(b) Corporate Environmental Responsibility (CER) must be undertaken, in consultation with the concerned authority of the Local Body (Municipal Corporation / Municipality / Nagar Panchayat / Gram Panchayat) by clearly outlining the type of activities and amount involved. CER shall predominantly include Municipal Solid Waste Management activities like- Material Recovery Facility (MRF), Wet Waste processing Facilities, Waste collection vehicles, etc. (c) Tree plantations especially soil binding plants in three-rows must be raised around the entire campus. (d) Before the unit becomes



operational, authorization must be taken under the relevant rules from Bihar State Pollution Control Board, Bihar regarding management of Bio-Medical Waste. (e) A distance of around 100 meters must be left from the Bank of river Punpun and plantation must be done for proper environmental protection. The buffer zone for river Ganga and its sub-basins should be strictly maintained and no construction work should be done as per Hon'ble National Green Tribunal / Supreme Court guidelines. (f) The Expert team from SEIAA / SEAC may visit any time during the implementation of the above project to verify whether the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal / Supreme Court norms are being complied. The conditions be fulfilled along with standard conditions as imposed by the SEAC (Annexure – A) in its MoM (Ref. No. 243, dated 09.08.2023).

The applicant should also furnish a Bank Guarantee of Rupees one Crore with the MoEFCC, GoI. The letter with respect to Environmental Clearance will be issued only after compliance of the condition mentioned in (a). (b) The Project Proponent shall abide by the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 08.01.2020 [Writ Petition 9 (s) (Civil No. (s) 114/2014] regarding re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may be disturbed due to mining activities. In compliance to the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ
