

The annual report about the progress of reclamation should be submitted to the Chief about the progress, Regional Office, Bangalore and the Nodal Officer, Conservator of Forests, Regional Office, Bangalore and the Nodal Officer, Orissa.
  - 10. It shall be ensured that no labour-camps are set up inside the forest area.

The mining lease area shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, using four feet high RCC pillars, with each pillar inscribed with the serial adjacent pillars.


