LTD., R.S.No. 54/1, SAGGONDA VILLAGE, GOPALAPURAM MANDAL, WEST GODAVARI DISTRICT ON THE PROPOSED EXPANION OF EXISTING PLANT TO MANUFACTURE ACTIVE PHARMACEUTICAL INGREDIENTS (API) & INTERMEDIATES (BULK DRUGS & INTERMEDIATES) WITH R&D AND INCREASE OF EXISTING PRODUCTION OF ALUMINUM CHORIDE.

At the outset, the Environmental Engineer, APPCB, RO, Eluru has welcomed the public gathering of the Environmental public Hearing. He informed that the Public hearing is conducted as per the Government of India Notification S.O. No. 1533, dated 14.09.2006 in connection with the proposed expansion of existing plant of M/s Bhagyanagar Chlorides Pvt. Ltd., Saggonda(v), Gopalapuram (M), West Godavari District to manufacture Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (api) & Intermediates (Bulk Drugs & Intermediates) with R&D and increase existing production of Aluminum Chloride. Paper notification regarding the public hearing was issued on 17.12.2016 in "Andhra Jyothi" Telugu News paper and in "Indian Express" English news paper with the details of proposed activity, date and venue of public hearing, places of availability of draft EIA report and executive summaries for access to the public. The Public Hearing is conducted as per the Government of India notification S.O. 1533, dated 14.09.2006, where in certain projects like Bulk Drugs etc., require to obtain prior Environmental Clearance for which comments/ objections/ suggestions of the public have to be solicited on environmental impacts and other pollution problems that may arise from the proposed activities before according environmental clearance by the MoEF & CC, GoI. Minutes of the public hearing incorporating all the views/ objections/ suggestions of the public would be submitted to the Government of India for further action on the application of project proponent for environmental clearance. The project proponent would give details on the project details, environmental impacts, proposed remedial measures etc.

Then the EE, APPCB, RO, Eluru requested the Additional Joint Collector, Eluru to conduct the proceedings for the public hearing.

The Additional Joint Collector, Eluru informed that the public hearing is intended to obtain views / objections on the proposed project of M/s Bhagyanagar Chlorides Pvt Ltd., All the views and objections expressed in the public hearing would be recorded and consolidated. He also informed that public can also submit representations and reports, if any, on the proposed project, which would then be incorporated as part of record of minutes and forwarded to the Government of India. The Additional Joint Collector requested the project proponents to explain to the public about the proposed project, its environmental impacts and preventive and control measures.

Sri Srinivasa Rao, Joint Managing Director, M/s Bhagyanagar Chlorides Pvt Ltd., has informed that they proposed expansion of their existing plant. The proposed expansion consists of manufacture of 5 bulk drug products at any point of time out of 10 bulk drugs proposed along with R & D facilities and expansion of existing production of Aluminum chloride and approached Ministry of Environment and Forests for Environmental Clearance. Draft Environmental Impact Assessment report was prepared as per the Terms of Reference (ToR) issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, (MoEF&CC), Govt of India and submitted to A.P.Pollution Control Board for arranging public hearing on the proposed project. The proposed expansion would create employment opportunities directly and indirectly

additionally to about 100 – 150 persons. They would be spending about Rs. 1.0 Crore as part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). This amount would be spent in phases in next five years duly consulting the villages for development activities. 3.5 Acres (42% of total area) would be developed as greenbelt which would ensure healthy surroundings. He promised that they would take all pollution control measures to ensure no harm to the surrounding villages. He requested the public present to express their views on the proposed project. He requested their environment consultant M/s KKB Envirocare Consultants Pvt Ltd, Hyderabad to explain about the technical details of the proposed project.

Sri J. Tirumalesh, Technical Director, M/s KKB Envirocare Consultants Pvt Ltd, Hyderabad explained about the project as follows:

