1.	<p>Nagaraj Shinde, Kadkola- Village :- He informed the gathering that the industry is proposing to increase the production capacity from 20 KLD to 60 KLD. He expressed his no objection for increasing as there will be more of job opportunities to local and industry has assured to provide facilities to the school.</p>	<p>Jobs will be given to the local persons and management is committed to provide facilities to the neighboring schools such as stationery items, furniture's, drinking water facility and toilets, scholarships to poor meritorious students etc</p>
2.	<p>Sri. Shivagowda Patil, Shivanetti-Village:- The distillery to produce 20 KLD from last so many years and the work of increasing from 20 KLD to 60 KLD is now proposed. He said that in the beginning the industry were requested to take proper control measures to control environmental pollution and there should not be any decrease in the yield of crop and so also the factory Authorities had agreed for request. However, there were some problems in the past that due to discharge of spent wash which contaminated water and also there were problems to live stock of cattle. Now by increasing from 20 KLD to 60 KLD it is apprehended that it is going to be bigger industry and so more caution is required. He welcomed this hearing by District Administrator before giving the license for increasing the capacity and said that environmental pollution is caused by so many industries. Due to environmental pollution including air pollution, smell nuisance, there has been damage to cattle livestock and crop yield too has come down.
