The Chairman welcomed the members and initiated the discussion. The subjects discussed and the decisions made under each of the agenda point are as follows:

109.1 Confirmation of the proceedings of 108th SEIAA Meeting held on 11th November 2015.

Proceedings of 108th SEIAA Meeting held on 11th November 2015 was read and as there were no comments the same was accepted.

The Authority reviewed the progress made during the month of October 2015. The Authority noted that substantial progress has been achieved in consideration of proposals within the timeframe prescribed.

The Member Secretary informed to the Authority with regard to the efforts made to consider application online and difficulties faced for showing the disposal status of the proposals. The Member Secretary informed that even though the proposals received up to end of October, 2015 have been considered by SEAC, due to the problems in the online portal, the progress could not be appropriately shown. Efforts have been made to rectify these difficulties. Many messages sent to MoEF&CC in this regard. The issues have been discussed with the concerned officials of NIC. Many bugs have been cleared and some more are to be attended to by the helpdesk established by the MoEF&CC in this regard to facilitate the Authority to ensure that all the online applications received are processed online in a transparent way and disposed in a time bound manner online, so that the physical progress made is depicted online also. The issue with regard to discrepancy between the actual number of applications disposed off physically and that shown in the online portal will be brought to the notice of MoEF&CC to ensure that the actual progress made is appropriately depicted in the online portal.

The Authority noted the efforts made for consideration of application online and disposal.

109.2 Action Taken reports on the proceedings of 106th SEIAA Meeting held on 9th October 2015 and 107th SEIAA Meeting held on 29th October 2015.

109.3 <u>Deferred Project:</u>

For Invite:

109.3.1 Residential Apartment at Sy. No. 103/1, Khatha No.216, Doddatogur Village, Begur Hobli, Bengaluru South Taluk, Bengaluru Urban District of M/s Sree & Sree Builders & Promoters (SEIAA 94 CON 2015)

It is a proposal seeking Environmental Clearance for construction of Residential Apartment of 351 units with Basement+Ground Floor+11 Upper Floor on a plot area of 17,502.50 Sq.mts (karab area = 607.02 Sq.m) and with total built up area of 54,578.58 Sqm. Total water requirement of project is 237 KLD.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 4th September 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance, subject to submission of the following information.

- 1. Scientific assessment of the availability of the water from the bore well in the project site
- 2. Revised water balance calculating fresh water demand at the rate of 55 LPCD as per the norms prescribed for rural water supply and the scheme for meeting the additional requirement
- 3. Revised rain water harvesting calculations
- 4. Proposal to provide an underpass to connect the other side of the project site.

The Authority during the meeting held on 26th September 2015 had perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC. The Authority observed that the parcel of land in Part-2 is not of any practical use or beneficial to the project activities, as it is bifurcated by a public road and the entire activity is concentrated on the land in Part-1

The Authority after discussion decided to get the following information, in addition to information sought by SEAC for further consideration:

- 1. Revised layout plan exclusively for the land in Part-1 without considering the land in Part-2.
- 2. Details of Kharab land duly marking it on layout plan.
- 3. Revised land-use plan such as ground coverage, park & open spaces, greenbelt, parking area, etc. with respect to Part-1 only.

- 4. Source of water and NOC from the competent authority.
- 5. Enhance energy savings to at least 25%.
- 6. Revised quantification of MSW as per the standards.
- 7. Revised water balance with due emphasis for utilization of the treated water.
- 8. Design of rainwater harvesting pit as per CGWA norms.

The Authority also decided to invite the proponent.

The Authority perused the reply submitted by the proponent vide letter dated 18.11.2015. The proponent appeared before the Authority and explained the proposal in brief. The Authority observed that the drawing submitted is not to the scale, the land in the Part -2 of the project site is deducted, but the activities in the land in Part-1 remains unchanged. In view of this, the activities proposed are disproportionate to the available area and therefore required lung space and other amenities cannot be accommodated as per norms. The Authority therefore advised the proponent to submit revised plan designed as per norms. The proponent requested for an opportunity to submit the revised plan and other required information. The Authority therefore decided to reconsider the proposal after the receipt of revised drawing and other relevant information from the proponent.

For Further Consideration:

109.3.2 Iron Ore Beneficiation Plant of capacity 0.90 LTPA at Sy.No.20/1C, Dindadhahalli Village, Hireguntanuru Hobli, Chitradurga Taluk and district of Sri K. Siva Prasanth, Partner, M/s Sri Vijaya Durga Devi Minerals, H.No.35/94, Ramnagar 1st Cross, Havambhavi, Siruguppa Road, Ballari-583104.(SEIAA 20 IND 2015)

It is project proposal for establishment of 0.90 LTPA capacity Iron Ore Beneficiation Plant on an area of 5.025 Acres (2.3 Ha).

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 5.8.2015, 23.9.2015 and 07.10.2015. Based on the following observations made and the infrastructure facilities available including the raw material availability in the region the committee considered the proposal under B2 category.

- 1. The proposed Iron ore beneficiation plant has proposed to supply raw materials for the captive sponge iron units situated in the adjoining districts.
- 2. The low quality of iron ore available in the region is processed in the plant and its quality is improved by this method and the same is applied to the sponge iron units.
- 3. This plant is located surrounded by mining lease areas of Bheemasmudra village of Chitradurga District
- 4. The land has been already converted to Non Agricultural (industrial) purpose.
- 5. B category projects are permitted up to 5 Lakh TPA process as per the EIA Notification 2006 and amended later.

- 6. When EIA Notification 2006 was issued only one lakh Ton per annum was the limit for B category projects. Then up to 20,000 TPA was considered as B2 category for appraisal. When the limit was raised to 5 Lakh TPA the notification is silent about the limit for B2 categorization.
- 7. The proponent has also proposed to transport 90% of the raw material and processed ore by train/trolleys

The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance.

The Authority during the meeting held on 29.10.2015 had perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC.

The Authority sought to know whether the proposed project site is a part of Mining lease and if so details of the mining lease held by the proponent and copy of the Environmental clearance obtained from the competent authority for mining activity.

The Authority after discussion decided to get the following information for further consideration:

- 1. Details of the mining lease held by the proponent and copy of the Environmental clearance obtained from the competent authority for mining activity.
- 2. Sketch showing the mining lease area duly indicating the proposed beneficiation plant site on the sketch.
- 3. Copy of the O.M dated 23rd September 2009 issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Chitradurga district do not bear the signature of the D.C. A copy of the said order duly signed by the Deputy Commissioner.
- 4. The proposed land is said to have been converted for commercial use as per the O.M dated 23rd September 2009. A copy of the order of conversion of the said land for industrial purpose.
- 5. Distance of the proposed site from the nearest human habitations.
- 6. The relationship between the proponent and the owner of the land with due documents to establish the same.
- 7. Source of raw material for the beneficiation plant, mode of transport and the precautions proposed for ensuring Environment safety.
- 8. Source and quantity of water required with relevant water balance chart.
- 9. Waterbodies in the Downstream of the project site with distance.
- 10. The project site duly marking on the village cadastral map.
- 11. Waste and tailing is estimated to be 30% of the raw material used is proposed to be sold to the cement industries and brick industries. The details of such user industries, distance from the project site, mode of transportation and MoU with such industries shall be submitted.

The Authority perused the reply submitted by the proponent vide letters dated 30.09.2015 and 13.11.2015. The Authority noted that as per the O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA-II (I) dated 24th December 2013, mineral beneficiation plants of more than 20,000 TPA through put are classified as B1. No amendment in this regard has been made by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change subsequent to the amendment made to the EIA Notification vide Notification No. S.O.1599 dated 25th June 2014, wherein the threshold limit for beneficiation plants to be considered as B category have been increased from 0.1 million TPA to 0.5 million TPA. Therefore the project in question which is proposed for beneficiation of 0.90 LTPA is to be appraised as category B1 projects following the procedure laid down in the law.

The Authority therefore decided to refer the file back to SEAC for issue of ToR and to appraise following the due procedure of law.

109.3.3 Residential Apartment Building Project at Sy.Nos. 345, Shivalli Village, Udupi Taluk, Udupi Distric by M/s. Kusuma Bhandary Construction Pvt. Ltd (SEIAA 156 CON 2014)

It is a proposal for construction of Residential Apartment of 156 units with G+Podium+13UF on an area of 8,538.13 Sq.m and with the total built up area of 28,853.52 Sqm. The total water requirement is 119.9 KLD.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 27th & 28th January 2015. The Committee has recommended for issue of environmental clearance subject to submission of a copy of the plan sanctioned by Udupi Municipal Council.

