this is to inform you that this Board hereby grants the Consent to Establish (NOC) from the environmental point of the above subject to the following conditions and special conditions annexed.

1. The quality of sewage and trade effluent to be discharged from your factory shall satisfy the permissible limits as prescribed in IS : 2490 (Pt. I) of 1974, and/or its subsequent amendment and Environment (Protection) Rules 1986.
2. Suitable measures to treat your effluent shall be adopted by you in order to reduce the pollutional load so that the quality of the effluent satisfies the standards mentioned above.
3. You shall have to apply to this Board for its consent to operate and discharge of sewage and trade effluent according to the provisions of the water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974. No sewage or trade effluent shall be discharged by you without prior consent of this Board.
4. All emission from your factory shall conform to the standards as laid down by this Board.
5. No. emission shall be permitted without prior approval of this Board and you shall apply to this Board for its consent to operate and atmospheric emission as per provision of the Air (Prevention & Control Pollution) act, 1981.
6. No industrial plant, furnace, flues, chimneys, control equipment, etc. shall be constructed/reconstructed/erected/re-erected without prior approval of this Board.

Special conditions issued to: M/s IFB Agro Industries Ltd.

A) Emission :

Husk or Coal & Biogas fired boilers- 02x20 TPH by replacing existing three no. boilers of capacity 20 TPH, 15 TPH and 12 TPH- to be provided with individual ESP and common stack of height 40 mtrs from G.L.
Stack to have sampling port, platform, ladder as per Emission Regulation PartIII of CPCB.

B) Effluent :

Industrial/process: To be recycled after treatment in upgraded ETP -as proposed.
Domestic- to be discharged into Panchayet Drain through septic tank and soakpit.

C) Solid Waste :

Solid waste to be disposed in environment friendly manner,

F) General:

1. Noise Control – Ambient noise level not to exceed the permissible limit. Every care to be taken to control noise. .
2. Unit shall obtain fire licence and other statutory licences.
3. Consent to Operate to be obtained from WBPCB.
4. Permission to be obtained from the appropriate authority for withdrawal of ground water.
5. Land conversion certificate to be obtained from the appropriate authority.
6. Good housekeeping to be maintained.
7. Adequate green belt around the unit to be developed.
8. Proper measures to be taken to control odour
9. Use of Coal as auxiliary fuel for Boilers of Co-generation power plant shall be within 15% of total fuel consumption.
10. This NOC is valid upto 30/11/2017 for change of raw material from molasses to grain in the existing 50 KLD molasses based distillery without change in “product mix” and “production capacity”
11. This NOC may be revoked if any valid complaint is lodged against your unit regarding Environmental Pollution.
