	"The proposed projects falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (<100 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).
	The SEAC, Committee noted that the proposed mines fall underB2 at par with B1. As the



cluster Area is > 5 Ha.

The SEAC, Committee after examining the proposed project proposals of mines, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs, Final EIA report and detailed deliberations, recommended TOR with a common public hearing, with additional TOR with Cluster letter EIA & EMP."

In the 171st SEIAA Committee meeting held on 24th& 25th January 2022 decided to refer to SEAC to Examine the issue of common Public Hearing w.r.t notification dated 15.01.2016.

In view of the above, this issue is taken up in the 180th SEAC committee meeting. The committee after examining the project proposals, MoEF&CC' Notifications, OMs, and detailed deliberations, recommended to issue separate TORs for each project with public hearing. All other conditions remain same as given in the previous recommendations.

Processing of 526 applications of violation cases received from MoEF&CC, New Delhi vide letter dt 1.3 .2021.

The SEIAA has addressed letter dt 28.9.2021 to SEAC requesting to examine the processing of the proposals (526 applications) received from MoEF & CC keeping in view of all the

Notifications and OMs issued by MoEF&CC on violation cases including the recent OM dated 07.07.2021 issued by MoEF&CC on SOP for identification & handling of violation cases under EIA Notification, 2006 and recommend the procedure to be adopted for processing of File No.APPCB-11033/73/2021-TEC-EC-APPCB violation proposals received from MoEF&CC, New Delhi.

The Ministry has issued a Notification No. S.O. 804 (E) dated 14th March, 2017 under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to appraise and regularize the projects, already taken up or under implementation without having obtained prior environmental clearance in terms of the provisions of the EIA Notification, 2006 and are therefore identified in violation of the same. The said Notification had given a six months window period i.e. 14.03.2017 to 13.09.2017 for submission of such proposals. Further, In pursuance to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras vide order dated 14.03.2018 in the matter of W.M.P.Nos.3361 and 3362 of 2018 and W.M.P.No.3721 of 2018 in W.P.No.11189 of 2017, MoEF & CC, New Delhi had provided one month additional window period i.e. 14.03.2018 to 13.04.2018 for submission of such proposals.

The committee has observed that these 526 proposals are filed in between the two window periods. In the light of MOEF notifications 14th March 2017, Ministry's Notification dated 8th March, 2018 and OM Nos. Z11013/22/2017-IA.II (M) dated 15th March, 2018, OM No. 22-10/2019 IA.III dated 9th September, 2019 the following is recommended.

As all these proposals are filed between the two window periods and the 9th September 2019 notification provided for lateral entry, EDS may be raised for each proposal seeking

To file Affidavit by the each proponent

Proof of credible action by the appropriate authority.

After receiving the above affidavit and credible action reports, the applications will be taken up in SEAC for appraisal.

The above recommendations of SEAC is placed in 174th SEIAA meeting and decided to **refer** back to SEAC to examine the implications of the SoP issued by MOEF&CC vide OM dated 7.7.2021 on violation cases ,Supreme Court judgment on civil appeal nos 7576-7577 of 2021 and OM dated 28.1.2022 issued by MoEF&CC on violation cases.



In view of the above, the issue is taken up in 180th SEAC committee meeting. The committee after examining the MoEF&CC' Notifications, OMs, including the latest OM dt. 28.01.2022, SOP dated 07-07-2021 and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise EDS for all these 526 violation proposals seeking the following.

- 1. To file Affidavit by each proponent
- 2. Proof of credible action by the appropriate authority.
- 3. Remediation plan with Bank Guarantee
- 4. The proponent is liable to pay the penalties as per the OM dt. 28.1.2022 and clause no 12 of SOP dated 07-07-2021, taking into consideration the project cost, total production and turnover during the violation period.
