Dear Sir,

Please refer the discussions on the above cited subject during the 7<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting held at Jammu during which the consultant EQMS failed to deliver presentation on the compliance sought during the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the SEAC at Srinagar on 13/06/2017. Therefore, following compliance be made to enable the SEAC to take a call on the project in its next meeting:-

1. The consultant need to use temperature data of Jammu instead of Batote station in risk assessment modeling.
2. The consultant need to submit certificate to the effect that the data projected for analysis thereof and that the proposed project design of the storage facility is authentic and satisfactorily within the standard permissible limits of risk management.
3. Further, the risk management plan be integrated with District Disaster Management Plan in consultation with local district authority so that the area is notified to ensure that no settlements are allowed to come up around the storage facility in future.
