Solan, H.P. over an area of 82.073 Hectares.

In the light of the issues raised as recorded in the proceedings of the Public Hearing, you are requested to kindly take necessary action as per the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006. It is also requested that following points may kindly be considered while granting environmental clearance to the project proposal.

- The project proponent shall carry out the mining operations as per the provisions of the Mines and Minerals Act, 1957, provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988, Standards laid by Indian Bureau of Mines and as per the approved Mining Plan.
- The project proponent shall ensure that the mining operation does not contaminate the water resources and obstruct the natural drainage lines in the catchment.
- The project proponent shall ensure to maintain the Ambient Air Quality Standards.
- The top soil cover shall be conserved and utilized for the rehabilitation of the mined areas.
- Phase-wise plan of greenbelt development, plantation and compensatory afforestation clearly indicating the area to be covered under plantation and the species to be planted should be given.
- Occupational health impacts of the project activity should be anticipated and proposed preventive measures be indicated.
- No mechanical mining /operations should be allowed.

Environmental public hearing was organized by HP State Pollution Control Board on 29.05.2013 at 11:00 AM at Vill Kheri (Near Water Pump) P.O. & Teh. Nalagarh, Distt. Solan, H.P. of M/s Manjholi Stone Crusher Village Berson, P.O. Manjholi, Teh. Nalagarh, Distt. Solan, H.P. for river bed mining area 82.073 hectare (1090.13 bighas) for the collection of sand, bajri & stone. This environmental public hearing was held as per EIA notification no. SO 1533 dt. 14.09.2006 under the chairmanship of Additional Deputy Commissioner, Solan. The attendance sheet of the present people is attached as annexure-I. During this public hearing Tehsil Dar Local Administration Nalagarh, Distt Mining Officer Solan, Regional Transport Officer Solan, Representatives of fishery Department & Pradhans from Manjholi Panchayat and local people were present in the public hearing. First of all Sh. Parveen Gupta Env. Engineer HPPCB welcomed Additional Deputy Commissioner. Sh. Farveen Gupta Environmental Engineer addressed the Govt. officers and people were present in the public hearing and made aware the public regarding motive of public hearing. Then Additional Deputy Commissioner asked the people to give their suggestions, views and queries regarding mining activities. During this period project proponent, Sh. Amarjeet Singh also welcomed the public to take participation in this public hearing. He further said that if any questions/queries regarding the establishment of this project, the public are being invited to ask the same. After that, Regional Officer HPPCB invited the Environmental Consultant of Stone Crusher M/s Shiwalik Solid Waste Management Ltd Vill. Majra P.O. Dabhota Tehsil Nalagarh Distt. Solan H.P. to deliver their technical details regarding river bed mining activities. The technical consultant of company Sh. Ashok Sharma welcomed the Additional Deputy Commissioner, officers from various Govt. Departments and local people present in the public hearing.

After that, with due permission of chairman, the proceedings of environmental public hearing was started and the entire proceedings were video graphed. The technical consultant of company Sh. Ashok Sharma introduced about the project and also discussed all technical aspects w.r.t. Air, Water & Noise. He said that this public hearing was conducted as per EIA notification 2006. He further said that the mining activity in the river is required, because if not so that, the flood situation will arise in rivers. He said that M/s Shiwalik Solid Waste has conducted monitoring w.r.t. Air, Water, Soil and Noise. As per analysis reports of Air, Water, Soil and Noise are confirming the standards prescribed. He also further said that when the mining activities starts, the dust emission generate during the mining. For the control of these dust emissions, there is a provision of sprinklers to arrest the dust and there is provision of sufficient fund for control and prevention of pollution & improve the ambient air quality. The above activities come under the Corporate Responsibility for Environment Protection.

Additional Deputy Commissioner asked the public to raise their issues/queries only about the prescribed mentioned subject. He also requested to the public that questions should be raised one by one and the same should not be repeated again and again. He also said that they will not take


any decision in this public hearing and proceeding of the public hearing shall be documented & videographed and the same shall be sent to the State Govt. The State Govt. shall forward this document to Ministry of Environment and Forest, New Delhi. During the course of public hearing several issues/queries were raised by the people and comments/reply on the same are as below:
