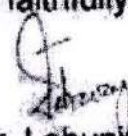

FINAL APPROVAL ORDER

Sub: Diversion of 227.00 ha of forest land for 3<sup>rd</sup> renewal of Mahulsukha Manganese Ore Mines in village Randa, Rantha and Bhutuda of Bonai Tehsil in Bonai Forest Division if favour of M/s AMTC Ltd., in Sundergah district of Orissa.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government's letter No. 10F(Cons)-114/2004/16131/F&E dated 30.10.2004 on the subject mentioned above seeking prior approval of the Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After careful consideration of the proposal by the Forest Advisory Committee constituted under Section-3 of the said Act, in-principle approval for the said proposal was granted vide this Ministry's letter of even number dated 16.02.2005 subject to fulfilment of certain conditions. The State Government has furnished compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval vide its letter No. 10F(Cons)-114/2004/12342/F&E dated 08.08.2008 and has requested the Central Government to grant final approval.

In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by the State Government, approval of the Central Government is hereby granted under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 227.00 ha of forest land for 3<sup>rd</sup> renewal of Mahulsukha Manganese Ore Mines in village Randa, Rantha and Bhutuda of Bonai Tehsil in Bonai Forest Division if favour of M/s AMTC Ltd., in Sundergah district of Orissa. subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- ✓ 1. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. ✓ (i) Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the project cost.
- ✓ (ii) Fencing, protection and regeneration of the safety zone area (7.5 metres strip all along the outer boundary of the mining lease area)

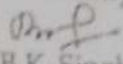
shall be done at the project cost and a half times the area under safety zone, shall also be done at the project cost. Besides this, afforestation on 100 meter radius of mining lease granted in degraded forest land if density is less than 0.4, enrichment plantation shall be taken up by the user agency in consultation with the Forest department.

(iii) Wherever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake afforestation measures in the blanks within the lease area, as well as along the roads outside the lease area diverted under this approval, in consultation with the State Forest Department at the project cost.

- x 3. The scheme for soil and moisture conservation for the entire watershed area shall be implemented at the project cost.
4. All measures should be taken to prevent pollution of tanks, rivers and nalas, etc. The desilting of adjoining villages in radius of 5 Km may also be taken up by the User agency from time to time.
5. The period of diversion under this approval shall be twenty (20) years subject to possession of valid lease by the User Agency under the MMDR Act, 1957.
6. Any tree felling shall be done only when it is absolutely necessary and unavoidable, and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
7. No damage to the flora and fauna of the area shall be caused.
8. For reclamation works, the top soil should be preserved and should be used for reclamation. The areas shall be reclaimed keeping in view the international practice of stabilizing the dumps by grading / benching so that angles of repose (normally less than  $28^{\circ}$  at any given place) are maintained.
9. The reclamation plan shall be implemented and monitored continuously. The User Agency should furnish the extent of area to be technically and biologically reclaimed each year, to facilitate monitoring. The annual report about the progress of reclamation should be submitted to the Chief Conservator of Forests, Regional Office, Bangalore and the Nodal Officer, Orissa.
10. It shall be ensured that no labour-camps are set up inside the forest area.

11. The mining lease area shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, using four feet high RCC pillars, with each pillar inscribed with the serial number, forward and backward bearings and distance between two adjacent pillars.
  12. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
  13. Any other condition that the CCF (Central), Regional Office, Bangalore/ the State Forest Department may impose from time to time for protection and improvement of flora and fauna in the forest area, shall also be applicable.
