The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 16.09.2022

Agenda Item No. 01	4.0 Ha. Stone and Metal of M/s. Karthikeya Metal Industries, Survey No. 310, Peddarevelly Village, Balanagar Mandal, Mahabubnagar District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Venkat and Sri. G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 15.03.2007 in favour of Sri. S. Venkat Reddy of M/s Laxmi Neeraja Metals for a period of 15 years i.e upto 14.03.2022. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted on 14.06.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Boda Gutta Tanda (V) exists at a distance 0.6 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 0.78 km (SE) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,33,278.4 m³/annum of Stone & Metal and the life of mine is reported as 13 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.14 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.58 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 27.07.2022 of ADMG, Mahabubnagar District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2006-07 to 2021-2022 (i.e upto 14.03.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2007-08 to 2010-2011 & from 2014-15 to 2021-22 (i.e upto 14.03.2022) except during the years 2006-07 & 2011-12 to 2013-14.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.27.07.2022 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Bodagutta Thanda, Balanagar (M), Mahabubnagar District stating that the proponent has donated Rs 2,00,000/- for Construction of Anganwadi Building in the village.

The SEAC informed the proponent to submit the following documents:


- Copy of proceedings of Mining department transferring mine lease from M/s. Laxmi Neeraja Metals to M/s. Kartikeya Metal Industries.
- Status of the mine after 14.03.2022 i.e., Production and despatch permits of the mine duly certified by mining dept., as the details of despatch permits issued upto expiry of lease i.e., 14.03.2022 only were furnished.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent

The representative of the project proponent Sri S.K. Ansar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted (in-principle) on 01.09.2007 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years i.e. from 27.12.2007 to 26.12.2027. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.809 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.


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The nearest village Yenupamula (V) exists at a distance of 1.1 km (E); nearest water body i.e a Canal exists at 0.8 km (SW) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 556 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 53 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.4 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.55 Lakhs/annum.

Earlier, The SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.27.03.2021 for Commercial Mall and Multiplex Construction project with total Built-up area 24,625.2 Sq.m.

Now, the proponent informed that there is change in project profile from commercial mall and Multiplex Construction project to Hospital building construction project due to which there are changes w.r.t increase in total built-up area, Parking area, water requirement, waste water generation, solid waste, STP capacity & EMP cost. The proponent informed that skeleton of the building (foundation, slabs, beams & columns) is completed. Mean while the line of activity changed. It was also informed that few floors of multiplex had much height and presently they proposed mezzanine kind of floor due to which no of floors did not increase, but the total builtup area incresed. The proponent a copy of structural stability certificate dated 17.01.2022 stating that eralier the structure was designed for 2B+S+15 floors and subsequently, the design has been revised for 2B+S+17 floors ensuring structural stability and safety for the building as per N.B.C standards. The representative of the project proponent Sri B.Ashok Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, The SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.03.07.2021 and EC (Amendment) vide order dt. 18.08.2021 for Residential Apartments Construction project with total Built-up area 5,25,870.5 Sq.m.

Now, the proponent informed that due to change in the project profile there is increase in built-up area, No. of units, No. of floors, water requirement, waste water generation, solid waste, STP capacity & EMP cost it was informed that presently footings are started for 2 blocks only and remaining blocks are under excavation stage. The proponent a copy of structural stability certificate dated 01.09.2022 stating that eralier the structure was designed for 4B+G+41 floors and subsequently, the design has been revised for 4B+G+43 floors ensuring structural stability and safety for the building as per N.B.C standards. During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 21.01.2021 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 553.15 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 773.15 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of amendment to EC.

The SEAC noted that total area is 6,685.1 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 693.8 Sq.m. (10.4%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 34,240.3 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 103 units including ammenities. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 1 Block (C + 3S + 8 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 11,771.6 Sq.m., (52.4% against required 22%).

In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt. 12.07.2022 from I&CAD Dept., of the SE, Irrigation Circle, Hyderabad. It is observed from the document that the applicant's land is not affected in Irrigation Channel area, but Ac 00-002 Gts is affected in its bufferzone 2.00 Mts width, the applicant's balance land Ac 03.37-.2 Gts in not affected in any water body / Canal / Vagu and it is free from water body, as per norms stipulated in the G.O. Ms No.168 dt.07.04.2012 of MA&UD dept. Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project. The proponent also submitted HMDA approval copy vide Lr. dt. 17.12.2020 for Existing Building (B+S+5 floors) with builtup area < 20,000 Sq.m. Now, the proponent proposed expansion of the project.

The SEAC noted that total area is 16,229.6 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 1628.6 Sq.m. (10%)

It was informed the total built up area of the project is 99,239.2 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 460 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Tower - (2B + S + 10 Floors) & Amenities (2B + G + 4 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 30,761.0 Sq.m., (44.9% against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 160 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 289.3 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs.8.1 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.23.5 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.83.4 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 02.01.2008 in favour of the proponent and the lease was executed on 11.03.2008 for a period of 15 years i.e upto 10.03.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The project proponent submitted a copy of Approved Mining Plan & EMP report.

The nearest village Deshmukhi (V) exists at a distance 1.08 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e. Musi River exists at 4.3 km (N). Nearest RF is Jalalpur RF exists at 3.8 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,07,400 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 18 years.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 08.07.2022 deferred the project and informed that proponent to submit Revised Cluster letter issued by the Mining Department covering details of all mines located within 500 mts from the mine lease area and also NOC from DFO, Forest Department duly mentioning distance of RF from the proposed mine lease area.