- M/s Bhagyanagar Chlorides Pvt Ltd., proposed to expand the plant with manufacturing of 5 bulk drugs at a time (2 regular and 3 campaign products) out of 10 bulk drugs proposed with R&D facility. Expansion is proposed in 4.3 Hectares
- As per ToR issued by the MoEF & CC, existing environment status of water, air, land and noise in the plant, in 10 km radius of the plant and in villages was collected and studied.
- PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, SO₂, NO_x, Hydrocarbons and Volatile organic Compounds levels in the ambient air are within the stipulated norms of Pollution Control Board.
- Water requirement for different purposes of plant activities is 250 kilo litres per day
- Waste water generation will be 99 kilo litres per day and all measures are proposed to ensure no adverse impacts on the surrounding environment.
- 99 KLD Waste water will be segregated into two streams depending on total dissolved solids levels and collected into tanks of 1.0 metre above the ground level, treated in Dual Sand Filter, Activated Carbon Filter, Reverse Osmosis plant and the treated waste water would be reused in Cooling tower and Boiler makeup. No waste water would be released to outside and hence no ground / surface water pollution. Guard ponds are also proposed to collect the waste water and same is retreated as necessary. Standby pumps for operation of ETP will also be made available in the plant.
- Air pollution from process operations are controlled by treating in Scrubbers. 2 Tons per Hour (TPH) and 5 TPH boilers will be installed for steam requirement. Multi cyclone and Bag Filter will be provided to control emissions from boilers.
- 6.6 Tons per day of solid waste is generated from process. These wastes are segregated as per the specifications, collected in HDPE bags, stored on a covered platform with leachate collection pit before disposal to cement plants / Common Facility as per Pollution Control stipulations with 7 Copy manifest system. Boiler ash will be disposed to brick manufacturing units.
- Extensive plantation to the extent possible is proposed to arrest noise to the surroundings.
- 30 kilo litres of water will be utilized for development of green belt in 3.6 Acres
- Rain water harvesting structures are also proposed. All efforts would be taken to utilize minimal natural resources.
- CSR funds would be utilized for welfare of the surrounding villages.

The Additional Joint Collector requested the public to come forward and express the views/ objections/ suggestions duly mentioning their name, village etc.

Comments/ Views/ Objections/ Suggestions expressed by the public during the public hearing are summarized as furnished below:

1. Sri M. Navin, Student, Gopavaram Village:

- Though the plant is in operation since last 7 years, no welfare measures are under taken by the industry to Gopavaram village. So far no hospital is provided for Gopavaram village. Hospitals are existing far away from village. No doctor is employed by industry even to treat employees of the industry in case of any emergency.
- While giving employment, the industry shall look into only technical and educational capabilities and not look into personal aspects.
- No rains in Gopavaram for the last three years. Crop of cashew/mango etc are damaged in the area.
- The existing industry is causing lot of pollution. White gaseous fumes of the industry are spreading in the entire surroundings of the plant. Industry is causing heavy chlorine pollution. Product itself is highly irritating.

- Many youth are unemployed in the village. Industry is practising favouritism in giving jobs.
- Industry shall utilize 10% of their profits for welfare of surrounding villages. But this industry spent nothing for the welfare of the surrounding villages.
- He opposed the plant expansion as only problems are to be encountered by this industry and no benefits can be expected from the industry.

2. Sri Pathuri Srinivasa Rao, Farmer, Gopavaram:

- Cashew crops damaged completely
- Very low salaries are paid to employees
- Drinking water facility is not provided
- No technical information about the industry is provided to any of the villagers. Presentation by the consultant is also not clear and not understandable. Need clear presentation on the proposed project again.
- No assurance from industry is forthcoming in case of any damage or untoward incidents/accidents.
- There is every possibility of complete damage to the surroundings in case of any major leak of chlorine from the industry. Safety measures are nil in the industry.
- Safety is foremost priority and shall be ensured by the industry.

Sri Menni Sri Hari, Farmer, Gopavaram:

- Crop losses are heavy due to the industry.
- Permission for expansion shall not be given.

The Additional Joint Collector requested the project consultant to explain with more clarity. Sri J. Tirumalesh, Technical Director, M/s KKB Envirocare Consultants Pvt Ltd, Hyderabad explained about the project again. Explained about the each product, its uses, pollution control measures etc., as mentioned in the draft EIA report.

Sri Menni Maruthi, Farmer, Gopavaram:

- Industry is unable to give any legal assurance to ensure no damages due to the industry operations.
- Our lively hood is based on cows. Cows are affected by this industry.
- Cashew plantation is already affected severely and would affect further
- Gopavaram – Gajjaram is damaged due to plying of vehicles of industries and dust pollution is causing allergy problems. No repairs since last 7 years.
- Insisted for legal assurance from the industry.

