Agenda item No. 12.2.1: Consideration of Site Inspection Report for Establishment of Solid Waste Management System at Lunglei by UD&PA.

From the site inspection report, the Solid Waste Management Facility of Lunglei which is around 8 km from Lunglei town situated at Riangvai Thlanmual covers around 2-3 Ha. It is the only waste management area recognized by the Government of Mizoram presently utilized by the whole town as there is no other alternative, which is a population of 161,428 (as per the 2011 census). After thorough consideration and deliberation of the agenda, it was found that the Solid Waste Management Facility of Lunglei needs to be operational as soon as possible because:

1. The present facility is not in conformity with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
2. The waste burned in the area set off fire outbreak caused forest area every year has become problematic to the environment.
3. The dumping area ends at the creek which joins a small stream which then joins other rivers. This may cause nuisance to the water body.
4. There is no proper infrastructure for the management of waste.

The meeting recommended the following points to be incorporated in the TOR.

1. A retaining wall should be built to check the dispersal of waste to other areas.
2. Fire breakout due to burning of wastes should be controlled to stop further outbreak of uncontrolled fire to the adjoining areas. Fire control plan must be incorporated in the TOR

On scrutiny and examination of the site inspection report, the meeting found no violation of EIA Notification, 2006, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, C.R.Z. Notification, 2011 etc.