The Authority during the meeting held on 25.02.2015, had perused the proposal along with the recommendation made by SEAC and the reply submitted by the proponent vide letter dated 20.02.2015.

The Authority noted that as per the observation made by SEAC, the proponent have already started the construction activity without prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority therefore decided to issue the following directions to the proponent under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act – 1986 in exercise of the powers conferred on the Authority vide O.M. No. S.O.637 (E) dated 28-02-2014.

- (a) To suspend the construction activity of the above said project with immediate effect at the existing level till the Environmental Clearance is obtained.
- (b) To submit details regarding present level of construction along with latest dated photographs.
- (c) To put up the matter relating to the violation to the Board of Directors of the company or to the managing committee / CEO of the society, trust, partnership for consideration of its environment related policy / plan of action as also a written commitment in the form of a formal board

resolution to be submitted to the Authority as per the O.M. dated 12.12.2012 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India to ensure that violations will not be repeated.

Accordingly, direction has been issued vide letter dated 24.04.2015.

A mahazar was conducted on 12.08.2015 to establish the violation. A complaint was filed in the court of II Additional Civil Judge & JMFC, Udupi on 06.11.2015.

The Authority after discussion decided to clear the proposal for issue of Environmental Clearance subject to submission of the following information:

- (1) Revised calculation for the water requirement and corresponding water balance chart along with design of the STP and equalization tank taking the peak flow into consideration.
- (2) Occupant density and movement details for each floor.
- (3) Details of Recreational Ground Area with total percentage to the plot area.

The Authority also decided to withdraw the Directions issued under section 5 of the Environment Protection Act, 1986 in view of the fact that action has been initiated under section 19 of the E(P) Act and a decision has been taken to issue Environment clearance based on merit.

109.3.4 Building Stone Quarry Project, Sy.No.29 of Huluvenahalli Village, Bengaluru South Taluk & Urban Dist. (5-0 Acres) (QL No.579) of Sri S R Ravishankar (SEIAA 1045 MIN 2015)

This is a New proposal seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying of building stone in 5 Acres.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 29th September 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance.

The Authority during the meeting held on 29.10.2015 had perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC. The Authority observed that several proposals for quarrying in the land belonging to Huluvenahalli village, Bangalore South Taluk have been cleared for issue of Environmental Clearance. If the proposed project site fall into a cluster situation as defined in the O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA.II (I) of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India dated 24th December 2013 and the total lease area equals or exceeds 25 ha, then the proposal needs to be appraised as category B1 project.

The Authority therefore decided to seek clarification from the Director, Mines and Geology as to whether the quarry lease in question falls into a cluster situation as defined in the O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA.II (I) of the Ministry of Environment and

Forests, Government of India dated 24th December 2013 and if so whether the total area in the cluster equal to or exceeds 25 Ha.

The Authority also decided to take up the proposal for further consideration after the receipt of the above mentioned information from the Department of Mines and Geology.

The Authority perused the letter dated 18.11.2015 submitted by the proponent along with letter from Department of Mines and Geology. The Authority noted that as per the information furnished by the Department of Mines and Geology the sum total of the quarry lease area in the cluster do not exceed 25 Ha.

The Authority therefore decided to issue Environmental Clearance for extraction of building stone as per approved quarry plan as per the recommendation made by the SEAC.

109.3.5 Building Stone Quarry Project, Sy.No.29 of Huluvenahalli Village, Bengaluru South Taluk & Urban Dist. (7-0 Acres) (QL No.581) of Sri S R Udayashankar (SEIAA 1046 MIN 2015)

This is a Renewal proposal seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying of Building Stone in 7-0 Acres, Government Land.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 30th September 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance.

The Authority during the meeting held on 29.10.2015 had perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC. The Authority had decided to seek clarification from the Director, Mines and Geology as to whether the quarry lease in question falls into a cluster situation as defined in the O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA.II (I) of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India dated 24th December 2013 and if so whether the total area in the cluster equal to or exceeds 25 Ha.

The Authority also decided to take up the proposal for further consideration after the receipt of the above mentioned information from the Department of Mines and Geology.

