Minutes of the 39<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), Assam held in the Conference Hall of the Pollution Control Board, Assam, Guwahati-21 at 11:00 A.M. on 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.

The Chairman, SEAC, Assam Sri S. K. Seal Sarma presided over the meeting. Welcoming all the Hon'ble members, the Chairman expressed the objective of the meeting and stated that 21 nos. of project proposal is included in the agenda inclusive of presentation on one project proposal. The Chairman, SEAC, Assam started the proceeding for open deliberation as per agenda note.

**Agenda item- 1: Confirmation of the resolutions adopted the 38<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC, Assam.**

**Resolution 38/1:**

The minutes of the 38<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 is placed before the Hon'ble Members for perusal and necessary discussion. The minutes are discussed and after a brief discussion the same is approved unanimously.

**Agenda item- 2:**

- 1. Proposal for extension of EC for mining of Sand & Gravel from the "Durpang River Mining Contract Are for Sand & Gravel" under Lakhimpur Division Forest proposed by Sri Bishnu Borah SEIAA.3035/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/271957/2022).**

**Resolution 39/2:**

The project proposal asking for extension the validity of the EC against mining of Sand & Gravel from "Durpang River Mining Contract Are for Sand & Gravel" under Lakhimpur Division Forest proposed by Sri Bishnu Borah is appraised in the SEAC meeting. Necessary documents including the EC granted earlier on 9<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2017, half yearly compliance reports, and status report on mining furnished by the concerned DFO and approved Mining Plan is discussed in detail. After thread bare discussion and considering the conditions laid down in the original EC,

the committee recommended the extension proposal approving to extract sand & gravel 1800 cu.m each from the approved mining area till 8<sup>th</sup> August 2024 with the condition that maximum quantity of sand & gravel is approved to extract in a year 1500 cu.m. each. The proponent shall have to follow all other terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Lakhimpur Forest Division will ensure due surveillances to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure to take necessary measures so that mining is not allowed beyond the limit of the approved mining site and the proponent comply with the terms and condition as specified during the mining period.

**Agenda item- 2.**

2. **Proposal of extension of EC from "Residential Complex 'Harmony Naturals' at village Azara & Mikirpara Chakardoi, Dist.Kamrup, Assam; Proposed for revision to Residential Villas & Row Housing Complex "Resort Residences" proposed by SKRE Building Future Private Limited. SEIAA.1949./2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/244917/2022).**

**Resolution 39/3:**

The proposal for extension of EC for **"Residential Complex 'Harmony Naturals' at village Azara & Mikirpara Chakardoi, Dist.Kamrup, Assam proposed for revision to Residential Villas & Row Housing Complex "Resort Residences" proposed by SKRE Building Future Private Limited** is placed before the SEAC for review and appraisal. It was resolved in the 31<sup>st</sup> SEAC meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2022 to conduct a site inspection to the proposed construction site. Accordingly the subcommittee of SEAC inspected the site on 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 and submitted their report 30<sup>th</sup> May 2022. The observation of the subcommittee is discussed in detailed and the committee needs the following additional information to review the project proposal.

On the basis of field inspection and interaction with the PP, the following observations have been made and suggestions given :

- 1) *The detail of project plan including the drainage including storm water discharge is required.*
- 2) *Rainwater harvesting plan, including the detail design of the rainwater harvesting unit, their dimension, boring size, and targeted aquifer layer should be given.*
- 3) *Details of Land use / land cover map in a 500-meter buffer on 1: 500 scale map composition using high resolution (less than 5 meter, preferably 1 meter spatial resolution) standard FCC of satellite images not older than 3 years from the date of acquisition is required.*
- 4) *Details of all drainage in the 500-meter buffer zone should be delineated in a separate map on 1:500 scale map composition.*
- 5) *The approach road width and traffic density on the road should be estimated.*
- 6) *Sewage treatment and discharge plan should be detailed.*
- 7) *Construction has already started as seen in the photograph given below.*

The proponent is requested to furnish the aforesaid information at their earliest for taking further requisite action at this end.

