The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Sardarkhan and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the initially lease was granted on 11.03.2020 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of cluster lr.dt. 06.07.2022 of ADMG, Vikarabad District informing that there are 2 quarry leases each of Ac. 1.0 falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is Ac. 3-12 Gts. (3.30 Ha.) and Net cluster area is Ac.3-12 Gts. (3.30 Ha.). The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.12 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The SEAC noted that earlier, the SEIAA issued EC on 12.01.2021 for the above project to mine 6060 TPA of Fullers Earth.

The proponent also obtained CFE dt.05.05.2021 from the TSPCB and CFO dt.07.05.2021 from the TSPCB.

Now, the project proponent proposed expansion of the project by increasing the mining capacity from 6060 TPA to 15,000 TPA and submitted proposal seeking EC for expansion.

The nearest village Gopalpur (V) exists at a distance 0.84 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Pedda vagu exists at 1.5 km; Nearest RF is Indol RF exists at 1.3 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 15,000 m³/annum of Fullers Earth and the life of mine is reported as 3 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 25 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.38 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 06.07.2022 of ADMG, Vikarabad District wherein it was informed that they have not issued dispatch permits pertaining to the quarry lease.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC for expansion.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Laxmi Narayana and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted in favour of Sri N.Surya Kalyana Chakravarthy on 06.09.2007 for a period of 15 years i.e upto 05.09.2022. Subsequently, the lease was transferred on 01.10.2018 in favour of the proponent for un-expired period of lease i.e 05.09.2022. Later, 1st renewal of lease (in-principle) was granted on 26.04.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Borollagudem (V) exists at a distance 0.76 km from the proposed site; nearest water body tank near Borollagudem exists at 0.8 km (NNE); Malkapuram RF 0.2 km (S) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 2,89,511.0 Cu.m/annum (Average Production – 2,57,035.0 Cu.m/annum) of Rough Stone and the life of mine is reported as 10.0 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.8 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.50 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 18.04.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District informing that there are another Eight existing quarry leases of (7 lease granted before 09.09.2013) & (1 lease granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2007-08 to 2020-2021. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2008-09 to 2009-10; 2017-18 to 2020-21 and Nil during the years 2007-08; 2010-11 to 2016-17.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.10.06.2022 issued by Grama Panchayath, Dandu Malkapur Village, Choutuppal Mandal, Yadadri-Bhongiri District stating that the proponent has donated material of worth Rs 1,50,300/- for Gram Panchayath needs and development activities of village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Hari Krishna and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 28.07.2022

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted in favour of the proponent on 25.06.1997 for a period of 20 years i.e upto 2018. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 30.06.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Ankireddypally (V) exists at a distance 1.45 km from the proposed site; nearest water body tank exists at 0.5 km (NNE); Yadagiripalli RF 0.4 km (S) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 81,690.0 Cu.m/annum (Average Production – 59,150.0 Cu.m/annum) of Building stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 19 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.15 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 13.07.2022 of ADMG, Medchal-Malkajgiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 1997-1998 to 2017-2018. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2002-2003 to 2012-2013; 2017-2018 and Nil during the years 1997-1998 to 2000-2001; 2013-14 to 2016-2017. It was further informed that the proponent has applied renewal of quarry lease w.e.f. 24.06.2018 and quarry lease will be renewed on receipt of EC, CFE & CFO.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.18.01.2022 issued by Grama Panchayath, Ankireddypally (V), Keesara (M), Medchal Malkajgiri District stating that the proponent has donated Rs 2,00,000/- for construction of CC Roads in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Lakshmi Narayana and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted in favour of the proponent on 08.09.2007 for a period of 10 years i.e upto 19.10.2019. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 20.05.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Jangamvarigudem (V) exists at a distance 1.0 km from the proposed site; nearest water body is Tank near Jangamvarigudem exists at 0.45 km; and nearest RF is Lalalpur RF is at 4.7km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 2,75,400 Cu.m/annum (Average Production – 2,56,500 Cu.m/annum) of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 15 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.8 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.20 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt. 27.06.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2004-05 to 2021-2022. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2004-05 to 2018-19 and Nil during the years 2019-20 to 2021-22.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.25.03.2022 issued by Grama Panchayath-Deshmukhi (V), Pochampally (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent has donated material of worth Rs 1,50,000/- for requirement of of Panchayat.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Shankar Reddy and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier, the lease was granted on 16.01.2014 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years i.e upto 21.01.2024. It may be noted that the mine lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of cluster Ir.dt. 13.05.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District informing that there are 3 quarry leases (1.0 Ha. – lease granted after 09.09.2013 & 2 leases granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 11.85 Ha. and Net cluster area is 4.25 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category, but since it is a violation case considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plant.

The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,40,000 Cu.m/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 12 years.

Nearest human habitation is Rangapuram @ 1.2km; Nearest water body is Rangapuram tank near mine exists at 0.9 km (E); Nearest RF is Parvatapuram RF exists at 1.0 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Vishweshwar Reddy; and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted on 17.11.2018 for a period of 20 years i.e. upto 16.11.2038. The proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, TS on 26.04.2018 of Velchal Laterite Mine with production of 96,000 TPA which is valid upto 25.04.2022.

The proponent submitted copies of CFE obtained from TSPCB vide order dt. 24.09.2018 and CFO obtained from TSPCB vide order dt. 24.09.2018.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they applied for EC Extension on 13.07.2022 i.e. within 90 days from EC validity and requested to condone the delay. As per old approved mining plan the validity of the mine was 5 years.

Now, the present proposal is for validity of extension for EC for further period of 05 years with proposed production capacity of 96,000 TPA. Hence, the proponent submitted proposal for extension of validity period of EC.

The proponent submitted copy of Ir.dt.13.07.2022 of the ADMG, Vikarabad District furnishing the details of production during the period 2018-19 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that production was carried out during the period 2019-20 to 2021-22 and Nil during the years 2018-19.

It is proposed to mine 96,000 TPA of Velchal Laterite and the life of mine is reported as 5 years as per latest Approved Mining Plan.

The proponent submitted a copy of certificate dt 02.06.2022 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath of Velchal (V) informing that the proponent has donated Rs.50,000/- for installation of CC Cameras in the Village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity of EC.

Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 05.05.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representations that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to local people; development of greenbelt; measures for control blasting; avoid dumping waste outside mine lease area; take adequate environment protection measures; covering of transportation vehicles with tarpaulin & maintenance of vehicles; etc., The proponent reported that they have allocated Rs. 5.5 lakhs towards capital cost & Rs.4.0 lakhs towards recurring cost for implementation of EMP measures and Rs. 5.0 lakhs towards implementation of CER/CSR activities.

The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to Quartz: 21,060.00 MT/annum Feldspar 58,500.00 MT/annum of Quartz & Feldspar. The life of mine is estimated for Quartz as 13 years (@ 91,108.80 TPA) & for Feldspar it is 13 years (@ 84,360.0 TPA)
