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1 Public Hearing

A public hearing was held in a school at Challang Pothar on 19th September, 2014 as part of the EIA study to understand the queries, grievances and expectations of local people due to the existing and proposed project activities (**Figure 1.1**). The people were made aware of the meeting through publication in two leading newspapers in English (The Assam Tribune) and Assamese (Dainik Jagran) on 20th August, 2014.

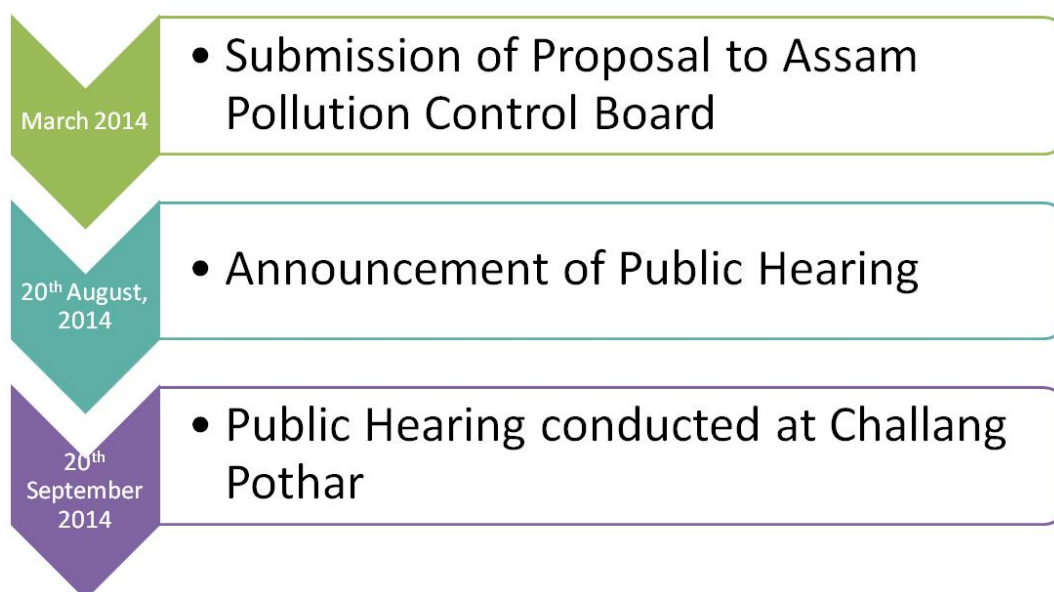


FIGURE 1-1: A SYNOPSIS OF PUBLIC HEARING HELD IN CHALLANG POTHAR

A Public Hearing was conducted in the LP School of Challdang Pothar on 20th September, 2014 as part of an EIA study for Exploratory/ development wells, GGS and Pipeline in Kasomarigaon Block to understand the queries, grievances and expectations of local people due to the existing and proposed Project activities. The people were notified of the meeting through a notice in two leading newspaper in English (Assam Tribune) and in Assamese (Dainik Janmabhoomi) on 20th August, 2014 (**Annexure 1.1**). The proposed activities qualify the Project under Category A and hence, the process of Public Hearing forms a pre-requisite for obtaining Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006.

The local people were concerned due to the activities of the ONGC. The key issues have been summarized below:

1. Road infrastructure
2. Plying of heavy vehicles
3. Mitigation measures for environmental pollution
4. Land acquisition and compensation
5. Accidents in the pipelines
6. Job opportunities

7. Funds for development of schools, church, namghor, etc
8. Channeling of waste gas that is burnt by ONGC to local people for use as fuel

It is to be noted that ONGC has already mobilized efforts to release funds to improve the infrastructure of schools of the area. Further, ONGC has commented that they will try and make provision for the other expectations. To conclude, it could be said that stakeholders had no objection to the project activities (**Annexure 1.2**). The concise report of the Public Hearing is given in **Table 1.1** and the Resolution and Minutes of the Minutes in detail is given in **Annexure 1.3** and the Attendance is given in **Annexure 1.4**.

ONGC agreed to look into the concerns raised by the villagers in the Public Hearing. For the people seeking employment, ONGC requested them to apply for interview in ONGC recruitment drives for the educated and skilled people. Whereas, for the uneducated, unskilled workers, temporary jobs will be available during construction of facilities.

Shri Anil Bera requested for jobs for himself and other unemployed youth, construction of road, funds for church, Namghor, and requested for the supply of the gas that is burnt as waste to be supplied to the houses of the poor to be used as fuel.	ONGC requested the crown to not be worried about the pipeline as they will be underground, equipped with pressure sensors and will be under routine check for anomaly.
3.	Shri Biren Ghatwal requested for funds for schools, proper roads	Further, ONGC announced that they had pollution control systems like ETP, acoustic enclosures to control water and noise pollution.
4.	Shri Bhadreshwar Bora asked for safety measures installed to prevent fire in the pipeline	ONGC said that they will speculate about the use of the waste gas that is usually discarded.
5.	Shri Bipul Mesh requested for employment with ONGC, fund and to utilize the waste gas	
6.	Shri Hiranya Gogoi asked for the measures to protect the environment from drilling work and Safety measures for pipelines. Further he requested for funds for schools, roads, and health facilities.

PCB official opined that there is no proven evidence to show that the burning of the waste gas will lead to crop loss. However, PCB will look into the matter of open burning.
9.	Shri Babul Dungdung wanted to know the extent of land that will be required for construction and what will be the amount of compensation. What will happen if someone did not want to part with his land	ONGC replied that 9ha of land will be required for the construction of the GGS. Rs.70,000 per bigha as per Government Laws. In case anyone is unwilling, negotiation will be done with the person.