- 3. Proposal of EC for mining of sand from “Disang River Sand Mining Permit Area, Rongarahghat, under Sivasagar Division proposed by Mekong Engineering and Infrastructures Private Limited. SEIAA 2040/2022. (SIA/AS/MIN/252337/2022).**

**Resolution 39/4:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of sand from **“Disang River Sand Mining Permit Area, Rongarahghat”** under Sivasagar Division proposed by **Mekong Engineering and Infrastructures Private Limited** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Necessary documents are scrutinized and appraised. Detailed discussion is held. Approved Mining Plan and report of the concerned DFO is also discussed. The committee after detailed deliberation recommended the proposal approving *to extract 1000 cu.m. sand from the proposed mining site within a period of one (1) year with the condition that mining depth is approved 1.0 meter and mining is allowed leaving a distance of 10 (ten) meter from the high rise of the river bank to avoid probable bank erosion.* The proponent shall have to strictly follow all other terms and condition laid down in the approved Mining Plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Sivasagar Forest Division is requested to ensure due surveillance to guard against occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure that the mining be permitted only within the proposed site and not beyond the limit of the same.

- 4. Proposal asking EC for collection of Ordinary Clay from “Outside Dikhow River Ordinary Clay Mining Permit Area, Boliaghat” under Sivasagar Division proposed by Sk.Jual Ali. SEIAA.2019/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/ 252341/2022)**

**Resolution 39/5:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary clay from the **“Outside Dikhow River Ordinary Clay Mining Permit Area, Boliaghat”** under Sivasagar Division proposed by **Sk.Jual Ali** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Documents submitted by the proponent in support of his project proposal are scrutinized thoroughly. Area shown in the KML file is examined. The proposed mining site is selected covering both the high bank and river bed of Dikhow River. It is observed that 3/4<sup>th</sup> the proposed mining site falls on the high bank of the river. Mining on that situation may bring serious threat to river bank erosion. After due deliberation and considering all the aspects **the committee declined to recommend the project proposal.**

**Resolution 39/6:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary clay from **“Outside Dikhow River Ordinary Clay Mining Permit Area, (K), Samshanghat”** under Sivasagar Division proposed by **Sri Gobin Baruah** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Necessary scrutiny of

the documents is scrutinized. Approved mining plan, report of the DFO and requisite maps are discussed. The demarcation of the *Samshanghat* is not shown in the map with relation to the proposed mining site. After due deliberation the committee needs the following additional information for consideration of the project proposal.

- Samshanghat area should be shown in a map with relation to the proposed mining site.
- *Opinion of the concerned Water Resources Department is sought relating to mining in the proposed mining site.*

#### **Resolution 39/7:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of Sand from “**Buridehing River Sand Mining Permit Area, (Kotoha Nagaon)**” under Dibrugarh Division proposed by **Sri Kamala Kanta Baruah** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Necessary documents including KML file, approved Mining Plan and recommendation of the concerned DFO is discussed. Due deliberation is held. The committee after thorough deliberation recommended the proposal to *extract 14000 cu.m sand from the proposed mining site within a period of two years subject to the condition that 20 (twenty) meters distance from the nearest high rise bank should be kept as a non mining zone.* The proponent is permitted to *extract 7000 cu.m sand from the proposed site annually* strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dibrugarh Forest Division is requested to ensure due surveillance to guard against occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure that the mining be permitted only within the proposed site and not beyond the limit of the same. Compliance of the terms and condition by the proponent has to be ensured by the concerned DFO.

#### **Resolution 39/8:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary clay from “**Dikhow River Ordinary Clay Mining Permit Area (N), Boliaghat**” under Sivasagar proposed by **Sri Bijoy Das** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and necessary discussion. Document furnished by the proponent in support of the proposal are scrutinized. Approved mining plan and recommendation of the concerned DFO is discussed in detailed. Due deliberation is held and the committee recommended the proposal approving to *extract 2600 cu.m. ordinary clay from the proposed mining site within a period of two years subject to the condition that the proposed mining site should be shifted 20 meters towards the river channel leaving the distance from the nearest high bank as non mining zone.* The proponent is permitted to *extract 1300 cu.m ordinary clay per year* strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.





The Divisional Forest Officer, Sivasagar Forest Division is requested to ensure due surveillance to guard against occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure that the mining be permitted only within the proposed site and not beyond the limit of the same. Compliance of the terms and condition by the proponent has to be ensured by the concerned DFO.

