The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Sk. Akbar and Sri P. Narendar of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the initial lease was executed on 29.05.2003 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years i.e. upto 29.05.2023. Subsequently, Renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 29.04.2023 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 0.725 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest human habitation is Madanathurthy village @ 0.42 km (SE); nearest water body i.e a small canal exists at 70 mts (NE) and Nearest RF i.e. Aleru RF exists at a distance of 5.8 km (NE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine maximum production of 1,046.4 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 15.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.12 Lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.85 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.22.06.2023 of the ADMG, Mahabubabad District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars details during the period from 2003-04 to 2023-2024. The SEAC observed from the letter that dispatch permits were carried out during the period from 2003-04; 2004-05; 2012-13 to 2014-15 and from 2017-18 to 2023-24 (upto 28.05.2023) and Nil during the period 2005-06 to 2011-12 & 2015-16 to 2016-17. Further, it is mentioned in the letter that there is no production activity or quarry operations were not carried out after expiry of the quarry lease i.e 28.05.2023.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.03.07.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Madanathurthy Village, Nellikuduru Mandal, Mahabubabad District stating that the proponent has donated Rs.25,000/- for development of the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Surender Reddy; Smt. G. Supreetha and Sri Kushal Bodhankar; Smt. G. Supreetha of M/s. KKB Envirocare Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they obtained EC dt.21.06.2005 issued by MoEF, GoI.

The SEAC noted that the industry obtained TORs (Violation) dt.18.12.2020 from the SEIAA, TS.

Total area is 0.81 acres i.e. 3300 sq m.

The proponent submitted Self Certified Compliance Report dt.20.07.2023.

Now, the project proponent informed that project could not proceed further after obtaining the TORs. Based on the market conditions there was need for revising the capacities of the products as well as to replace some of the products with other new products including R&D products. Hence, it was requested to issue Amentment to TORs for the following:

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to TORs.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Manoj Kumar and Sri Santhosh Kumar of M/s. Pioneer Enviro Laboratories & Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 90,385.32 Sq.m., and Net Plot area is 85,437.20 Sq.m; Out of which green area is 9451.49 Sq.m. (11.06%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 49,999.38 Sq.m. The project consists of Gated Community Residential Villas Construction Project to accommodate total no. of 72 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are (G + 1 Floor) & Club house (G + 1 Floor).

It is also noted that 2 car parking spaces are provided to each villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs.50.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 132.6 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 28.1 lakhs/annum.

The SEAC observed few trees are existing in the proposed site. In this regard, the proponent submitted undertaking letter stating the following:

- The trees present in the project site premises will not be disturbed and all trees will be maintained as a part of greenbelt development.
- Entire planning of the construction of proposed Gated community villas project is designed to keep the trees intact in the proposed site premises.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Mohd Yasar and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide Order dt.06.03.2020 for mining of Limestone Slabs with production capacity of 1200 TPA and life of mine as 21 years. The proponent also obtained CFE Order dt.27.08.2020 and CFO Order dt.05.09.2020 which is valid upto 30.06.2025.

Now, the proponent proposed for enhancement of production capacity from 1200 TPA to 12,000 TPA of Limestone Slabs.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt.04.08.2018 of the DMG, Hyderabad that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years. Then, the lease was executed on 02.06.2022 for a period of 10 years i.e upto 01.06.2032 for enhanced capacity. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt.08.05.2023 of ADMG, Vikarabad District, informing that there are five other quarry leases of (0.485 Ha.; 0.485 Ha.; 0.608 Ha.; 0.151 Ha. & 0.404 Ha. – all the leases were granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 0.879 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area and Net cluster area is 3.012 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. It was also mentioned in the letter that they have not obtained dispatch permits and hence production may be treated as nil.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ogipur (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.0 km; and Mullamari River flows at a distance of 0.7 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine average production of 12,000 TPA of Limestone and Slabs and the life of mine is reported as 11 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 18.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 2.25 Lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.38 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC observed few trees are existing in the proposed site. In this regard, the proponent submitted undertaking letter stating the following:

- The existing trees that are at the boundary will not be disturbed and the trees that are coming in the premises of the construction will be translocated to the boundaries.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC for expansion.

The representative of the Environmental Consultant Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA in its meeting held on 18.04.2023 deferred the project noted the project is considered under Violation and processed as per S.O. 804(E) dt. 14.03.2017, S.O. 1030 (E) dt. 08.03.2018, OM dt. 12.11.2020 & Lr. dt. 16.02.2021 O.M. dt. 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt. 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI. As per the guidelines of the SEIAA for Mining project involving violation, the rationalized project cost is Rs. 2,03,96,400/- and the amount of Bank Guarantee is Rs.20,39,640/- for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan. Hence, the proponent is directed to submit the Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs.20,39,640/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Thirty nine Thousand Six hundred Forty only) along with detailed action plan for implementation, Penalty amount of Rs.1,23,746/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Six only) through DD in favour of Member Secretary, TSPCB and undertaking to abide by the additional guidelines of the MoEF&CC, GoI, if any. The proponent is also directed to submit copy of clearance letter from concerned authority under WALTA Act.

Now, the proponent has applied fresh as the application is not visible in the PARIVESH and also submitted Bank Gurantee along with action plan for implementation of penalty amount. The proponent further informed that they have approached the DFO for WALTA act, due to non-availability of the officials, the process is delayed. Hence, they requested for exemption of WALTA Act.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC Clearance subject to approval by the SEIAA for submission of Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs. 20.40 lakhs and Penalty of Rs. 1,23,746/-.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Venkateshwarlu and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 9,220.89 Sq.m.; Out of which green area is 922.10 Sq.m. (10.0%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 1,22,437.76 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartment Construction Project to accommodate total no. of 304 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Single Block with (4B + Stilt + 2 levels clubhouse + 38 Floors); Club house at 1st and 2nd floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 31,664.90 Sq.m. (34.88 % against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.250.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 250.0 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 37.0 lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 19.07.2023 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 567.25 mts AMSL and the

permissible top elevation is restricted to 712.18 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

The proponent has submitted Mechanical Ventilators for Air circulation as they have proposed 4 basements/Cellars.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Balaji and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 20.03.2021 for construction of Residential Apartments construction project with total built up area of 30,066 Sq.m. The proponent informed that they have applied for CFE on 18.07.2023 and it is under process.

Now, the proponent informed that there is increase in built-up area due to which there are changes w.r.t built-up area, green area, No. of Floors, No. of units, Parking area, No. of vehicles, Water requirement, waste water generation, STP capacity, Solid waste, and Project cost. It was also informed that Demolition and Earth work is initiated in the site. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 18.08.2020 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 515.7 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 596.87 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Ashok and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) on 15.10.2022 for preparation of EIA Report exempting Public Hearing.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was granted on 02.07.2009 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years i.e upto 01.07.2019. Later, Renewal of LOI was granted (in-principle) on 05.07.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.31 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category, but since it is a violation case considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

Nearest human habitation is Bomapally @ 0.86 km and nearest water body i.e Ragini Cheruvu exists at a distance of 1.6 km; Nearest RF is Putnnoor RF exists at 8.0 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 42,290.50 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 15.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.5 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 16.06.2023 of ADMG, Peddapally District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars and heignlorage paid by the proponent during the period from 2009-10 to 2022-2023. Further, it is mentioned in the letter that after issue of TORs, no production by the lease holder and obtained dispatch permits for the available stock.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.14.06.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath of Ghanshayamdas nagar Village, Palakurthy Mandal, Peddapalli District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 50,000/- for Road repairing works in the village.

The proponent informed that State Government has initiated credible action against the proponent vide CC No. 294/2023 filed in the Hon'ble II-Addl Junior civil Judge-cum-II.Addl, Judicial Magistrate of first class court, Godavarikhani and the fine of Rs.10,000/- paid by the proponent.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is Low. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan is worked out to be Rs. 0.656 Lakhs and the details are as following:

The SEAC considered the project as per the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 & O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. The SEAC noted that as per SOP, the total Penalty (where operations have commenced without EC) is 1% of the total project cost incurred up to the date of filing of application along with EIA/EMP report PLUS 0.25 % of the total turnover during the period of violation. Further, the percentage rates, as above, shall be halved if the project proponent *suo-moto* reports such violations without such violations coming to the knowledge of the Government either on inquiry or complaint.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.31 Ha and the rationalized project cost Rs. 13.10 Lakhs considering Rs. 10.0 Lakhs/Ha. for Building stone & Road metal, But, the project cost is 15.00 Lakhs (Considering the higher of project cost and rationalized project cost). Hence, the project cost of the quarry is considered as Rs.15.00 Lakhs as per Methodology for calculating Penalty. Further, the SEAC considered total turnover as 2 times the Seignorage fee and hence, the turnover is Rs. 1,25,13,130/-.

Subsequently, transfer of lease was granted on 25.03.2013 in favour of the proponent for a period upto 19.05.2032. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest human habitation is Pocharam (V) @ 0.84 km (N); nearest water body i.e Irrigation canal exists at 0.45 km (NW) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine maximum production of 2,119.65 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 15 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.57 Lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.11 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 7,316.0 Sq.m (as per document) and 6,776.62 Sq.m (as on ground). Net plot area is 5,836.29 Sq.m.; Out of which green area is 1,085.5 Sq.m. (18.60%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 35,966.83 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential buildings construction Project to accommodate total no. of 116 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 2Cellars + Stilt + 12 Upper Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 10,880.83 Sq.m. (43.37% against required 33 %).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 35.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 45.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 10.0 lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 03.05.2023 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 525.77 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 576.50 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that a nala flows adjacent to the site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt.20.06.2023 of the Superintending Engineer, HL&WBM circle, I&CAD Dept., Hyderabad District. It is observed from the document that the Sy.No. 210 with total extent of land is 6,798 sq.mts; the area affected under MFL to an extent of 33.75 sq.mts; the area affected under buffer to an extent of 337.5 Sq.mts and the balance land is to an extent of 6,426.75 sq.mts is not affected in any Water body/Nata/Channel and it is free from the Water body/Nala as per the norms stipulated in G.O.Ms.No.168, dt.07.04.2012 of MA&UD Dept and G.O.Ms.No.7 MA & UD Dept. Accordingly, that project proponent proposed layout of the project.

During presentation, the SEAC observed few trees in the proposed site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of undertaking letter stating the following:

The project is proposed within 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, **Puppalguda (V)** is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto-generated) on 21.06.2023 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 19.07.2023

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 28,329.8 Sq.m.; Out of which green area is 5,068.0 Sq.m. (17.9%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 4,21,200 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate total no. of 1458 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 3 Towers with (2B + 3P + G + 54 Floors) and Amenities (5B + G + 5 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 1,03,500 Sq.m. (32.6 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.1150 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 1308.3 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 29.4 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 256.7 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 279.1 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC's (3 nos.) dt.04.07.2023 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 552.51 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 752.51 mts AMSL for Tower-1; the site elevation is 552.39 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 752.39 mts AMSL for Tower-2; the site elevation is 551.49 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 751.49 mts AMSL for Tower-3. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that a nala is flowing through to the site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt.30.07.2019 of the Executive Engineer, I&CAD Dept., IB Division, Hyderabad. It is observed from the document that no kunta is existing physically on ground, but the Bulkapur Nala is passing through the Sy.No's. 285, 286 & 287 as shown in the location sketch submitted by the Tahsildar, Gandipet (M), Ranga Reddy (M). Hence, the said land is permitted for construction of Road Bridge over the Nala dividing the Survey No. 285 and 287 of Puppalaguda Village, Gandipet Mandal, R.R Dist at new location instead of earlier permission and subject to obtaining the permission of Right of way from the Revenue authorities as the Nala land is Government property and with the following conditions:

1. The applicant can access the site by constructing the culvert as per approval of design without obstructing the free flow of water.
2. The Average Bulkapur Nala width at the proposed crossing is about 20 m. Hence the applicant has to provide culvert vent way with 20 m width and height with minimum vertical clearance of 0.6 m above the M.F.L. for free flow of water
3. Further the applicant has sought permission for carriage width of 100 ft (ie 30 m) for convenience of the Employees in their proposed LT Park, motarable access and for walking Path However the carriage way of 24 m for Double Lane Bridge is permitted with hand rails on either side as per the standards.
4. The Design and drawing of the Bridge shall be as per standards and approved. Farther the construction of Culvert are to be executed under the supervision of Department Personnel only.
5. The applicant should not allow dumping/throwing of any type of effluents/wastes debris etc., and sewerage water into the Tank/Nala as it damages the quality of water.
6. The officials of the Department/ Government will have the right to inspect and access through the applicant land bearing Survey. No. 285 and 286 situated at Puppalaguda (V), Gandipet (M), R.R.Dist and the applicant should not restrict entry for inspection and access at any time.
7. Further upon any objection by the higher authorities of the Department/Government for conversion of land to residential use zone/Multipurpose use zone then the permission is liable for cancellation without any prior notice and no compensation or reimbursement of cost, maintenance that may arise due to above permission for any reason what so ever.
8. For any construction in the above said survey numbers, the applicant has to follow the terms and conditlons laid down under GO.Ms.No.168, Dt.07.04.2012.
9. In case of any violation in the conditions laid above, permission given gets cancelled without any prior intimation or notice.

Earlier, the SEIAA in its meeting held on 22.06.2023 noted that the proponent applied for EC for the first time. It was directed to submit copies of initial mine lease order and latest status of mining activity to verify the compliance of EIA Notification. The proponent submitted a copy of initial mine lease order issued by DDMG vide Procds. dt.28.04.1993 and copy of ADMG, Peddapalli lr.dt.07.06.2023 with the details of dispatch from 2013-14 to 2022-23. However, it was observed from the history of google map for the period from December, 2020 to May, 2023 and ADMG lr.dt.07.06.2023 it was confirmed that the proponent continued mining activity after 17.04.2014 without obtaining EC. Thus, it amounts to violation of EIA Notification, 2006 & its amendments. Hence, the proposal was rejected on 27.06.2023.

The proponent also submitted the application filed (Form-B) which was applied on 01.02.2013. However, the ADMG has taken 14 months for processing of application and renewed the mine lease on 17.04.2014 with effect from 26.05.2013 i.e before 09.09.2013, hence violation is not applicable.

The SEAC noted from ADMG lr dt.07.05.2003 wherein it was mentioned that the original lease granted in favour of Sri T. Kumara Swamy and Subsequently transferred in favour of M/s. Kanaka Durga Stone Metal Suppliers for a period upto 26.05.2003. Later, the lease was again transferred from M/s. Kanaka Durga Stone Metal Suppliers to M/s. Venkateshwara Stone & Metal Suppliers, for a period upto 26.05.2003 and M/s. Venkateshwara Stone & Metal Suppliers, have obtained 1st renewal of mine lease on 07.05.2003 for a period of 10 years i.e. 04.05.2013. Further, the 2nd renewal of lease was granted w.e.f 26.05.2013 for a period of 10 years i.e 25.05.2023. Subsequently, the LOI was granted (in-principle) on 23.03.2023 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.69 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Bodaguttapalli (V) exists at a distance 621 mts (NE); nearest water body i.e SRSP canal exists at a distance of 202 mts; Nearest RF i.e. Putnur RF exists at a distance of 7.0 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 24,000 m³/annum of Building stone and Road metal and the life of mine is reported as 23 years.

The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing that the issues are: Implement pollution control measures; Provide local employment; control fugitive dust due to movement of vehicles roads are damage, greenbelt development, CSR funds to be spent on effected villages, Provide tarpaulin covers to the covers to trucks to avoid accidents; Implement water sprinkling method for control of dust pollution; Conduct Health camps; Install RO plant; The proponent informed: Implement all pollution control measures; Employment will be given to local; Greenbelt will be developed along approach roads ; tarpaulin covers will be provided to cover the trucks to avoid accidents; Health camps will be conducted every year; Adopt water sprinkling to control fugitive dust pollution, an amount of Rs.5.0 Lakhs allocated under CSR activities. Total no. of speakers are 25, out of which 8 members supported the project and 17 speakers offered suggestions,

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was executed on 27.08.2014 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years i.e 26.08.2034. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Ir.dt. 04.06.2022 of ADMG, Karimnagar District informing that there are four another quarry leases of (4.0 Ha. & 4.0 Ha. – leases granted before 09.09.2013) and (6.0 Ha. & 4.78 Ha. - leases granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease.

Subsequently, 1st renewal of lease was granted (In-principle) on 26.05.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.5 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. But, since it is a violation project, it is considered as B1 category. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

Nearest human habitation is Khazipalli (V) exists at 1.26 km (SE); Nearest water body i.e Small water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 59 m (S) and nearest RF is Khazipalli RF exists at a distance of 150 m from the mine lease area.

The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is that same to mine 2,23,258 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and life of mine is reported as 6.30 years.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Bharadwaj and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that they obtained EC from DEIAA, Jagityal District dt. 26.09.2017 for mining of Stone and Metal with production capacity of 30,000 m³/annum for a period upto 14.07.2021.

Now, the proponent has applied for fresh EC. The SEAC noted that the initial lease was executed on dt.15.07.2006 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years i.e upto 14.07.2021. Then, 1st renewal (LOI) of quarry lease was granted on 16.07.2022 for a period 20 years w.e.f 15.07.2021. Subsequently, the quarry was not in operation as per ADMG Ir dt.02.05.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.50 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

It is proposed to mine 16,000 m³/annum of Building Stone and Road metal and the life of mine is reported as 39 years.

The Nearest human habitation is Velgatoor (V) @ 1.32 km; Nearest water body exists at a distance of 1.3 km and Nearest RF is Munnula Gutta RF exists at a distance of 3.2 km from the mine lease area.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.0 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Ir.dt.02.05.2023 issued by ADMG, Jagityal District wherein it is mentioned in the letter that the quarry lease is non-working since expiry of the lease period.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.21.04.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Velgatur Village, Velgatur Mandal, Jagityal District stating that the proponent has donated material of worth Rs.1,10,000 /- for repairing of the roads in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 19.07.2023

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 26.06.2023 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit the Status of mining after issue of TORs duly certified by the Mining Department and also CSR activities carried out by the proponent.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.07.07.2023 issued by the ADMG, Karimnagar District. It is mentioned in the letter that the quarry lease is not under operation since the issue of TOR letter from SEIAA, TS. After receiving the TOR letter they have obtained permits for dispatch of old existing Granite Block stocks only and the old existing stock is shown as production.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.07.07.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Gollapally, Karimnagar District stating that the proponent has donated Rs.14,00,000/- for various developmental activities like Drinking water facilities; construction and repair of roads; development and repair of village water tanks; plantation of trees and construction of borewell in the village.

The SEAC considered the project as per the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 & O.M. dt:07.07.2021 & O.M. dt:28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. The SEAC noted that as per SOP, the total Penalty (where operations have commenced without EC) is 1% of the total project cost incurred up to the date of filing of application along with EIA/EMP report **PLUS** 0.25 % of the total turnover during the period of violation. Further, the percentage rates, as above, shall be halved if the project proponent *suo-moto* reports such violations without such violations coming to the knowledge of the Government either on inquiry or complaint.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.966 Ha and the rationalized project cost Rs. 44.49 Lakhs considering Rs. 15.0 Lakhs/Ha. for Colour Granite, But, the project cost is 55.00 Lakhs (Considering the higher of project cost and rationalized project cost). Hence, the project cost of the quarry is considered as Rs.55.00 Lakhs as per Methodology for calculating Penalty. Further, the SEAC considered total turnover as 2 times the Seignorage fee and hence, the turnover is Rs. 9,21,90,454/-.
