An Environmental Public Hearing in respect of Pemashelpu Hydro Electric Project (81MW) executed by M/s Mechuka Hydro Power Private Limited was conducted on 11.08.2014 from 10.15 am onwards at Multipurpose Community Hall, Yorni, Mechuka, West Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh. The entire Public Hearing proceeding was presided over by Sri Pige Ligu, Deputy Commissioner, Aalo, West Siang District-cum- Chairman of the Public Hearing. In all 118 (One hundred eighteen) people attended the public hearing. The attendance sheet is enclosed as **Annexure-A**.

At the outset Sri N.Tam, IFS, Member Secretary, Arunachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board, Naharlagun while welcoming the Project Affected Families (PAFs)/Public elaborated the provisions of the EIA Notification dtd 14th September, 2006 and subsequent amendments issued by the Ministry of environment & Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India pertaining to Environmental Clearance for developmental projects and requirements of Environmental Public Hearing thereof.

The Member Secretary, APSPCB further explained that the objectives of the Environmental Public Hearing is to solicit and record the opinions, views, comments or objections of the people residing at and in the adjoining areas of project sites likely to be affected by the construction of the proposed Pemashelpu Hydroelectric Project (81MW). He further added that the Environmental Public Hearing is a part of the Environmental Clearance process and that the proceedings of the same will be submitted to the Ministry of Environment & Forests

Shri .P.M Nanda, COO, M/s Mechuka Hydro Power Private Limited explained the salient features of the project with the help of power point presentation. Later, Sri. Vivek Jhaldiyal , Consultant representing M/s R.S Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd. explained on environmental studies, sources of air pollution & its mitigation measures environmental management plan, management of air quality, water management, solid waste management, green belt development programme, social economic development etc.

The EIA/EMP studies are prepared by consultants M/s R.S Envirolink Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Gurgaon as per Terms of Reference (TOR) issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests.




Accordingly, the views/suggestions/objections/queries/word of appreciation expressed by the public participants are as follows:




- Notice of public hearing was not done in Bothi language.

7. Sri. Kesang Panden Philley, ASM, Kaling -Mechuka


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
- I will not allow the project to come in my area.

10. Sri. Karma Sona, Ex-ASM




- When project comes, natural beauty will be lost.

- Request the Company to cooperate with the PAFs while executing the project.







ISSUES RAISED BY THE PAFs/PUBLIC AND CLARIFICATIONS GIVEN BY THE PROJECT PROPONENT

We are thankful the public and land owners for participation in the public hearing and thankful to the public which stayed outside the venue but still participated fully in the public hearing by registering themselves and participated in the discussions through their many speakers and raised many valuable issues. I assure you all that all these points raised by the public will be considered and incorporated in the final EIA&EMP report.

S No	Issues Raised by PAFs/Public	Clarification given by Project Proponent
1	Company has not maintained any good rapport with the locals/public	Company has tried its best to keep good relation with locals and have maximum interaction on all issues. We accept that there might have been some shortcomings which we will try to improve as local public support is utmost importance to us for smooth implementation of the project. We request ADC, Mechuka-Sub Division, to constitute a coordination committee under them to facilitate the resolution of any such issues.
2	Damage to the Medicinal plants of the area.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ These aspects have been duly considered in the EIA/EMP report and there is a special process for Biodiversity consideration and plan which cover the medicinal plants also.➤ CAT plan for the project also has the provision for conservation of medicinal plants.➤ These two provisions will help in practicing and improving the medicinal plants in the area.

3	Memba Community is very less in number, if project comes then maximum land will be used for the project.	The land acquired for the project does not involve acquisition of any structure or cultivated land. Therefore, it is not likely that the land holding will be reduced extensively because the major quantum of land being acquired in the Dam area is mostly the River bed and areas adjoining to the Riverbed.
4	Damage to the area due to the construction of the project	<p>It is well accepted fact that there are always some damages during construction of the project. Therefore, it will be wrong to say there will not be any damages. Provisions under EMP Report have been kept only for this purpose to minimise the impact of the damages to the area, inconvenience to the public and compensation for the impacts of the project.</p> <p>Disaster Management Plan of the project has the provision for installing sirens, alert systems and warning systems to be installed along the river to inform the release of water from Barrage and this will be done near all habited locations (including Mechuka Town) downstream of project.</p>
5	Regarding Disaster Management during Dam Break	<p>➤ Though Dam break is not required for Barrages because it is a rare phenomenon, we carried out DAM/Barrage breach analysis and appended in the EIA/EMP report and it shows that damages to Mechuka Town is not likely to happen.</p> <p>➤ Site specific design parameter</p>

		study has been carried out by Earth quake Engineering Department of IIT-Roorkee for this project.
6	Earth Quake Zone and susceptibility of Barrage in view of Earth Quake.	➤ These days DAM/Barrages are designed with Site Specific/Area specific seismic parameters and same procedure will be adopted here also as per GOI guidelines.
7	Less of forest produce due to acquisition of land	➤ As per land requirement for the project around 12 Ha will be physically used for the project, where as balance 20 ha will be required only during construction stage. Secondly, compensatory Afforestation has been proposed for 64 Ha, therefore availability of forest produce in coming years will be more.
8	As Dam is near Chaina Boarder, likely damage in case of war and other reasons.	Project has been allotted by Arunachal Govt after considering all aspects and Ministry of Defence has also accorded NOC to us. These days distances have very less relevance and DAM and population/habitation is nearby areas are equally susceptible. This point has been addressed in the Disaster Management/Dam break issue.
9	Circulation of Executive Summary in Bhoti language	As per the normal practice we had prepared the executive summary in two main local languages that is Memba & Ramo (with Roman Script) as it was thought that more people would be able to understand it. This requirement of Bhoti language was not apprised to us at any stage.

		Otherwise we would have ensured the same also.
10	Possible damages to the Hanuman camp and Gurudwara	<p>➤ No damage is likely to occur in Hanuman camp and Mindir. The proposed tunnel is crossing at a considerable distance from these establishments. Right now, I am not able to tell you the exact distance, but I am of the view that, it should be around 300-400 m inside the hill from location of these establishments.</p> <p>➤ Gurudwara is located beyond the project area that is around 200 m downstream of our Tail race outlet and much above the HFL at that location.</p>
11	Company has not done anything for the public from the last 4 years	➤ Since the project is still under investigation and clearance stages, therefore company has not been able to take up CSR activities on bigger level, but company has always provided help and support in the times of need such as providing fuel and vehicles in case of medical emergencies, financial support for local fairs, and employment to local youth.
12	Creation of Barrage increases the land slides in the Area.	<p>Suitable Engineering and Biological measures have been suggested in CAT Plan & Reservoir RIM Treatment plan in EMP.</p> <p>This is important for us also to ensure that no such landslides occur in the reservoir area, because that tentamounts to increase in silt in the reservoir thereby impacting the project.</p>

13	No guarantee that Company will do whatever has been promised in the EIA report.	<p>At this stage we can only assure you that Company is bound to implement all the activities as mentioned in the EIA and EMP reports. The Company cannot deviate from these provisions. Regional office at Shillong (MoEF, Govt. of India) has been entrusted by Govt. of India to monitor and ensure the compliances of the provisions in the final EIA & EMP report (accepted by the Govt. of India while according the clearance) by physically visiting the site on Quarterly & Half Yearly basis.</p> <p>In case of non compliances of the provisions stipulated in the EIA & EMP report, the MoEF, Govt. of India can cancel the clearance accorded to the project.</p>