The Authority perused the letter dated 18.11.2015 submitted by the proponent along with letter from Department of Mines and Geology. The Authority noted that as per the information furnished by the Department of Mines and Geology the sum total of the quarry lease area in the cluster do not exceed 25 Ha.

This is a Renewal proposal seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying Building Stone in 3-24 Acres, Govt. Land.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 8th October 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance.

The Authority during the meeting held on 29.10.2015 had perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC. The Authority had decided to seek clarification from the Director, Mines and Geology as to whether the quarry lease in question falls into a cluster situation as defined in the O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA.II (I) of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India dated 24th December 2013 and if so whether the total area in the cluster equal to or exceeds 25 Ha.

The Authority also decided to take up the proposal for further consideration after the receipt of the above mentioned information from the Department of Mines and Geology.

The Authority perused the letter dated 18.11.2015 submitted by the proponent along with letter from Department of Mines and Geology. The Authority noted that as per the information furnished by the Department of Mines and Geology the sum total of the quarry lease area in the cluster do not exceed 25 Ha.

The Authority therefore decided to issue Environmental Clearance for extraction of building stone as per approved quarry plan as per the recommendation made by the SEAC.

"Patil Planet", Mixed development project at Survey No. 41D/1 & 41D/2 of Mahalbagayath Village, Vijayapura Taluk, Vijayapura of Mr. Raghavendra Sanjeeva Shetty Partner, M/s. Patil Planet Developers LLP, F-8/9, Sacred World, Wanowrie, Pune – 411 040 (SEIAA 156 CON 2015)

It is project proposal seeking Environmental clearance for proposed construction of "Patil Planet" Mixed development Project comprising of retail shops, office space, 168 No's of residential units and Clubhouse in B + G + 10 UF. Total Plot area is 8,197.02 Sq.mt and total built up area is 43,593.46 Sq.mts. Total water requirement is 180 KLD.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 21st October 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance, subject to submission of structural stability certificate of the building from a reputed third party agency to ascertain the load bearing capacity of the predesigned structure in view of the proposed construction above the already approved structure by the competent authorities.

The Authority during the meeting held on 11.11.2015 had perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC.

The Authority after discussion decided to get the following information in addition to the information sought by SEAC for further consideration:

- (1) Present level of construction with due justification for commencement of construction activity.
- (2) Revised scaled map clearly indicating commercial and residential land use.
- (3) Revised parking calculation based on norms both for residential and commercial activities.
- (4) Revised calculation for the water requirement and corresponding water balance chart along with design of the STP and equalization tank taking the peak flow into consideration.
- (5) Revised calculation of MSW and appropriate management plan.
- (6) Details of Recreational Ground area for the residential and open space for the commercial area as per NBC norms.

The Authority perused the reply submitted by the proponent vide letter dated 27.11.2015. The proponent appeared before the Authority and explained the proposal in brief.

The Authority after discussion decided to clear the proposal for issue of Environmental Clearance subject to submission of the following information:

- (1) Revised layout plan increasing the drive way to 8m and with the provision for separate entry/exit to the residential and commercial areas.
- (2) Revised design of the equalization tank taking peak hour flow into consideration.
- (3) Details of Recreational Ground Area with total percentage to the plot area.
- (4) Commitment with regard to undertaking compensatory greenbelt development outside the project site.
- (5) Specific social commitment plan with budget, activity and time frame.

The Authority perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC.

The Authority after discussion decided to issue Environmental Clearance for extraction of building stone as per approved quarry plan.

109.4.2 Building Stone Quarry Project, Sy.No.706, Srinivas Saradagi Village, Gulbarga Taluk & Dist. (6-0 Acres) of Mis. Prabhudev Stone Crushing Unit, Sri Prabhudeva Sb. Sri Shivasharanappa Kalburgi, Plot No.29, Bilagundi Layout, Sedam Road, Gulbarga Taluk and District (SEIAA 246 MIN 2015)

This is a renewal proposal, seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying of 139.11 Building Stone in 6-0 Acres, Government Land.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 5th & 6th June 2015 and 2nd November 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance, with a condition that approach road to be asphalted.

The Authority perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC.

The Authority after discussion decided to issue Environmental Clearance for extraction of building stone as per approved quarry plan, with a condition that approach road to be asphalted.