**Resolution 39/9:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of boulder from “**1.5 Ha Upper Dikrong Boulder Mining Permit Area**” under Lakhimpur Forest Division proposed by **Shivam Transcon Private Limited** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal, review and deliberation. Appraised the replies furnished on both EDS & ADS on this proposal. Detailed discussion is held. The committee after thread bare discussion recommended the project proposal to *extract 3000 cu.m boulder in a period of two years from the proposed mining site considering mining depth 2.0 meter and 64 % of boulder out of total reserved minerals.* The proponent is permitted to *extract 1500 cu.m boulder annually* strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Lakhimpur Forest Division is requested to ensure due surveillance to guard against occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure that the mining be permitted only within the proposed site and not beyond the limit of the same. Compliance of the terms and condition by the proponent has to be ensured by the concerned DFO.

- 9. Proposal for “Construction of Proposed New Medical College at Shivsagar (Charaideu) District, Assam proposed by PWD Building Division, Shivsagar, Assam. SEIAA.3046/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/ 237864/2022).**

**Resolution 39/10:**

The project proposal requesting EC for “**Construction of Proposed New Medical College at Shivsagar (Charaideu) District, Assam**” proposed by **the PWD Building Division, Shivsagar, Assam** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and deliberation. Documents furnished by the proponent in support of the project proposal are scrutinized and appraised. In the mean time, the proponent was invited to give a detailed presentation relating to the proposed project before the SEAC, Assam. Accordingly, the proponent along with their consultant gave presentation in the meeting. Detailed discussion is held in presence of the proponent. The committee requires the below mentioned additional information for further processing of the proposal and the proponent has agreed to furnish the same within shortest possible time.

- (i) *A shape file of the project site should be provided delineating the categories of (a) Green area (b) Building area & (c) Campus road.*
- (ii) *Methodology of estimation of waste generation and procedures adopted in these estimations need to be detailed.*
- (iii) *All information and analysis in the reports should contain supporting documents and factual records.*

- (iv) *Land Cover/ Land Use (LCLU) map should be made on 1: 50000 using high resolution satellite image and classification on 1:5000 should be as per NRSC level-III classification scheme. A detail report on LCLU should be provided in the report.*
- (v) *A detail waste water plan with report and supporting design plan and document need to be submitted.*
- (vi) *All the drainage of the project site and its surroundings to a radius of 2 k.m. be shown in a map separately. The drainage outlet of the project area to its outside drainage should be marked.*
- (vii) *The land use/ land cover maps should be made from standard false colour composite of satellite image whose acquisition date should not be older than 3 years and resolutions about 5 meter or less.*
- (viii) *The scale of land use/land cover and drainage map of 2 k.m. radius should be 1:5000 and for 10 k.m. radius land use/land cover map the scale should be 1:50000.*
- (ix) *Details of rain water harvesting plan, estimation of rain water volume, rain water harvesting pit design, target aquifers, filtration, removal of bio-contamination, estimation of recharge volume should be included in the report.*
- (x) *Details of sound, air, water, soil sampling sites should be given including site photographs with GPS camera.*
- (xi) *Topographic contour map of the project site is to be submitted.*

- 1) *The land boundary of the project is not delineated with boundary, rather it is within a larger area bounded by boundary walls (as stated by the PP during the site visit that the area within the boundary is 10 Bigha).*
- 2) *Well defined boundary of the project site is required.*
- 3) *Details of Land use / land cover map in a 500-meter buffer on 1: 500 scale map composition using high resolution (less than 5 meter, preferably 1 meter spatial resolution) standard FCC of satellite images not older than 3 years from the date of acquisition is required.*



- 4) *Details of all drainage in the 500-meter buffer zone should be delineated in a separate map on 1:500 scale map composition.*
- 5) *The approach road width and traffic density on the road should be estimated.*
- 6) *Land documents of only the project site should be given.*
- 7) *The green belt should be calculated and marked within the project area, demarcated and details of indigenous plants to be planted should be listed.*
- 8) *The project's construction work has started as CTE is already given by the PCB Assam.*




