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 1,27,649.2 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas (G + 2 Floors) to accommodate 589 Villas; Amenities (G + 3 Floors) and School Building (G + 3 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided with two parking spaces each.

The total cost of the project is Rs.282.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.526.22 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs.11.99 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.25.82 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.134.07 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC with the following specific condition:

• The proponent shall not discharge any treated or untreated waste water or any solid waste in the existing Brahmanpalli Cheruvu /Nala/Canal located adjacent to site under any circumstances.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Y. Sharath Chandra and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed within 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, Raidurg Navkhalsa (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 15.11.2021 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 545.25 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 746.76 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.
