**PROCEEDINGS OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MEETING IN RESPECT OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR JORURI IRON ORE MINES OF M/S. KALINGA MINING CORPORATION FOR PRODUCTION OF IRON ORE UPTO 0.5 MTPA (ROM) OVER AN ML AREA OF 27.170 HA. IN JALAHARI VILLAGE OF KEONJHAR DISTRICT HELD ON 21.08.2014 (12.00 NOON TO 01.30 PM) AT JALAHARI VILLAGE IN KEONJHAR DISTRICT, ODISHA**

The Public Hearing meeting in respect of Environmental Impact Assessment for Joruri Iron Ore Mines of M/s. Kalinga Mining Corporation for production of Iron Ore upto 0.5 MTPA (ROM) over an ML area of 27.170 Ha. in Jalahari village of Keonjhar district was held at the scheduled venue & time i.e. on 21.08.2014 (12.00 Noon to 1.30 PM) at Jalahari village in Keonjhar district, Odisha with reference to:

1. EIA Notification S. O. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006.
2. Interim Operational Guidelines.

**The Panel consisted of the following members:**

1. Sri Sangram Keshari Swain, OAS (S), Additional District Magistrate, Keonjhar
2. Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar,

Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar had explained the views, comments, objections and opinions of the public are necessary while considering the environmental clearance of the project in the first public hearing session held for the same lessee (i.e. Joruri Iron and Manganese Ore Mines of M/s. Kalinga Mining Corporation (ML area of 54.754 Ha held at the scheduled venue and time i.e. on 21.08.2014 (10.30 AM to 12.00 Noon).

He asked the project proponent to make a brief presentation about the various aspects of the proposed project to be undertaken for better awareness of the public. On behalf of the Project Proponent, Mr. Smruti Ranjan Behera, Mines Manager, Joruri Iron Ore Mines of M/s. Kalinga Mining Corporation, addressed the committee members and assembled public, and made a brief presentation about the salient features of the proposed project, environmental management, pollution control measures, waste management, afforestation programme and various other CSR activities envisaged in the proposed project.

Then Dr. Sohan Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Keonjhar requested the public to give their views, comments, objections and opinions on the proposed project.

**The following speakers gave their views on the above said project, which is given as follows:**

**1. Sri Mahendra Nath Bodra, Jurudi village**

He expressed his opinion in favour of the proposal of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation. However he suggested the management for the followings

- He requested the management to give employment to local people only.
- He informed that he came to know that at present workers are working under contractor on 12 hr basis for which they are being paid extra as overtime wages for 4 hrs. So he suggested them that instead of giving OT wages, they can recruit more people, it will reduce the unemployment problem of the area.
- He requested that employment has to be provided at least one person from each family.
- He also suggested management that towards CSR activities if they can pay some compensation to those who have lost their land due to mining activities.
- Regarding development of education, he told that due to lack of proper education, we are backward till now. So he requested the management to try for upliftment of the educational standards of the schools of this area.
- He also suggested the management to adopt one or two villages and to provide all sorts of facilities to make it modern village.

**2. Mr. Bidhyadhara Mahakud, Jurudi village**

He welcomed the dais, company management, media and the people gathered at the meeting. He informed the gatherings about the public hearing meeting and it is being conducted today for production enhancement of the mine and asked all the people to support the project proposal of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation. Further he told that it is true that due to increase in production there must be some adverse effect on the environment but for this he suggested the company management to carry out more plantations in barren land to minimize the pollution. He also requested the following demands before the management:

- To construct high school in the area for better education of the local children
- To give permanent employment to local people and to give preference to those who have lost their land due to this mine.
- To arrange medical facilities for the local people
- They should appoint teachers in local schools for up-liftment of the educational standards of the school.
- He requested the management to initiate at their end to open a branch of Bank of India here itself so that local people don't have to go far for their bank related works.
- He also suggested the management to construct one college and one technical school like ITI or Diploma school for local people.

He also told the management that, they have not fulfilled all the commitments they have made in their last public hearing but expect that management will fulfill the commitments once the mine reopens so that the people will get engagement and development in the area will take place.

