The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 21.07.2022

The representative of the project proponent Sri D. Srinivas Raju and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, Mamidipally (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 40,860.6 Sq.m., Net plot area is 31,094.2 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 3136.9 Sq.m. (10.1%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 30,744.0 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas to accommodate 121 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Villas (G + 2 Floors) and Amenities Block (G + 2 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided with two car parking spaces in each Villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs.140.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 148.29 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 3.60 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 9.67 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 47.71 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Praneeth Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 12,708.4 Sq.m., Net plot area is 10,628.3 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 1,068.9 Sq.m. (10.1%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 51,709.6 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments with 5 Blocks (A – E) to accommodate 287 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 2C + G + 9 Floors and Amenities Block (2C + G + 3 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 13,761.8 Sq.m., (36.3% against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.80.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 221.8 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 5.9 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 18.4 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 55.4 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

<b>Agenda Item No. 03</b>	<b>M/s. Virchow Petrochemical Private Limited (Formerly M/s Ambuja Petrochemicals Limited), Plot No. 17 A, IDA, Phase-I Patancheru, Sangareddy District. (Formerly Medak District). - Environmental Clearance - Reg.</b>
<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/IND3/78202/2022 (EC)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri C. Subba Reddy and Sri P.V. Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- M/s. Virchow Petrochemical Pvt. Ltd., was incorporated in June, 2003 and the industry was purchased from M/s. Ambuja Petrochemicals, Lt., unit in Patancheru through the Official Liquidator, Hon'ble High court of Andhra Pradesh (combined State) Hyderabad. It was also informed that the industry was involved in manufacturing of organic chemicals and established their unit in 1988. Further, the industry was renamed as M/s. Virchow Petrochemical Private Limited.
- As there was no requirement of environmental clearance at that time, the unit obtained CFO from the State Pollution Control Board under Water & Air Acts. After the unit takeover by M/s. Virchow Petrochemical Private Limited continued the manufacturing of existing two chemicals i.e., Phthalic Anhydride and Fumaric Acid.
- The industry obtained CFE from State Pollution Control Board for change of product mix under "No increase in pollution load" concept by reducing the production quantities of Phthalic Anhydride and Fumaric Acid and added GCLE which is also used as chemical in pharma industries.
- CFE for change of product mix is granted by TSPCB in the year 2016 Also unit obtained CFO for these changes vide CFO order TSPCB/CFO/SRD/HO/2018- 545 dated 11.05.2018.
- VPCL modernized its plant by adding Zero Liquid discharge unit in 2015 and added 20 TPH boiler with 2.6 MW co-gen unit.
- As these activities are not covered under EC category as per SO No. 1834(E) dated 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 the unit approached Pollution Control Board for amendments.
- Also due to recovery of various other useful products, the Bi- products like Potassium Chloride and Spent HCl are added under Bi-Products category.
- Due to continuous efforts for reducing odor nuisance the unit established 12 multi stage scrubbing units and treating this waste in ZLD system which consists of Stripper, Evaporators and ATFD.
- Due to implementation of ZLD and other environmental improvement measures, the organic Residues are increased
- Similarly Spent Mixed solvents are generated to a tune of 6760 Kg/Day and Stripper wastes from waste treatment plants is 5400 Kg/Day.
- Based on the directions of the TS Pollution Control Board task force, VPCL approached Board for inclusion of these additional wastes generated from the treatment systems and inclusion of new boiler and co-gen plant in the CFE and CFO.
- After long deliberations TS Pollution Control Board directed us to obtain for Environmental Clearance for the inclusion of the changes though there is no increase in production quantities or production category.
- This application is made for obtaining EC for Changes in wastes quantities and for inclusion of Utilities.
- As per the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification S.O.1533 on 14th Sept, 2006, issued by Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India, the proposed Synthetic organic Chemicals Manufacturing facility is categorized as Category-B project, and comes under Schedule S.No. Item 5(f) which mandates obtaining prior Environmental Clearance from MOEF, Govt. of India.
- The proposal is in line with G.O.Ms. No 64 and proposed ZLD System for treatment of effluents.

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The proponent submitted self certified Compliance Report.

The SEAC noted that the SEIAA issued TORs (Auto generated) on 16.06.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The SEAC noted that the proposal is for grant of EC for change in wastes and utilities.

The SEAC noted the G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007 of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP; G.O.Ms. No. 64, dt. 25.07.2013 & G.O.Ms. No. 24, dt.24.04.2019. of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP.

During presentation, the proponent informed that there will not be any change in the production capacity, changes are primarily for the addition of By-products and changes in Hazardous waste generated and inclusion of boiler and few associated activities.

