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I. GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS:

112-A: Issues related to EIA Notification 2006 violation cases in Mining projects in Andhra Pradesh under Category 'B' projects.

- i. In the SEAC, A.P. meetings held in September 2017 & October 2017 the committee noted that some of the project proponents' violation cases, the credible action was initiated and submitted the copy of the counterfoil of penalty in the Hon'ble Courts at district level.
- ii. The Committee opined that the credible action for EIA - 2006 violations, against this mine was initiated, before the issue of procedure on violation cases by MoEF&CC, New Delhi (i.e before 14th March 2017) and hence recommended for issue of EC. Also the aforesaid notification dated 14th March 2017 was challenged before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras vide W.P.No.11189/2017 and W.P.M.P.No. 12134/2017. The Hon'ble High Court has stayed the Notification in the month of May, 2017.
- iii. The Committee recommended for issue of Environmental clearance to those mining projects without prejudice to the orders/directions of the Supreme Court/any Hon'ble High Courts/NGT etc.
- iv. The SEIAA,A,P. in its meetings held on 04.10. 2017 & 10.10.2017 and it was decided that this aspect to be examined legally and hence deferred.
- v. The Hon'ble High Court , Chennai disposed the case on 13th October 2017 , given the judgment in W.P.No.11189/2017 and W.P.M.P.No. 12134/2017.
- vi. Further, recently the MoEF&CC, Govt.of India, New Delhi, for the violation cases in reply to the project proponent's proposal applied for Terms of Reference/ Environmental Clearance as per provisions of notification vide S.O. S.O.804(E) dated 14.03.2017 involving violation of the EIA Notification, 2006, requested the project proponent that they **are required to first approach the Mines and Geology Department of the State Government for certification regarding payment of 100% cost of illegally mined mineral to the State Government in terms of the section 21(5) of the MMDR Act, 1957. The amount so payable to the State Government for the ore/mineral, would inter-alia, account for the mining operations in violations. Further directed to obtain the No Objection Certificate from the Mines and Geology Department of the State Government, in respect of settlement of all the amount payable against the identified violations (mentioned in para 4 above), in terms of provisions under section 21(5) of the MMDR Act, 1957, and as observed and directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in their judgment dated 2nd August, 2017 in WP No 114/2014 in the matter of 'Common Cause Vs UoI'.**
- vii. The SEAC,A,P and SEIAA, A,P unanimously decided that the violation cases of EIA Notification 2006 of mining project proposals **which were deferred** in the earlier SEAC,A,P & SEIAA,A,P meetings held in September 2017 and October 2017, shall be informed to approach the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Govt. of. India, New Delhi for further consideration *for consideration of ToR/EC in pursuance of the Notification .S.O. S.O.804(E) ,dated 14th March, 2017.*