### **3. Sri Gokul Chandra Mohanta, Bhandaridiha Village**

He welcomed the dais, company management, media and the people gathered from the 5 Gram Panchayats at the meeting. While supporting the proposal of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation, he told that it is very happy moment for them since today public hearing is being conducted for opening and production enhancement of KMC mines. During his speech, he told that this is a mineral rich area and we are proud to be a local inhabitant of this area. Due to mining activities and iron ore this place is known all over the world. As per our constitution, the local people are owner of these land, water and forest, so it is our duty to save it and work for development of this area. Hence he requested the management to carry out developmental works in the field of employment, education, health care and transportation facility for all round development of the area. He also told that due to mining activities we have been benefitted a lot by getting employment directly and indirectly so there should not be any differentiation in these mines and the people should get together for opening of the mine. He requested the management to fulfill the demands raised by his previous speakers and also to carry out the developmental works as they have mentioned in their executive summary for all round development of the area. At the end he requested the Government officials to recommend for early grant of the proposal for development of the local area.

### **4. Sri Krushna Chandra Pallei, Jalahari Village**

He first informed that permission should be given to the project proposal placed by M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation. He wholeheartedly supported this proposal and told that due to opening of this mine local people will be benefitted a lot directly or indirectly but it is also true that due to mining activities there will be some adverse effect on the environment and for that he requested the management to adopt adequate steps to minimize it. He advised management to give preference to local people of Khandbandh, Jalahari & Jurudi and give business to them. He also requested to provide all the facilities towards education, health care to these people. In the meanwhile he stated that the Company Management has done a lot of developmental works in the area like Anganwadi, club, construction of roads (Pucca road from Jalahari to Khandabandha), supply of drinking water in the villages etc. However he requested the management for the followings:

- De-siltation and renovation of Dalki nala.
- As per the last public hearing commitment M/s. kalinga Mining Corporation has provided tractor for development of agriculture.
- To provide financial support to poor people and to construct pucca houses for very poor people of these surrounding panchayats.
- To provide school bus for the school children

### **5. Sri Krishna Naik, Guruda Village**

He welcomed the dais and the people gathered at the meeting. While giving his full support in favour of the production enhancement proposal, he requested the management to give permanent employment to local people. He also urged them to pay special attention for providing medical facilities to local people and upliftment of the educational standard.

**6. Sri Senapati Munda, Jalahari Village**

He gave his opinion in favour of the proposal of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation and he requested the Government officials to grant all the permissions for opening of this mine at the earliest. He also requested the management on behalf of Panchayats for construction and repairing of existing roads and to dig borewell in Munda Basti for supply of drinking water.

**7. Smt. Gouri Naik, Gurutuan Village**

She welcomed the dais and the people gathered at the meeting. During her deliberation, she requested the management to give employment to local people once the mine restarts as they are suffering a lot to maintain their family due to closure of mines. She also told that previous village heads have done nothing for the welfare of the locals due to mis-utilization of funds provided by the company and the Government sources. However at the end, she expressed her full support for the proposal.

**8. Sri Pranab Mohanty, Jurudi Village**

He whole heartedly supported this project proposal and told that few persons due to their personal interest or benefit tried to cancel this public hearing but everyone present here is in favour of the proposal and support it. He also told that only by agriculture alone, we cannot grow or develop. We can develop only by proper and scientific exploitation of these natural resources present here with proper utilization, so they all support this proposal. He told that few persons unnecessarily dragging the name of some politician here due to their personal interest but it is he who is giving compensation to poor people every month and these poor people are alive even when there is no work due to closure of mines.

At the end he requested the management for construction of a bye-pass road for two wheelers and light vehicle only to avoid accidents and traffic. He also suggested for more water sprinkling to minimize the pollution on the road. and not to complete mines in very quicker manner. He also expressed that, though the owner of the mine is an Odia, they have their heartiest support for the proposal and the mine should start operation and more people should support the project. He highlighted that large scale mining should not be done as the minerals will finish quickly. But this company has asked for only 1.0 Million Ton and they should be allowed as the company is doing the right thing.

**9. Sri Raj Kishore Barik, P.S. Member, Bada Kalimati G.P.**

He told nothing specific about the proposal and expressed his support for the proposal.