Now, the proponent submitted reply to ADS on 19.08.2022 online. The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.16.08.2022 of the ADMG, Rangareddy District informing that there are 2 existing quarry leases (Ac. 20.0 - amalgamation of leases granted before 09.09.2013) & (1.589 Ha. - lease granted after 09.09.2013 – lease granted for allied activity, not for quarrying purpose) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is observed that the total clulster area is 13.682 Ha & Net Cluster area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha and hence, the SEAC consider the project under B2 category. The proponent also submitted a copy of letter dt.03.08.2022 from Forest Divisional Officer, Amangal Division, Rangareddy District. It is observed from the letter that, the land does not fall in the Reserve Forest of Gummadvally Reserve Forest Block and it is located at the distance of 50 m and also stated that there is no disturbance occurs for wildlife.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Ltd., for a period of 15 years i.e upto 21.09.2022. Subsequently, the lease was transferred on 15.10.2012 in favour of the proponent for un-expired period of lease i.e 21.09.2022. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 24.06.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.640 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

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The nearest village Ramalingampally (V) exists at a distance 860 m (E) from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e. Ramalingampally Cheruvu exists at 505 m (SE); and nearest RF is Keshavpur RF exists at a distance of 1.42 km (SE) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,36,920.0 m³/annum (Average Production – 1,35,523.20 m³/annum) of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 15.5 years (@1,35,523.20 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.5 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 21.07.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2007-08 to 2021-2022. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2007-08 to 2013-14 & 2016-17 to 2017-18 and no permits were issued during 2014-15; 2015-16 & from 2018-19 to 2021-22.

The proponent submitted self certified Compliance Report.

Lease was renewed vide G.O.Ms. No. 146, Industries & Commerce Department, dated: 06.05.1999 for a further period of 20 years. The ADMG, Nalgonda issued work orders on 03.11.1999 and the lease period is up to 24.09.2017. The ADMG, Nalgonda vide Lr. No. 1197/M2/1996, Dated: 24.04.2013 has submitted proposals to the Director of Mines & Geology, Hyderabad recommending for declaring the Mining Lease for Quartz lapsed under Rule 28 (1) of Mineral Concessions Rules, 1960 as the lease is non-working and not obtaining dispatch permits since 2005. The Department of Industries and Commerce (Mines II) Department after careful examination of the matter and in the exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28(A) (3) of Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 vide Memo No. 199/M. II (1)/2014-1 Dated: 25.02.2015 revive the mining lease and accorded permission. The proponent obtained permit from Dept. of Mines & Geology, Nalgonda vide Permit No. 32/Major/2015-16 Dated: 08.12.2015 for transportation of the Quartz from the mine lease area with a validity period up to 06.01.2016. The DMG: Hyderabad vide notice dt.23.06.2017 part surrender of 1.2 Ha from existing quarr lease area (i.e., 25.90 Ha. - 1.20 Ha.) theretained area for quarry lease is 24.70 Ha only. Subsequently, the Proponent obtained 2nd renewal of quarry lease over extent of 24.70 Ha. and later the DMG: Hyderabad has granted in-principle approval vide notice dt.23.03.2018.

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The SEAC noted that the lease is granted before 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 24.7 Ha which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA issued TORs on 17.06.2020 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 26.03.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representations that the issues emerged during public hearing are: health problems; cracks to walls of Houses dueto blasting; death of Cattle due to mining operations, etc., The SEAC observed that almost all the speakers opposed the project, whereas the proponent submitted copies of few representations supporting the project.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Agraharakacharam (V) which is existing at a distance of 270 mts; nearest water body i.e., Pond near Agraharakacharam exists at 230 mts (N) & Mudigonda RF exists at 9.8 kms from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 47,583.60 TPA of Quartz including 7513. 20 TPA of Ferruginous quartz and the life of mine is reported as 32 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs.2.40 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 24.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 10.0 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that the proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 08.04.2022 of ADMG, Nalgonda furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 1993-94 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during 1993-94, 1994-95, 1996-97 to 2003-04, 2005-06 & 2015-16 and dispatch permits were not issued during 1995-96, 2004-05, 2006-07 to 2014-15, 2016-17 to 2021-22.

The proponent informed that State Government has initiated credible action against the proponent vide CC No. 618 of 2022 was filed in the Hon'ble Jr. Civil Courts, Devaraknda and submitted copies of supporting documents.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted revised Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is Low. The proponent informed that the initial lease was granted Procds. dt.06.01.2009 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0971 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Porlkunta Thanda (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.91 km; nearest water body i.e., a Canal exists at 1.6 km & Gundamal Kunta exists at 1.8 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,21,877.25 TPA of Quartz & 77,558.25 TPA of Feldspar and the life of mine is reported as 9 years @ 1,99,435.50 TPA.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 9.1 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.4 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Lt.dt.10.05.2022 of ADMG, Narayanpet District informing the details of dispatch particals for the period 2013-14 to 2022 (upto 10.05.2022). It is observed that the dispatch permits for feldspar were issued during 2013-14 to 10.05.2022 except during 2019-20 and dispatch permits for quartz were issued during 2018-19, 2019-20, 2021-2022, 2022 (upto 10.05.2022) except during 2013-14 to 2017-18 & 2020-21.

The proponent submitted a copy of certificate dt.18.06.2022 issued by the sarpanch of gram pancayat of porlakunta thanda (V) stating that the proponent laid mud roads (4 Km), provided electric poles including wiring, paid electricity bill for 2 years, donated bore with motors to fulfill water needs of animals, etc.,.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.
