Note on the Proposal: This is regarding an expansion proposal for Building and Construction Project. The project is submitted at SEIAA under Category 'B' as per the EIA Notification, 2006 it's falls in the schedule SI.No.8(a) –"Building and Construction Projects" as the built up area >20,000Sqm and <1,50,000 Sqm. The present proposal is submitted for Environmental Clearance for Construction Sum Ultimate Medicare (Campus-II) having expansion of clinical area of 15,669.32 Sqm to 49,881.63 Sqm. at Ghatikia, BBSR. The PP has obtained EC earlier for Institutional & residential building Complex (Campus-II) bearing Khata plot no. C/6, C/7 with total built-up area 50,553.11 Sqm. At the time of appraisal the SEAC 	

enjoy such exemption. So it would be helpful for the appraisal by SEAC to throw some light on the status of each individual building in relation to requirement of EC or exemption from EC for same. (a)The buildings covered by the EC granted on 19.12.2013 for 50553.11 sqmtr of built up area, and (b) the buildings which are within the purview of the above stated exemption in terms of OM dated 22.12.2014 are to be separately listed. If there are buildings which do not fall within either of the said two lists, these need to be identified.

Since а committee of SEAC has made site inspection. these and relevant issues such as whether the proposed clinical establishment 34,212.31 sqmtr is in planning stage only, or construction has taken place already, even if partially may be clarified by SEAC by conveying a joint meeting in SEIAA office on a mutually convenient date. The Chairman, SEAC, the Secretary, SEAC, the concerned expert members of SEAC may be invited to this meeting.

The proposal as it is submitted appears to be misconceived. Perhaps it has to be a proposal for modification of EC for pointed out that the case was a violation case as constructed without EC and after submission of Resolution by the PP along with written commitment for not repeating the violation of EP act, vide his letter dated 05.12.2013 the SEAC recommended the proposal for EC and accordingly EC obtained vide letter no.8743/SEIAA dtd. 19.12.2013.

- Area provision for green belt-24,298.38sq.m (23% of plot area), parking 21005.83 sq.m (19.89% of built of area).
- Solid waste generation mainly domestic & Biomedical-2886 kg/day(MSW) & 133 kg/day(BMW) out of Hospital waste 528 kg/day.
- The PP has not submitted earlier EC compliance report issued by SEIAA.
- The SEAC recommended the proposal for grant of EC valid for a period of 7 years with stipulated conditions.