#### **10. Sri Laxmidhara Prusty, Jajang Village**

While expressing support for the proposal of Kalinga Mining Corporation, he told the gathering that the owner of this mine is an Odia owner and he is here since 1954, so we all should support this proposal and setting up of screen plant for the production. He requested the Management for giving employment and transportation work to local people (people of Jalahari, Khandbandh & Jaroli) on priority basis. He is happy to see the support given by the people for opening of the mine and he also requested the Government officials for opening of the mine.

#### **11. Sri Ranjeet Naik, Sarapanch, Balda G.P.**

He told that proposal of Kalinga Mining Corporation for production enhancement and setting up of the crusher and screening plant should be granted. He requested the management to give employment to the unemployed local people in the mine and crusher plant.

#### **12. Sri Indramani Behera, Jajang Village**

He opined in favour of the proposal and requested Govt. officials to provide all the supports from Government which are required for opening the mine. He urged the Company and Government shall give all help to the people. Employment should be given first to Jalahari villagers, then Jururi Penthei Basti people and slowly to the nearest Panchayat. Then the loading works etc. should be given to the people of the 5 Gram Panchayats. Finally he asked that permission to be given to the project proposal.

#### **13. Sri Rajendra Kumar Barik, Kamalpur village, Jajang**

He expressed his support for the proposal of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation and asked for the permission to be given to the company.

#### **14. Sri Sarat Chandra Patra, Jalahari Village**

He welcomed the dais and the people of Jalahari and Jajang GP gathered at the meeting. He supported the proposal of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation and during the deliberation, he requested the Company management for protection of the water bodies as its getting polluted and also requested to arrange for cleaning the dust bin of their area every 15 days. Finally he submitted a written representation to the chair.

#### **15. Sri Sasee Bhusan Pattnayak, Keonjhar town**

He told that these mines are public property, so we should first think how our environment will be safeguarded and try to keep it safe. Since the mine area belongs to the local people, so they should get employment, earnings, transportation facility, education, health and other facilities. But it should be seen that there is no adverse effect on the environment and to avoid natural disaster as we are seeing today in Uttarakhand and Maharastra. We should become aware and protect the environment and ask the company as well the District Administration that they should operate the mine without damaging the environment.


One (01) numbers of representations was submitted to the Chair by the people which is annexed herewith.

Dr. S. Giri, Regional Officer, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar then asked the Project proponent to give commitments to the people with respect to the demands raised by the people. Sri Smruti Ranjan Behera, Mines Manager, Joruri Iron Ore Mines of M/s Kalinga Mining Corporation, thanked the speakers for their valuable suggestions and cooperation. He informed that they have already carried out various CSR activities like education, drinking water, infrastructure, electrification, health and sanitation, road construction (Ganesh temple to Khandabandh), plantation, water sprinkling and have spent around Rs 6.65 Crores. He gave his commitment to the issues and demands raised by the public which are as follows (i) after commencement of mine work at least one village will be converted to a model village and assured support and infrastructures for carrying out business for the local people (ii) Infrastructure development for the educational institutions (iii) construct a community hall, club house and do other renovation works as required, (iv) all steps would be taken for protection of environment as per guide lines of MoEF and SPCB, (v) to construct toilets in the nearby villages, (vi) they will start the welfare activities like supply of drinking water, health care, education facility, promotion of agriculture, arrangement of proper sanitation etc. in the surrounding villages and (vii) they will give preference to local people as per eligibility during employment and mineral transportation work after commencement of the mining operation.

Then Dr. S. Giri, Regional Officer and representatives from State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Keonjhar prepared the summary of the public hearing proceedings accurately reflecting the views and concerns expressed by the speakers with the inclusion of comments of the applicant. The statement of issues and concerns of public with the comments of applicant, prepared in Odia and English languages are annexed separately.

Then the President of Public Hearing meeting, Sri Sangram Keshari Swain, Addl. District Magistrate, Keonjhar spoke on the two public hearing meeting held consecutively and thanked the people for rendering their co-operation for smooth operation of the public hearing and finally ratified the minutes of meetings with the views and demands of the public. He informed the public that the proceedings will be sent to the Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar who will again send all the documents to the Ministry of Environment and Forest, New Delhi where a high level committee will decide and take decision for grant of the above project proposal.

The meeting was ended with thanks to the chair.