Sri Ukkusuri Suresh, Gopavaram:

- Cows, buffalos and crops are damaged in 3 km radius due to pollution from this industry.
- Without Village Panchayat permission/ resolution, industry cannot proceed with the expansion. Demanded to know whether village panchayat gave any permission.
- No suitable jobs are provided even for inter / degree qualified persons. Forced to work for hard labour jobs. Still many unemployed though having degree qualification.
- Our objections are not all considered and projects are obtaining clearances though objected to by local people.
- No college and no hospital in the village
- Opposed the expansion

Sri Menni Gangadhara Rao, Farmer, Gopavaram:

- Own lands are located adjacent to the industry. Chlorine emissions caused damage to the crops. Though complained to revenue authorities, no action taken. Emissions are more particularly during early morning.
- Industry is also unresponsive though complained many times.
- Expansion would result in more problems and hence shall not be permitted.

Sri M. Sudhkar, Gopavaram:

- In case of any emergency, villagers do not know to whom to approach in the factory to redress their grievance. Emission from the factory spread upto their village eight months back. Factory representatives were evasive and simply denying that the emissions are not from their unit. No other factory is existing in this area.
- Farmers surrounding the industry are suffering a lot. Crop yields reduced drastically because of pollution from the plant. Farmers are in despair.
- Sound pollution from the industry is severe. Not controlled sound pollution in spite of several representations. Even cows are going panic and not allowing milking. Village is also disturbed because of sound pollution.

Sri Menni Atchyutha Rama Rao, Farmer, Gopavaram:

- Ownland of about 30 acres is existing adjacent to the industry.
- Not operating the existing unit as per safety and labour law norms. No Safety Head nor Labour head employed for the factory. Employees do not wear helmets and nose masks.
- A woman died because of pollution from this factory sometime back and the facts were suppressed. Our agriculture labour are also suffering because of air pollution from this plant.
- Two of cows died. Three calves born handicapped. Cows are not allowing milking. Wrong information is furnished in the EIA report.
- Demanded to know as to whether the factory is paying salaries/allowing leaves/other benefits as per labour laws, whether industry employed any person as labour head to look after welfare of the employees. No body from their village were employed in the plant.
- Management of the industry is highly apathetic towards their village.
- Students are disturbed because of sound pollution from the industry and pass percentage is reduced.
- No CSR activity was under taken by the industry so far. Information furnished in the reports is not true.
- Villagers were wrongly informed at the time of establishment of the existing unit that soap manufacturing unit would be put up. Instead they established chemical unit of Aluminium Chloride unit.
- SC/ST/BC students are suffering a lot due to sound pollution.
- Existing industry and also the proposed expansion, which involves bulk drugs is even more dangerous, shall not be allowed at any cost.

Sri M. Venkata Ratnaji, Vice president / Farmer, Gopavaram:

- The existing site of the industry was sold to the plant for a noble purpose expecting employment benefits to the villagers with a belief that the industry operations would not cause any pollution. Management had also given the same assurance, but the same turned out to be a false assurance as the industry had not divulged pollution potential from the industry. The industry is still evasive to redress village grievances.
- Even guests are not able to sleep peacefully in the village because of severe sound pollution from the industry. Not able to tolerate inaction of industry in controlling sound pollution.
- Skin of his face got rashes because of pollution of the existing industry.
- Milk yield from cows/ buffalos reduced from 5 lit to 2 lit. Domestic animals, birds are suffering from pollution of this industry. Crops are severely damaged.
- Fining the employees on filthy grounds like late reporting / leave etc, is morally unethical.
- It is the villagers who are exposed to pollution, as no employ of the plant live in Gopavaram village.
- Strongly oppose existing as well as proposed expansion.

Sri Nadipalli Rama Krishna, Gopavaram:

- No compensation was given though crops were damaged
- Demanded that no permissions shall be given to the industry. If permissions are given, villagers would not tolerate.

Sri M. Rajesh, President, Saggonda:

- Though there may be benefits of employment and development, the industry shall first ensure that no pollution is caused to the villages and surroundings. The village suffered a lot due to pollution.
- Permissions are issued to industries even though people oppose the same.
- Management shall take utmost care to control pollution and the villagers shall also come united to ensure that no pollution is caused by the industry.

