The inspection report was put up in the SEAC-2 meeting dated 28/02/2022. The committee went through the inspection report and following observation has been made:

- 1. The Joint Committee constituted by SEIAA did not consider/clarify query points which were communicated by SEIAA vide letter no. 391/Parya/SEAC/5831/2021, dated 26/08/2021 in joint site inspection report.
- 2. As per the file records, The proponent has submitted the replies of SEIAA query letters but the Joint Inspection Committee has also not commented on the proponent's reply letter.

The committee discussed the matter and finds that the Joint Inspection report is not according to the requirements of SEIAA. The committee opined that The Joint Committee consists of representatives from Ghaziabad Development Authority, CPCB, UPPCB and SEIAA should revisit the site and submit the factual report in view of the above points mentioned.
