- 2. The proponent should strictly comply with, Tamil Nadu Government Order (Ms) No.84 Environment and forests (EC.2) Department dated 25.06.2018 regarding ban on one time use and throwaway plastics irrespective of thickness with effect from 01.01.2019 under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 3. The Project Proponent has to provide rain water harvesting collection tank to the capacity of 360 Cu.m in order to recover and reuse the rain water during normal rains as committed.
- 4. The proponent has to earmark the greenbelt area along the periphery of the site with dimension and GPS coordinates for the green belt area and the same shall be included in the layout out plan to be submitted for CMDA/DTCP approval.
- 5. The project proponent shall operate and maintain the Sewage treatment Plant and

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- Grey water Treatment plant effectively to meet out the standards prescribed by the CPCB.
- 6. All the commitment made by the project proponent in the flood management plan shall be strictly implemented.
- 7. For CER: The project proponent shall allocate and utilize the CER fund of Rs. 76 Lakhs (0.5% of the total project cost of Rs. 152 Crores) totally as committed for restoration of water bodies in and around the project site and to improve the surrounding Environment through EMAT DD favouring "Environmental Management Authority of Tamil Nadu" as per MOEF & CC OM dated: 01.05.2018 before applying for CTO from TNPCB.

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
