Deliberations:

The representative of the project proponent Sri Mohd. Fayazuddin and Sri V. Venkatesh of M/s. Enviro Care India Pvt Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they have obtained EC vide order dt. 07.02.2020 from the SEIAA, TS for mining - 15,806 TPA of quartz & 1,07,659 TPA of feldspar and the life of mine for quartz as 15 years and for feldspar as 9 years. It was informed that they also obtained CFE vide order dt.21.04.2020 and CFO vide order dt. 21.04.2020.

Now, the proponent applied for expansion of EC on 14.08.2023 as there are increasing the production capacity of quartz from 15,806 TPA to 74,846 TPA and decrease in feldspar from 1,07,659 TPA to 80,056 TPA. Hence, it was requested to issue expansion of EC. The proponent submitted certified compliance report dt.07.06.2023 issued by the IRO, MoEF&CC, GoI.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was executed on 28.07.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.26.06.2024 of ADMG, Nagarkurnool District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.76 ha. which is less

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than 5.0 ha. Hence, the project is considered under 'B2' Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of scrutinized/approved mining plan & EMP Report. The nearest village to the proposed site is Chennaram (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.4 km (NE) and water body i.e., Tandur pond exists at a distance of 3.1 km (NW) from the mine lease area. It is proposed to mine 74,846 TPA of Quartz & 80,056 TPA of Feldspar and the life of Quartz mine is reported as 11.3 years and for Feldspar it is 14 years. The source of water requirement for the proposed project is from tankers from nearby villages. The total water requirement is 5.0 KLD. Out of that, 2.3 KLD is used for water sprinkling on haul roads & dump yard, 1.5 KLD is used for development of greenbelt and 1.2 KLD is used for domestic purpose. The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.10 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.70 lakhs/annum. The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt. 26.06.2024 of ADMG, Nagarkurnool District furnishing the details of dispatch permits for the period from 2022-23 to 2024-25 (upto 25.06.2024). The SEAC observed from the letter that the dispatch permits were carried during the period from 2022-23 to 2024-25 (upto 25.06.2024).

The SEAC observed that as per the certified compliance report dt.07.06.2023 issued by the IRO, MoEF&CC, GoI, there are non-compliance of several important conditions imposed in the EC. The SEAC further observed that the proponent has not submitted photographic evidence of CSR activities and not developed greenbelt.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended not to consider EC.

Deliberations:

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Mahipal Reddy and Sri V. Venkatesh of M/s. Enviro Care India Pvt Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was executed on 10.07.2008 in favour of Sri Raireddy Raja Reddy for a period of 10 years. Later, transfer of quarry lease was granted on 06.01.2012 in favour of the proponent for a period upto 09.07.2018. Then, LOI was granted on 06.07.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the mine lease is granted before 09.09.2013. However, the proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt. 20.06.2024 issued by ADMG, Siddipet District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500mts from the proposed mine lease area. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 ha. which is less than 5.0 ha. The project has to be considered under 'B2' Category, but the proponent continued mining activity after expiry of the mine lease without obtaining prior EC and hence it is a violation case, it is considered under 'B1' Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The proponent submitted a copy of scrutinized/approved mining plan & EMP Report. The nearest habitation is Anthakkapet (V) exists at a distance of 0.83 km (N); nearest water body i.e., seasonal canal exists at a distance of 208 mts (S) & katkoor cheruvu exists at a distance of 1.6 km (S) from the mine lease area. It is proposed to mine 55,176 m³/annum of building stone and road metal & the life of mine is reported as 20 years.

The source of water requirement for the proposed project is from tankers from nearby villages. Total water requirement is 5.5 KLD. Out of that, 1.6 KLD is used for water sprinkling on haul roads & dump yard, 1.5 KLD is used for development of greenbelt and 2.4 KLD is used for domestic purpose. The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.15 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.86 lakhs/annum. The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt. 20.06.2024 of ADMG, Siddipet District furnishing the details of production and dispatch permits for the period from 2008-09 to 2023-24 (upto 09.07.2023). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production was carried during the period from 2008-09 to 2021-22 and nil during the period from 2022-23 to 2023-24 (upto 09.07.2023) & the dispatch permits were carried out during the period from 2022-23 to 2023-24 (upto 09.07.2023).

After detailed discussions, the SEAC noted that the case is under violation and the MoEF&CC, GoI vide its OM dt: 08.01.2024 informed that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dt:02.01.2024 stayed the operation of the SOPs issued by MoEF&CC, GoI vide OM dt:07.07.2021 & OM dt:28.01.2022. As the matter is sub-judice the project proponent is requested to resubmit after the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment.

The representative of the project proponent V.V. Raghav Raju; K. Kishore and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued TORs dt.11.10.2021 and also issued EC vide order dt.27.12.2021 for IT buildings and others with total built up area of 1,80,423.5 Sq.m. The proponent informed that they have obtained CFE vide order dt.22.06.2024.

Now, the proponent informed that there is increase in no. of floors due to which there are changes w.r.to. built-up area, super built-up area and no. of floors. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

The proponent submitted a copy of structural stability certificate dt. 23.01.2024 for Tech Mahindra Ltd., (TMTC SEZ), Sy. no. 62/1A, Bahadurpally (V), Dundigal-gandimaisamma (M), Mandal, Medchal- Malkajgiri District. The project consists of SEZ A, B, C and D wings, basement + G + 6 upper floors, D wing basement + G + 4 upper floors including wing E are designed for structural strength and stability confirming to the Indian standard codes and specifications. The provisions proposed of the National building code 2005 have been fully incorporated in the design in relation to the material specifications and codes of practice for construction.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC subject to the following additional conditions in addition to the Specific/Standard/General conditions applicable to the project:

- 1. The proponent shall make an arrangement for O & M contract with operator of the STP for a minimum period of 10 years and shall be extended from time to time.
- 2. The proponent /Builder shall ensure that the environmental issues (Sewage treatment, Solid waste management) shall be addressed continuously.
- 3. The proponent shall ensure that the Sewage generated is properly treated and shall be reused at the maximum extent for gardening/avenue plantation.
- 4. The proponent shall provide LED lights in the project to the maximum extent.
- 5. The proponent shall provide rain water harvesting pits.
- 6. The proponent shall obtain NOC from HMWS&SB or local municipality for water supply and sewerage connection.
- 7. The proponent shall dispose C&D waste as per rules.

Deliberations:

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Madhu and Sri Vinay kumar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they obtained EC vide order dt. 20.06.2013 from the SEIAA, AP for mining 3,240 m³/annum of Colour granite and life of mine is 10 years. It was informed that they also obtained CFE vide order dt.03.12.2015 and CFO & HWA vide order dt.27.09.2022 valid upto 31.05.2023. It was informed that earlier, reserves were estimated/shown very less in the Approved Mining Plan for 10 years due to which even the EC was issued for 10 years only.

The SEAC noted that in the MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221(E), dt. 18.01.2021, it was mentioned that "9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid". With this notification, EC validity is extended up to one year i.e., upto 19.06,2024.

Now, the proponent applied for extension of validity of EC on 19.10.2023 i.e within the validity period of EC. Hence, it was requested to issue extension of EC.

The nearest habitation is Eluvarigudem exists at a distance of 1.10 km (NNW); nearest water body i.e field canal exists at a distance of 0.65 km (E) from the mine lease area. It is proposed to mine production of 3,240 m³/annum of black granite & the life of mine is reported as 5 years. The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.39 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.30 lakhs/annum. The proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.07.06.2024 of the ADMG, Khammam District furnishing the details of dispatch permits for the period from 1997-98 to 2024-25 (up to May). The SEAC observed from the letter that the dispatch permits were carried during the period from 1997-98 to 2007-08; 2009-10; 2010-11 and from 2014-15 to 2018-19 and nil during the period 2008-09; 2011-12 to 2013-14 & from 2019-20 to 2024-25 (upto May). The proponent submitted a copy of CSR certificate dt.22.05.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Beerolu (V), Thirumalaipalem (M), Khammam District informing that the proponent has spent Rs. 1,25,000/- for various developmental activities in the village.

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After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for Extension of validity period of EC with the following conditions in addition to the existing conditions and Specific/Standard/General conditions applicable to the project:

- 1. The proponent shall submit the details of CSR activities carried out along with photographs to IRO.
- 2. The proponent shall transfer money through online/cheque only for CSR activities.
- 3. The proponent shall take up greenbelt in addition to the existing.

Deliberations:

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Santhosh and Sri Vinay Kumar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 03.07.2015 in the name of M/s. Novel granites limited for mining - 222 m³/annum of black granite and the life of mine as 9 years. Later, the proponent obtained transfer of EC vide order dt.08.03.2018 from M/s. Novel granites limited to M/s. Lakshmi granites. It was informed that they also obtained CFO vide order dt.27.04.2018 valid up to 28.02.2023.

The SEAC noted that in the MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221(E), dt. 18.01.2021, it was mentioned that "9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and

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subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid". With this notification, EC validity is extended up to one year i.e., upto 14.10.2024.

Now, the proponent applied for extension of validity of EC on 19.10.2023 with same production capacity. Hence, it was requested to issue extension of validity of EC.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was granted on 22.03.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period up to 14.10.2023. Then, the LOI was granted on 13.10.2023 for a period of 20 years. The nearest village to the proposed site is Redlawada which is existing at a distance of 1.40 km (NW); water body exists at a distance of 0.69 km (SW) and the nearest RF is Ingurti RF exists at a distance of 2.61 km (S) from the mine lease area. It is proposed to mine 222 m³/annum of black granite and the life of mine is reported as 17 years. The total cost of the project is Rs. 60.0 lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 7.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.19 lakhs/annum. The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt. 12.06.2024 of ADMG, Warangal District furnishing the details of dispatch permits for the period from 2003-04 to 2023-24. The SEAC observed from the letter that the dispatch permits were carried during the period from 2004-05 to 2009-10; 2011-12 to 2015-16 and 2022-23. The proponent also submitted a copy of CSR Certificate dt.04.01.2023 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Redlawada (V), Nekkonda (M), Warangal Rural District informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 6,00,000/- for various developmental activities in the village.

The SEAC observed that there are non-compliance of several important conditions imposed in the EC. The SEAC further observed that the proponent has not submitted photographic evidence of CSR activities and not developed greenbelt.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended not to consider EC.

Deliberations:

The representative of the project proponent Sri Rahul Veeravalli and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 06.06.2024 deferred the proposal and directed to address a letter to irrigation department marking copy to GHMC with a request to provide whether the proposed site is falling under musi river buffer or not and the distance from the musi river boundary to site boundary.
