An Environmental Public Hearing in respect of Pemashelpu Hydro Electric Project (81MW) executed by M/s Mechuka Hydro Power Private Limited was conducted on 11.08.2014 from 10.15 am onwards at Multipurpose Community Hall, Yorni, Mechuka, West Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh. The entire Public Hearing proceeding was presided over by Sri Pige Ligu, Deputy Commissioner, Aalo, West Siang District-cum- Chairman of the Public Hearing. In all 118 (One hundred eighteen) people attended the public hearing. The attendance sheet is enclosed as Annexure-A.

At the outset Sri N.Tam, IFS, Member Secretary, Arunachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board, Naharlagun while welcoming the Project Affected Families (PAFs)/Public elaborated the provisions of the EIA Notification dtd 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2006 and subsequent amendments issued by the Ministry of environment & Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India pertaining to Environmental Clearance for developmental projects and requirements of Environmental Public Hearing thereof.

The Member Secretary, APSPCB further explained that the objectives of the Environmental Public Hearing is to solicit and record the opinions, views, comments or objections of the people residing at and in the adjoining areas of project sites likely to be affected by the construction of the proposed Pemashelpu Hydroelectric Project (81MW). He further added that the Environmental Public Hearing is a part of the Environmental Clearance process and that the proceedings of the same will be submitted to the Ministry of Environment & Forests

(MoEF), Govt. of India. The Ministry will examine and scrutinize such views, comments, suggestions by project affected people while processing the application for Environment Clearance.

Shri .P.M Nanda, COO, M/s Mechuka Hydro Power Private Limited explained the salient features of the project with the help of power point presentation. Later, Sri. Vivek Jhaldiyal, Consultant representing M/s R.S Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd. explained on environmental studies, sources of air pollution & its mitigation measures environmental management plan, management of air quality, water management, solid waste management, green belt development programme, social economic development etc.

The EIA/EMP studies are prepared by consultants M/s R.S Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Gurgaon as per Terms of Reference (TOR) issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests.

After presentation, the Project Affected Families (PAFs) from Project Affected Villages (PAVs) were given time to give their views/suggestions/objections/queries/word of appreciation regarding the proposed project.

Accordingly, the views/suggestions/objections/queries/word of appreciation expressed by the public participants are as follows:

#### 1. Sri. Gebo Onge, Village Dijitang

He put forwarded following:

- Public shouted slogans against the project.
- Memba Community is very less in number, if project comes then maximum land will be used for the project.
- The notice of the public hearing was not published in Bothi language which has hurt the sentiments of the public.
- The APSPCB has fixed the date of public hearing without our knowledge.
- There are many medicinal plants which will become extinct on the arrival of the project.

 The project will affect the religious structure and hurt the religious sentiments of the people.

- The rapport of Råajratna Company is not good. Ramana Murty was asked many a times to discuss regarding the proposed project, but he never turned up till date.
- · The Company should try to gain the sympathy of the public.
- So far as the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) of the Company is concerned, the role of Raajratna Company is "Zero". Not a single Computer has been donated to any schools so far.
- All land owners are against the project.
- · The project should not come.
- The Company should come and talk with public in an appropriate platform rather than meeting few people in secluded places.

#### 2. Sri, Karma Lera Mosing, ASM cum Bazar Secretary, Mechuka

He put forwarded following:

- · Notice of public hearing was not done in Bothi language.
- I don't buy any assurances given by the Company.
- Company is giving only Powerpoint presentation, but practically doing nothing.
- The Company people were asked to meet and discuss with people/public. But, company people did not turn up.
- We are in border area, we are skeptical of being sabotaged by neighboring China when the project comes up.
- Under Local Area Development (LADP) Plan many things like medical, schools
  facilities have been shown. But, what is guarantee that these things will be
  carried out.

#### 3. Sri. Lakpa sona, Village Singber (Representative of Sona Clan)

He put forwarded following:

- When the Company came four (4) years back, people felt happy that they would get benefits.
- Request the Brothers and Sisters of Sona Clan to sit together and discuss whether to allow the project to come or not?

#### 5. Sri. Tachang Jebing, President, ATSUM, village Mechuka

He put forwarded following:

- I will speak as a student.
- . If project comes, area will be developed.
- If project comes, natural beauty will be lost, but development is essential.
- Perhaps, the Local MLA and ZPM are also opposing the project. Will they give
  job opportunities?
- Project will be beneficial for the area in particular and the State as a whole.

#### 6. Sri. Umar Sona, Village Yorni

He put forwarded following:

All people are happy]'

#### 7. Sri. Kesang Panden Philley, ASM, Kaling - Mechuka

He put forwarded following:

- I will not allow the project to come in my area.
- I will not donate any land.
- All Panchayat leaders of my segment are unhappy.

#### 8. Sri. P,C Kijar, village Dorjeeling

He put forwarded following:

- Request the Company not to construct the project.
- If the project comes, then the area and the streams will be polluted.
- We did not call all the villagers for public hearing meeting as it was not felt necessary.
- · We do not require the project.

- · We do not want project.

#### 10. Sri. Karma Sona, Ex-ASM

He put forwarded following:

- When project comes, natural beauty will be lost.
- If the project comes there will be impact on religious places like Hanuman Mandir, Guru Dwara etc.
- If dam is constructed, then there will be Water pollution and deforestation.
- Due to muck disposal the water of the river will be polluted. The river water is used for domestic consumption.
- · Let's contemplate, what are the advantages and disadvantages of the project.
- Let the project come after 10-15 years. At present the disadvantages will be more.

#### 11. Sri, Prupa Tsering Mane, Village Bijithang

He put forwarded following:

- The Company should have conducted a meeting with the Project Affected Families/Public.
- I have my own private land.
- I can sustain my life by cultivating on it.
- I don't have to sell my land to anybody.
- I shall not give an inch of my land for the project.
- I am not in favour of this project.

- Request the Company to cooperate with the PAFs while executing the project.

Shri .P.M Nanda, COO, M/s Mechuka Hydro Power Private Limited, then gave clarifications to the above queries which is enclosed as **Annexure-B**.

Sri. Ravi Dhawan, IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Mechuka Sub-Division, West Siang District addressed the gathering. He firstly congratulated the PAFs for sharing their views peacefully. He further added that its very motto is to share views and queries about the project. He hoped that the Company would take care of the doubts raised by the PAFs in the public hearing. He then thanked the Deputy Commissioner, West Siang District and the Member Secretary, APSPCB for conducting the meeting.

Sri Pige Ligu, Deputy Commissioner, Aalo, West Siang District -cum- the Chairman of the public hearing then addressed the public hearing. He thanked all for active participation in the public hearing. He appreciated the PAFs for sharing their views/suggestions and grievances. He further said that every word that the speakers had shared is recorded and documented.

He said that India is a democratic country and the views and objections raised by the speakers in today's meeting should be taken care of. He lamented that the public relation of the Company with the Project Affected Families (PAFs)/Public is very poor due to communication gap. The Company has to execute work with good intention as the project will take long time.

He further suggested the Project Proponent to maintain good public relation with the Project Affected Families (PAFs)/Public. Lastly, he thanked one and all present for attending the public hearing.