Sri Menni Satyanarayana, Gopavaram:

- Industry is causing severe pollution. Management is unresponsive to the grievances.
- Plant shall not be granted permissions under any circumstances

Sri Pathuri Suryachandaram, Gopavaram:

- Crops of cashew, mango, paddy etc are affected because of pollution from the industry, hence no permission shall be given

Sri Menni Ramachandram, Gopavaram:

- Plant is of no use to Gopavaram village in any way.
- All villagers are opposing, hence oppose establishment of plant.

Sri Myddi Ratnaji Rao, Gopavaram:

- Government shall take decision on permitting industry keeping in view the opinions expressed by the villagers.

Sri Bobbili Venkatraju, Gopavaram:

- Industries shall be established at least 3 km from the village habitation.
- Sound pollution is causing disturbance to the students particularly to SC/ST/BC students. Village, Crops, animals are affected by the existing unit.
- Opposed expansion of the plant

Sri Tagaram Anandarao, Gopavaram:

- Severe health problems are caused to family members and employees due to chlorine emissions released by the industry
- Opposed expansion of the plant

Sri Mandapalli Srinivas, Gopavaram:

- Village, Crops, animals are affected by the existing unit.
- Opposed expansion of the plant

Sri Jaliparthi Pradeep, Gopavaram:

- Industry is causing severe pollution. Employees also suffer because of pollution of this industry. All villagers are opposing.
- Opposed expansion of the plant

Sri Maganti Srinivasa Rao, Nidadavole:

- Reiterated that no pollution shall be caused by the industry. Industrial growth is also equally important. Employment opportunities would increase.
- Village is benefited in terms of tax revenues received by the gram panchayat. 60-70 persons of the village receive salaries of about Rs. 60 lakhs adding to the economy of the village. Panchayat receives grants indirectly for rural development from excise duty, sales tax etc paid by the industry.

Sri Parimi Radhakrishna, Kovvur:

- Industry management and the villagers shall discuss together the problems and solve the issues amicably and then go forward on the proposals of the industry.

Sri Kakarala Hare Ramakrishna, Rajampalem:

- Proposed expansion shall be taken up only after resolving all issues such as pollution control, employment etc.

Sri Chennakesava Reddy, NGO, Kadapa:

- Appealed industry to take all measures to control pollution and adhere to the CPCB norms, resolve labour issues amicably etc., Only local people shall be given employment. A suitable person shall be designated as public relations officer to redress the village problems.
- A mobile hospital shall be arranged to take care of health of the people.

Sri Vijaya Reddy, NGO, Hyderabad:

- Public hearing shall be conducted in front of the gate as per the EIA Notification 2006.
- Rainwater harvesting structures shall be provided and shall see that the local farmers are not deprived of ground water because of drawl of ground water for industrial purposes. This shall be incorporated in the final draft report because industry requires about 65,000 KL of water annually.
- Will submit a detailed report with suggestions to the industry, authorities etc., on the proposed project.
- A full-fledged report shall be submitted to the MoEF for taking further action.

Sri D.Anjaiah, NGO, Hyderabad:

- Industry shall take proper measures to control sound nuisance as there is no dearth of technology. Wages to labour shall be paid as per minimum wages acts and rules.
- Industry shall resolve all problems so far expressed and then go forward on expansion proposals.

Sri K. Naga Raja, Gutala:

- Owns 17 acres of land adjacent to the plant and cultivating. All the lands around industry are agriculture lands. Cultivation stopped because of industry pollution. Report mentioned that soil types around industry are of silty loam, which is wrong and misleading and without any authenticated report regarding silty nature of soils around the plant.
- Eucalyptus plantation will not survive in this area. Ground water is polluted because of the industry. Hence, reporting that none of the plant species and animals present in the study area belongs to threatened or endangered categories is wrong.

- Maximum temperature recorded is mentioned as 46⁰ C, which is also wrong as the temperature shoots up to more than 50⁰ C. This wrong reporting mislead that the temperature of this area would decrease because of industrial operations.
- Base line environmental data generation in Mar 2016 was carried by consultant out without the knowledge of local people.
- Very difficult to understand the scientific terms and their meaning mentioned in the reports.
- Emission quantities that are generated due to consumption of 20 lit per hour of diesel for DG sets are not mentioned.
- Farmers became debt ridden because of crop damages and pollution problems of the industry. Industry is unresponsive. Farmers are in despair.
- No proper details are furnished about ash generated per month, area available for storage and disposal etc., Handling of Hazardous waste, chemicals and Risk assessment (Para No. 5 of Executive Summary) and on Occupational Health Hazards (Para No. 6 of Executive Summary)
- Details of activities undertaken under corporate social responsibility and amount incurred are lacking clarity. If expenditure is incurred, what are the activities undertaken.
- No clarity is furnished in the report as to how many locals are employed as of now in the plant.
- Opposed plant expansion

Sri Koduri Durgarao, Gopavaram :

- No villager was informed about the proposed expansion of the plant
- Crops were growing very healthily before ten years. But since last 10 years, the crops are suddenly loosing flowering stage, which may be because of industrial establishments of this area
- Severe air pollution is causing on roads because of plying of industry vehicles which carry acid, chlorine, sulphur etc. Spillages of these chemicals onto road and then into ambient air are causing eye burning whenever such dust is emitted into air due to winds and vehicle plying. Health of Cows, buffalos are severely affected because of drinking of rain water contaminated with spillages of above chemicals. Animals are dying because of drinking the contaminated water.
- Chlorine fumes are contaminating the crops and also grass resulting reluctance by animals to eat grass.
- Sometimes, but not frequently, villagers are feeling difficulty in breathing because of chlorine emissions. Severe skin allergies and eye burning is also caused by the pollution of the industry.
- All the adverse effects shall be studied by experts to find out the reasons for such health problems.
- No objection if the industry is established at a suitable place, other than the existing place, such that nobody is affected including crops, animals etc.
- Village is at a distance of 300 mts. Infants are also disturbed because of sound pollution from the industry.
- Opposed expansion of the plant at the existing site, as villagers are already suffering due to pollution problems of this industry.

Sri T. Hussain Naidu, NGO, Hyderabad:

- Sound levels mentioned in the report are in contrast to the actual situation as already expressed by the villagers. This need correction in the report.
- Minimum wages act shall be implemented. Locals shall be employed compulsorily.
- Supported proposed expansion activity

Sri S Venkata Reddy, NGO, Hyderabad:

- Industry shall implement continuous online monitoring systems. Industry shall initiate action to resolve all the problems. Action shall be taken by the authorities in case of any pollution caused by the industry.
- Permission can be granted with a condition that the industry shall not cause any pollution.

Sri G. Janardhan Reddy, NGO, Hyderabad:

- Oppose causing of pollution, but not for establishment of industries.
- Report shall be submitted to the government on all the problems mentioned by the industries.
- Supported the plant expansion provided management resolves all the issues amicably with villagers.

Sri Chintala Sailu, NGO, Matrubhumi Parirakshana samithi, Hyderabad:

- All the issues shall be resolved in the village level committees. Local shall be employed. Industry shall provide ambulance facility.
- No objection for the expansion if the plant is operated without air and water pollution.

Sri Sunanda Reddy, Environmentalist, Hyderabad:

- Health status of the local villages, crop yield status, ground water availability status shall be incorporated in the report which will help as base line data for assessing future impacts.
- Water harvesting structures shall be provided. CSR funds shall be utilized for this purpose. A coordinating committee may be constituted for unitilizing CSR funds.
- Greenery shall be atleast 50% along roads including medicinal plants
- Skill development training shall be imparted to the local people.
- Water spraying on roads may be done to control road dust.
- No objections for the proposed expansion provided all the issues of the villagers are resolved amicably.

Sri H. Madhu Babu, Environment Volunteer, REEHAS, Hyderabad:


- No objections for the proposed expansion provided all the issues of the villagers are resolved amicably.

The Additional Joint Collector, Eluru requested the project proponent to reply to the issues raised by the public. Sri Srinivasa Rao, JMD of the project has thanked the public about expressing their views and complaints and clarified that any chemical process would have its characteristic emissions from operations released into the environment and these emissions have to be controlled effectively, otherwise surroundings would be affected. Presently, they are not causing any pollution from the industry. Rs. 6 Crores is estimated as expenditure at full production levels as proposed for environment management, pollution control equipment etc.,

The Additional Joint Collector stated that all the views expressed have been heard patiently and recorded and concluded the public hearing proceedings.

Public supported the expansion project with suggestions. 33 persons have spoken (12 have supported, 4 neutral and 15 have not supported) and 26 representations (25 in support and 1 against chemical units) received. Following is the summary of Industry response to the Public Hearing issues. We noted down all their suggestions and noted points raised by them.
