The 57th meeting of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), Assam held on 18th March 2023 from 11-00 a.m. onward in the Conference Hall of the State Pollution Control Board, Assam, Bamunimaidam, Guwahati-21. At the outset the Chairman Sri S K Seal Sarma welcomes all the members of the Committee present and called the meeting in order. The Chairman initiated the discussion as per the agenda circulated on 17th March 2023.

Points to be discussed:

- (a) Minutes of the 56th SEAC meeting held on 4thMarch.2023 is to be approved.
- (b) Altogether 25 nos. of proposals are included in the agenda for appraisal and deliberation including presentation on two nos. of project proposals.

Agenda item- 1. Confirmation of the resolutions adopted the 56th meeting of SEAC, Assam. Resolution 56/1:

The minutes of 56th of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), Assam's meeting held on 4th March, 2023 from 11-00 a.m. onward in the Conference Hall of the State Pollution Control Board, Assam, Bamunimaidam, Guwahati-21 is placed before the Hon'ble Members for their perusal and deliberation.  Proposal requesting amendment of EC for mining of Ordinary Clay from "Barkhanajan Ordinary Clay Mining Permit Area" under North Kamrup Forest Division Proposed by Sri Babul Boro. SEIAA.2013/2022(SIA/AS/MIN/297138/2023).

Resolution 57/2:

The project proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary clay from the "Barkhanajan Ordinary Clay Mining Permit Area" under North Kamrup Forest Division Proposed by Sri Babul Boro is placed before the SEAC for review, appraisal and detail deliberation. The proposal was initially discussed in detail in the 55th SEAC meeting held on 18th Feb. 2022 and EC granted allowing to extract 2650 cu.m. ordinary clay within one-year period considering the condition given by the Water Resources Department. But, the proponent made an appeal asking approval of the extractable quantity as approved in the Mining Plan. Accordingly, the proposal was placed in the 55th SEAC meeting for deliberation. The committee after deliberation resolved to get clarification being ADS from the E.E. Water Resource Division, Nalbari relating to approval on depth of mining. Now, the E.E. Water Resource Division, Nalbari clarified the issue communicating vide letter No. WR/NLB/N-13/2008/231 dated 3rd March 2023 which has been deliberated in the meeting. The committee after due deliberation recommended amendment of the EC approving to extract additional 52862 c.m. [55512 u.m. - 2650 cu.m. (already granted) =52862 Cu.m.] ordinary clay from the proposed mining area with validity of the EC up to 30th June 2023 subject to the condition that the maximum mining depth is recommended up to two (2) meters from the existing ground surface. The proponent shall have to complete extraction of minable materials within 30th June 2023 strictly following all other terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan as the terms and condition of the previous EC granted on 30th June 2022 will remain unchanged.

The Divisional Forest Officer, North Kamrup Forest Division, Rangia is requested to mount due and regular surveillances on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. The DFO is also requested to arrange marking of the approved mining area on the ground fixing permanent boundary pillars before starting mining activities as mining is strictly permitted only within the approved mining site and not beyond the limit of the same. He will further ensure that necessary compliance of the terms and condition laid down in the EC be duly complied by the proponent in course of mining operation.

 Proposal requesting modification of EC for mining of ordinary earth from the "Patta land ordinary earth mining permit area" at Kamarkuchi Nonkey of Kamrup East Forest Division under Kamrup Metro District proposed by Protech Buildcon Private Limited. (SEIAA. 1131/2020), (SIA/AS/MIN/294162/2023).

Resolution 57/3:

The proposal asking modification of the EC for mining of Ordinary Earth from the "Patta land ordinary earth mining permit area" at Kamarkuchi Nonkey of Kamrup East Forest Division under Kamrup Metro District proposed by Protech Buildcon Private Limited is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and detail discussion. Area of the proposed project is 2.024 hect. On scrutiny it reveals that EC was granted

previously allowing extraction of 50000 cu.m. ordinary earth within a period of 540 days i.e one & half year vide this office letter No. SEIAA.131/2020/EC/18/1036 dad29th Feb.202. The proponent has explained that due to Covid situation prevailed at that time and such mining of earth was suspended by the District Administration, Kamrup Metropolitan District communicated vide letter No. KMJ.139/2019/42 dated 24th Dec.2020 he failed to execute the approved mining work in time and hence modification is sought. This proposal has also been discussed in the 51st SEAC meeting and asked for certain additional information. Accordingly, the proponent has furnished required information along with copy of the order withdrawing banned on mining communicated by the District Magistrate, Kamrup Metropolitan District communicated vide letter No. KMJ.39/2023/263 dated 1st March 2023. Having detailed deliberation, the committee recommended the modification proposal approving to extract 50000 cu.m. ordinary earth from the aforesaid mining area within a period one (1) year. All other terms and condition laid down in the previous EC granted on 29th Feb.2020 will remain unchanged and the proponent shall have strictly follow all the terms and condition during the proposed mining operation.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Kamrup East Forest Division, Basistha, Guwahati is requested to mount due and regular surveillances on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. The DFO is also requested to arrange marking of the approved mining area on the ground fixing permanent boundary pillars before starting mining activities as mining is strictly permitted only within the approved mining site and not beyond the limit of the same. He will further ensure that necessary compliance of the terms and condition laid down in the EC be duly complied by the proponent in course of mining operation.

- (b) Requirement of total minable materials for five years is 24080 cu.m. as per approved mining plan. On the other hand, minable reserved estimated up to 3 meters' depth is on 5 hect area is above 73000 cu.m. Why such large area for mining is chosen for extraction of comparatively smaller quantity of minable materials? Required quantity could have been managed from an area less than five hect. The DFO, Chirang is requested to furnish suitable reply on the above discussed points.