The SEAC noted the contents of the EIA report and noted the details of the project as follows:

Total area is Ac. 45.143, out of which Green area is Ac.18.05 (39.99%).

Nearest human habitation is Patancheru (V) @ 1.59 km; Nearest water body is Child Cheruvu @ 1.66 km; and nearest RF is Kodakanchi RF exists at a distance of 8.2 km from the industry.

Project Cost for proposed is Rs. 176.71 Crores. Budget for Environmental protection towards Capital Cost is Rs. 925.0 Lakhs and Recurring Cost is Rs. 153.0 Lakhs/annum. Budget for CER is Rs. 650.0 lakhs in first 5 years.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Satyanarayana and Sri P.V. Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 1.0803 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 6.2m to 6.6m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 1.0m, as per joint inspection report.

It is proposed to mine 10,803m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Siddapur (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.3 km from the boundary of the sand reach.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 15.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 2.9 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.55 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Satyanarayana and Sri P.V. Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.046 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 6.1m to 6.6m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 1.0m, as per joint inspection report.

It is proposed to mine 40,470 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Mandarna (V) which is existing at a distance of 2.85 km from the boundary of the sand reach.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.65 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Satyanarayana and Sri P.V. Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is Ac. 4.39 Gts. (2.013 Ha.) which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 6.3m to 6.9m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 1.0m, as per joint inspection report.

It is proposed to mine 20,127 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Sunkini (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.735 km from the boundary of the sand reach

The total cost of the project is Rs. 15.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 2.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.55 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Ravinder and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, AP issued EC vide order dt.29.11.2012 with production capacity of 4,080 m<sup>3</sup>/annum for validity upto 20 years. The proponent has exceeded the production since mine inception.

The proponent informed that the initial lease was granted on 25.02.2011 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.30 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category. But as it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category, as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) on 28.05.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the project proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded on 11.07.2022.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Saiganipally (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.59 km; nearest water body i.e., Balaiahpally exists at 1.58 km (SW) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 51,510 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 16 years (@ 1,00,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.6 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.19.07.2022 of ADMG, Karimnagar district furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2012-13 to 2022-23 (upto 11.07.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2012-13 to 2021-22 and no permits were issued during 2022-23 (upto 11.07.2022).

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.18.07.2022 issued by Sarpanch of Thimmapur (M), Karimnagar District stating that the proponent has donated Rs 4,70,000/- for Drinking water, sports items in primary school, benches at Panchayath office & school premises, plantation surrounding primary school and temple development of village.

The SEAC noted that it is a project under violation and hence considered the proposal as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and OM dt. 07.07.2021 & 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. processing of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is High. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan is worked out to be Rs. 12,38,000/- and the details are as following:

The SEAC noted that the SEIAA addressed a letter to the State Government to take action against the project proponent under the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and further no consent to operate to be issued till the project is granted EC. But, the SEAC observed that the proponent has not provided any evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of evidence for credible action taken by the State Government against the project proponent on violation.

It is noted that the mine lease area is Ac.9.38 Gts. (4.026 Ha.) which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 6.2m to 6.8m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 1.0m, as per joint inspection report.

It is proposed to mine 40,261 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Karegaon (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.566 km from the boundary of the Sand reach.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Ravinder and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, AP issued EC vide order dt.29.11.2012 with production capacity of 1,091 m<sup>3</sup>/annum for validity upto 11 years. The proponent has exceeded the production since mine inception.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted on 04.06.2010 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.50 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category. But as it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category, as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

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Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Violation) on 28.05.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the project proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded on 11.07.2022.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Saiganipally (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.59 km; nearest water body i.e., Balaiahpally exists at 1.58 km (SW) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 32,400 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 8 years (@ 1,00,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 35.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.5 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt.19.07.2022 of ADMG, Karimnagar district furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2012-13 to 2022-23 (upto 11.07.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2012-13 to 2021-22 and no permits were issued during 2022-23 (upto 11.07.2022).

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.18.07.2022 issued by Sarpanch of Thimmapur (M), Karimnagar District stating that the proponent has donated Rs 4,55,000/- for Drinking water, sports items in primary school, benches at Panchayath office & school premises, plantation surrounding primary school and temple development of village.

The SEAC noted that it is a project under violation and hence considered the proposal as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and OM dt. 07.07.2021 & 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. processing of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted Compliance of criteria mentioned for processing violation proposals w.r.t. mining projects. The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is High. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for Implementation of Remediation plan; Natural Resource Augmentation Plan; and Community Resource Augmentation Plan is worked out to be Rs. 5,63,000/- and the details are as following:
