## 1. Introduction

Exploratory drilling proposed in AA-ONJ/2 Block is included under activities specified in (Activity 1b) of the new EIA Notification dated 14<sup>th</sup> September 2006. It requires Environmental Clearance (EC) from the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF). Additionally, a copy of the report has to be submitted to the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH), Government of India (GoI) as Production Sharing Contract (PSC) requirements.

ONGC had submitted Form-1 of the EIA Notification, along with a Draft Terms of Reference (ToR) for EIA study to MoEF. MoEF has issued approved ToR vide letter No. J-11011/91/2012-IA II (I) dated 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2012. The approved ToR is attached as **Annexure 1.1** and is in compliance to ToR is presented at **Table 1.1**.

ONGC has conducted a systematic Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study as per approved ToR. The draft EIA report was submitted to Assam State Pollution Control Board in the month of March, 2014 for conduction of Public Hearing. ONGC had participated in two (2) Public Hearing for the wells at Assam on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. ONGC has accepted for consideration the views of relevant stakeholders who may be affected by the proposed project activity and the same has been incorporated in the final EIA report.

### 1.1 PUBLIC HEARING

The public hearing was conducted to understand the queries, grievances and expectation of local people due to proposed project activities. Two (2) public hearing were conducted for proposed Exploratory Drilling Project of the Pre- NELP Block AA-ONJ/2, One Public hearing were arranged at Pabda Gaon Panchayat Office for three locations at *RPAA*, *RLBK-1* and *RBK-3* whereas the other public hearing was held at Irrigation department Inspection Bungalow at Tundurkanti for balance three locations at *LBAA*, *RBK-1* and *RTDN-1*, coming within Assam province of the block. It is to mention that presently ONGC will not undertake any activities coming within Manipur and Mizoram province of the block.

The local people were satisfied due to establishment of ONGC in the respective villages. However they had few expectation and grievances towards ONGC, which are summarized as under:

1. Taking Care for prevention and control of pollution
2. Local Job Opportunities
3. Improvement of road infrastructure and overall local area development
4. Improvement in local drinking water facility.

To conclude, it can be said that the stakeholder had no objection to the proposed project activities.

The concise report of Public Hearing is given in **Table 1** whereas the notice of public hearing, Minutes of meeting and resolution during public hearing and attendance records are attached as **Annexure 1**.