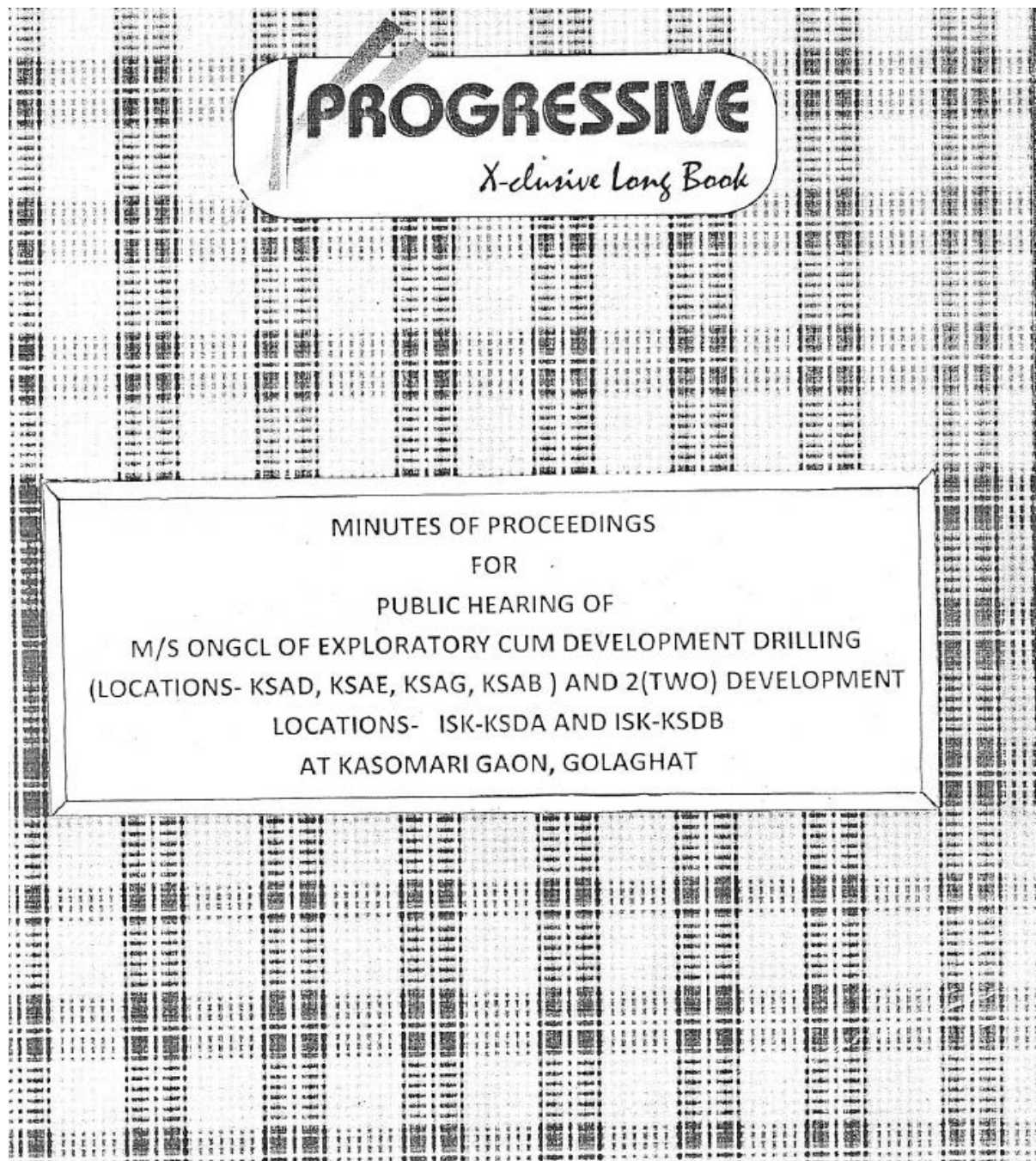

PROCEEDINGS (MINUTES AND RESOLUTION):

At the beginning, Sri B.K. Baruah, Chief Environmental Engineer, PCB explained the purpose of the Public Hearing as per the Notification, 2006.

As per the agenda, the Project proponent of M/s. ONGC spoke about the projects in details in Assamese language.

VIEWS OF PUBLIC:

Sebeswar Karanokar, a Gaonburah talked that public hearing arranged in the area and he gave thanks for that. He spoke that the area is Nayang Gari Panchayat and why drilling in Kasomari areas Public hearing is held here. He also alleged that the works of M/s. ONGC affected the area and requested the authority to take measures to mitigate pollution. He also requested to construct the road properly and plying of heavy vehicles should be restricted. Noise pollution will be there and hence request to take steps in this regard. If Colony will established in that area then it will affect the area due to dirt and waste water that will be discharge from the colony. Also request to provide health facilities in that area.

Anil Bora, 2 No Chollong Pathar, unemployed youth spoke that he is an unemployed so he requested to absorb him and other unemployed youth in M/s. ONGC and requested to construct the road that passes through Chollong Pathar and also request to provide funds for the Church, Nanghar etc. He also talked that in the ONGC Colony they have seen that a gas burnt in that area as waste so requested M/s. ONGC to provide these gas to the poor people.

Biren Ghatwal, Higher Madhyamik School President, spoke that they lived in a very backward place and they are mainly farmers and so he requested the authority to provide funds to the schools. He also requested M/s. ONGC to construct the road in proper way and in broader manner and also request to fulfill their grievances.

Bhadreswar Bora, Bordubi talked that the pipeline passes through the area may burst then what protection M/s. ONGC will give.

In this regard the M/s. ONGC authority spoke that the pipeline will be placed at depth of 100 to 150 cm below the soil so there is less

possibility of bursting. The authority will test the pipeline frequently and so they request the public not to construct any houses over the pipeline. Regarding gas he spoke that gas will be sold to Assam Gas Co. Ltd. and from there the public can take from that and till now the authority did not get the permission to sell the gas.

Bipul Mesh, a habitant of Mirapani spoke that M/s. ONGC gave the presentation and in that they gave some impact assessment and these are approved from the PCB. The gas burnt in the colony will affect the agrifarm and so the question the authority what measures they will take for pollution measures. Request to absorb the unemployed youth in the project and also request to use the CSR fund in that area and the waste gas and the works of M/s. ONGC will affect the area and the Pollution Board and M/s. ONGC will take the responsibility or not?

In this regard the PCB representative spoke that the EIA report does not need approval from the PCB. The Public hearing is held so that views of the public can be noted down. The EIA report will be forwarded to Delhi, MoEF without editing by Board's official.

In this regard the consultant of EIA report spoke that Jangam forest is not now in existence and Garampani Samalok is also far from the area.

The PCB representative also clear the matter that the burning of the gas affected the agrifarm is not established till now.

Hiranya Gogoi, spoke that due to drilling works the environment will be affected then what measures will be taken so that the area will not be affected. The pipeline will pass through over the land and what compensation will be given to them. Requested to construct fund for schools, roads and health facilities.

In this regard the ONGC authority spoke that sound pollution will be mitigate due to acoustic enclosure in the S.G. Set. They will construct the road for the public of the area in the next year from the CSR fund. They also spoke that to absorb unemployed youth they must attend the interview and definitely got absorbed and those who are unskilled labours they will be get absorbed in the project works which will be short term employment. Regarding providing fund to the schools the ONGC will provide sanitary toilet to the schools in that area. For the land they will give compensation for the house, agrifarm etc.

Laxal Rangha, Gaonburah spoke that due to loss for the waste gas burning in the area requested to compensate for the loss and wanted to know whether they will compensate for that loss or not.

In this regard the PCB representative spoke that the PCB will take action against the waste gas burning openly by ONGC.

ONGC explained that negotiation will be made.

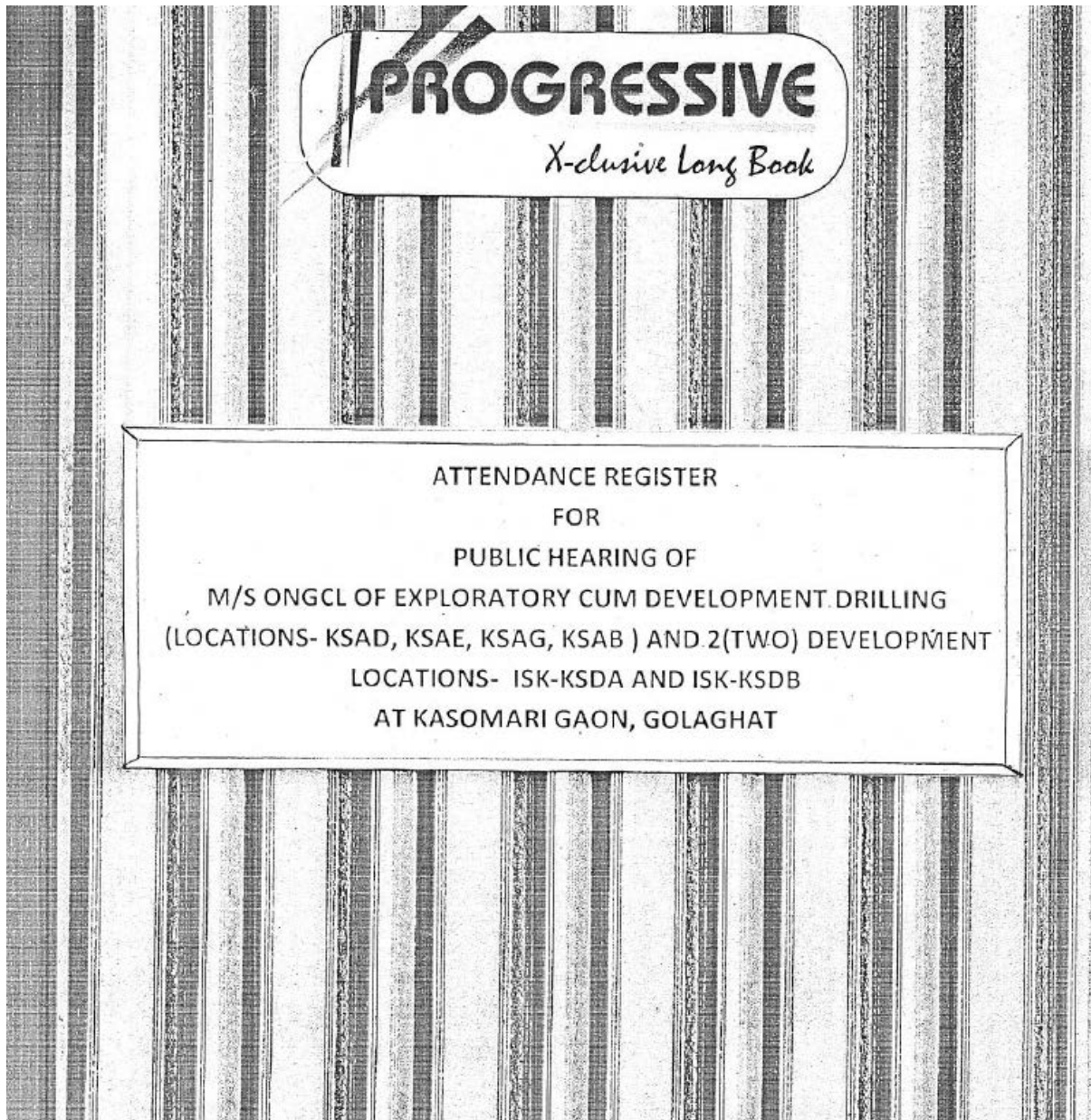
