PA informed that care will be taken during the period of mining and Condition No. i: at the time of mine closure for safe guarding the area from ingress of water from the nalla passing through the middle of the mine. PA is agreed upon. Condition No. ii: PA is agreed upon. Condition No. iii Checking of the possibility of existence of fault in consultation with Condition No. iv: Director DGMS is yet to be done. PA agreed that de-pillaring will be carried out after taking prior approval of DGMS. PA informed that coal handling plant is in design stage. It will be Condition No. v: equipped with devices to deal with airborne dust. Loading and unloading point, including coal transfer point will be provided with efficient water spraying arrangement.

Condition No. vi : PA informed that tree plantation programmed has been formulated for plating trees on mine site, road site and around coal yard, near