109.4.3 Building Stone Quarry Project, Sy.No.88 of Manchegowdanapalya Village, Ramanagara Taluk, Ramanagara Dist. (8-20 Acres). (QL No.1292 & 1293) of Mis. Sapphire Stone Crushers No.3, G.R.Grand Residency, J.P.Nagar, 6th Phase, Kanakapura Main Road, Bangalore. (SEIAA 491 MIN 2015)

This is a proposal seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying of Building stone in 8-20 Acres, Government Gomala Land.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 24th to 29th July 2015 and 2nd November 2015. The Committee observed that already mining has been done in the proposed quarry area. Though it is a patta land, without obtaining EC, doing mining is violation of EIA Notification, 2006.

The Committee after discussion decided to limit the production to 60% (Restricting the depth of mining to 10m) of the total estimated production keeping

the minable area quantity and the sustainability of the mine in the mind and decided to recommend the proposal to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance.

The Authority perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC.

The Authority after discussion decided to get a clarification from the proponent with regard to the violation noted, for further consideration.

109.4.4 Building Stone Quarry Project, Sy.No.2 of Bilakundi Village, Gokak Taluk & Belagavi Dist. (6-0 Acres) of Sri Ashok Siddappa Sarvi S/o. Sri.Siddappa, Patagundi Village, Gokak Taluk, Belagavi District. (SEIAA 624 MIN 2015)

This is a new proposal seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying of Building Stone in 6-00 Acres, Government Land.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 25th August 2015, 2nd November 2015. The Committee has recommended to SEIAA for issue of Environmental Clearance subject to submission of the following information:

- 1. An undertaking that the approach road to be asphalted.
- 2. Top soil management details.

The Authority perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC.

The Authority after discussion decided to issue Environmental Clearance for extraction of building stone as per approved quarry plan, subject to submission of information sought by SEAC.

The Authority noted that the SEAC during the 130th SEAC meeting held on 19th February 2015, taking note of the inspection report submitted by the sub-committee have decided to issue ToR incorporating the additional ToRs recommended by the sub-committee. M/s Intel Technology India Private limited have been given Environmental Clearance from the Authority for construction of SRR 3 Building in G + 9 floors for expansion of Intel's SRR Campus on a plot area of 17.28 Ha with the total built up area

of 1,00,250.8 Sq.mts. vide letter No. SEIAA 197 CON 2013 dated 3rd October, 2013 and the corrigendum dated 03.09.2015.

"The Proponent and the RQP/Environment Consultant attended the 147^{th} meeting of SEAC held on 4^{th} and 5^{th} September 2015 to provide clarification/additional information.

The Committee noted that many proposals have been cleared in this area and if the proposed area is likely to result in to a cluster situation with a total lease area of 25 Ha or more as defined in the O.M dated 24.12.2013 issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India then the proposal has to be appraised category B1. The committee therefore directed the proponent to get the details of all the leases of Chikkaballapura Taluk with the extent of lease area, lease Nos., latitude & longitude and distance between the boundaries (OUTER) of each lease area and be marked on combined sketch plotted on a village map which shall be attested by a competent authority.

This is a Renewal proposal seeking Environmental clearance for quarrying of Building Stone in 2-00 Acres, Government Revenue Land.

The subject was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 3rd November 2015. The Committee has recommended the proposal to SEIAA for closure and the extract of the proceedings of the Committee meeting is as below:

"The Proponent and the RQP/Environment Consultant attended the 147th meeting of SEAC held on 4th and 5th September 2015 to provide clarification/additional information.

The Committee noted that many proposals have been cleared in this area and if the proposed area is likely to result in to a cluster situation with a total lease area of 25 Ha or more as defined in the O.M dated 24.12.2013 issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India then the proposal has to be appraised category B1. The committee therefore directed the proponent to get the details of all the leases of Chikkaballapura Taluk with the extent of lease area, lease Nos., latitude & longitude and distance between the boundaries (OUTER) of each lease area and be marked on combined sketch plotted on a village map which shall be attested by a competent authority.

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- 3. NOC's not submitted.

The proponent informed the committee that lease renewal application has been submitted to DMG, but he failed to produce the copy of the same.

The Committee after discussion decided to recommend the proposal to SEIAA for closure."

The Authority perused the proposal and took note of the recommendation of SEAC and decided to close the file.
