Dear Madam,

The State Government had granted the Mining Lease of Gypsum in our favour at Village Kothiyara District Doda. We had executed the Lease Deed Agreement with the State Government on 01-09-2005, and the lease deed was duly registered with Sub Registrar Doda as required under rules.

The Director Geology and Mining Department vide letter No: 279/MCC/DGM/03-04/4522 dated: 01-02-2017 had asked us to apply for the Grant of Environmental Clearance with respect to the gypsum mine. Since the SEIAA was not formed at that time we had applied online thru the registered/authorized consultant, and our case was taken up by the SEAC in its 7th meeting at Jammu office on 28-11-2017. After the presentation we were asked to get the NOC from the HOD Forest Department as the only requirement to clear our case.

It needs to be mentioned, that we already have the NOC from Forest department issued by DFO Batote vide No: 4019-20 dated: 25-02-2009 (Annexure 1). The Revenue authorities have also issued the certificate on the Site plan stating the land under the lease area to be State land and private land.

The SEAC after the 7th meeting had issued a letter addressed to us vide No: SEAC/2017/785-94 dated: 02-12-2017(Annexure 2), wherein we were asked to furnish a No Objection Certificate from the Head of the Forest Department so that our case could be processed further for the grant of EC.

Subsequently we had applied to The Principal Chief Conservators of Forests, J&K Government Jammu for the issuance of the NOC vide our letter dated: 22-01-2018. The case was sent to DFO Batote Forest Division, who after getting the leased out area verified on ground, by Forest

Department's Demarcation team along with the Revenue authorities forwarded our case with recommendation for the issuance of NOC to the Conservator of Forests, Chenab Circle Doda vide letter No: 1794-95/BFD dated: 13-09-2018. It was stated that the Lease area not a forest land (Annexure 3).

The Director Geology & Mining Department J&K Govt had approved the Scheme of Mining Plan vide letter No: DGM/F-435/AOMP/4860-67 dated: 23-02-2017. This approval had been granted with the consultation of Fishiries, Forest, Irrigation & Flood Control Departments. The copy of this Scheme of Mining Plan has been sent to the Principal Chief Conservator Forests J&K Forest Department by office of Director Geology & Mining. (Annexure 4)

It has been more than a year since our case is with the Conservator of Forests, Chenab Division Doda and as such the grant of EC in our favour is getting delayed for no fault of ours.

In view of the above facts it is requested, that as it has been established that the leased out area is a **not** a **forest land but State and private land** as vetted by the DFO Batote (as per NOC of 2009 and recommendation of 13-09-2018), that our case may kindly be processed at the earliest we and we be granted the Environmental Clearance as all other required formalities are completed as require.

Our case may kindly be considered in the next meeting of SEAC for urgent favorable disposal please.
