7. PUBLIC CONSULTATION

7.0 Introduction

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, (MoEFCC) Government of India issued Environmental Impact Assessment notification S.O. 1533 dated September 16, 2006 mandating prior environmental clearance for manufacture of agrochemicals under category A for projects located outside notified industrial area/estate. The proposed project is located at Sy.No. 45/1 to 45/54 and 46/1 to 46/22, Kovvada Agraharam Village, Pusapatirega Mandal, Vizianagaram District, Andhra Pradesh. The proponents obtained the terms of reference from the MoEFCC, which mandated public consultation. Accordingly the draft Environmental Impact Assessment was submitted to Regional Officer, Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board, Vizianagaram District for conducting public hearing. The public hearing for the proposed synthetic organic chemicals manufacturing unit was conducted on 08.02.2017 at 10:30 AM Near Ramalayam Temple, Opposite Pradamika Patasala, Kovvada Agraharam village, Poosapatirega Mandal, Vizianagaram District. The public hearing was chaired by Sri M. Jitendra, District Revenue Officer & Addl. District Magistrate, Vizianagaram District and Sri K.L.P. Kumar, Environmental Engineer, Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board. Special Invitee Sri. Pativada Narayana Swamy, Member of Legislative Assembly, Nellimarla Constituency, Vizianagaram District.

MINUTES OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PROPOSED BULK DRUGS AND INTERMEDIATES MANUFACTURING UNIT OF M/S. SVL LIFE SCIENCE PVT. LTD, R.SY. NO.45/1 TO 45/54 AND 46/1 TO 46/22, KOVVADA AGRAHARAM (V), POOSAPATIREGA MANDAL, VIZIANAGARAM DISTRICT, ANDHRA PRADESH HELD ON 08/02/2017 AT 10:30 AM, NEAR RAMALAYAM TEMPLE, OPPOSITE PRADAMIKA PATASALA, KOVVADA AGRAHARAM (V), POOSAPATIREGA MANDAL, VIZIANAGARAM DISTRICT.

At the outset, while welcoming the gathering, the Environmental Engineer explained the features of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India, EIA Notification dated 14/09/2006. According to EIA Notification, Environmental Public Hearing is mandatory for getting Environmental Clearance for carrying this kind of establishment of Bulk Drugs and Intermediates Manufacturing Units from Ministry of Environment and Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi (MoEF), Govt. of India. He stated that M/s. SVL Life Science Pvt. Ltd, have applied for Environmental Clearance for the proposed Bulk Drugs and Intermediates Manufacturing Unit (135.3 TPM) on 26/02/2016 with MoEF, New Delhi. The Ministry Authorities have appraised the project and issued Terms of References (TORs) to this project i.e. M/s. SVL Life Science Pvt. Ltd., authorities to go for Public Hearing. He informed that the press notice was issued on 06/01/2017 in two newspapers i.e., "Andhra Jyothi" (Telugu) & "The New Indian Express" (English) and disseminated the same to the general public through beat of tom-tom in the villages intimating about the proposed Public Hearing to be held on 08/02/2017 with project details for inviting suggestions, views, comments and objections from the public for carrying out the proposed Bulk Drugs and Intermediates Manufacturing Unit by M/s. SVL Life Science Pvt. Ltd, R.Sy. No.45/1 to 45/54 and 46/1 to 46/22, Kovvada Agraharam (V), Poosapatirega Mandal, Vizianagaram District, Andhra

Pradesh and further informed that the EIA report was placed in the offices of Panchayats, Tahsildar in English and Telugu languages for information of general public.

No written representations were received within the stipulated time i.e. 30 days from the date of issue of notification. At the time of public hearing 147 written representations were received from the surrounding villagers and NGOs stating that the proposed project management shall assure to protect the environment in the surrounding areas and also provide employment to the local people only. The copies of the same are appended to the minutes.

The District Revenue Officer has explained that this is a Bulk Drugs and Intermediates Manufacturing Unit and he informed that the proposed project may have impact on environment in the surrounding areas. He, then, requested the Project authorities to explain the public about the activities and measures being taken up by the management to control the pollution and the salient features of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) study carried for this purpose.

Sri Sanyasi Naidu, Proponent & Chairman of the proposed project stated that the public hearing is being conducted by the AP Pollution Control Board to ascertain the views of the public on the proposed project. He further stated that M/s. SVL Life Science Pvt. Ltd., proposes to establish Bulk Drugs and Intermediates Manufacturing Unit at R.Sy. No. R. Sy. No. 45/1 to 45/54 and 46/1 to 46/22, Kovvada Agraharam (V), Poosapatirega Mandal, Vizianagaram District, Andhra Pradesh in an extent of 17.67 Acres of land. The capital cost of the proposed project is Rs.25.0Crores. He also stated that this project will generate employment of about 30 directly and 110 indirectly. He informed that he is native person of the village and attained sufficient experience by working in Bulk drug units for the past 24 years and now proposing to establish this unit with other partners with love and affection towards native place i.e. Kovvada Agraharam. He further informed that they will allocate 2% of their profits as part of CSR budget and the same will be spent for the development to surrounding villages. They will operate the industry as per the Government norms. He requested the public to co-operate for the establishment of the proposed unit in the area. He further informed that their consultant will explain the details of the propose project along with EIA study revelations.

Sri G.V. Reddy, Team Labs, Consultant of the proposed project has explained the public about the details of the proposed Bulk Drugs and Intermediates Manufacturing Unit which are as follows:

- ❖ M/s. SVL Life Science Pvt. Ltd., proposes to establish the unit in an area of 17.67 acres at Sy.No. 45/1 to 45/54 and 46/1 to 46/22, Kovvada Agraharam Village, Pusapatirega Mandal, Vizianagaram District, Andhra Pradesh. The capital cost of the project is Rs. 25 Crores.
- ❖ The Environmental Consultant of the proposed project has studied the base line data for Ambient Air Quality, Surface & Ground Water Quality, Noise and Soil Quality from March 2016 to June 2016.
- ❖ Water is required for process, scrubbers, washing, cooling tower makeup, steam generation and domestic purposes. The required water shall be drawn from bore wells within plant premises in addition to reuse of treated wastewater. The total water requirement is 257.7 KLD consisting of 146.7 KLD of fresh water and 111 KLD of recycled water.
- ❖ The management proposed to establish coal fired boilers of capacity of 10 TPH and 6 TPH. The required steam for process and ZLD system shall be drawn from 10 TPH boilers, while 6 TPH boilers shall be kept as standby. The DG sets requirement for emergency power during load shut down is estimated at 2000 KVA. Accordingly 2x1000 KVA and 1x500 KVA DG sets are proposed.
- ❖ The Effluent management system is developed to ensure 'Zero Liquid Discharge' system. No impact on water quality is expected due to the discharge of effluents as zero liquid discharge (ZLD) is envisaged ensuring reuse of treated effluents for cooling tower makeup. There is no usage of treated wastewater for on land irrigation.
- ❖ Solid wastes are generated from process, solvent distillation, effluent treatment system, DG sets and boilers. Stripper distillate, process residue and solvent residue are sent to cement plants for co-incineration based on acceptability as the same contain significant calorific value. If these wastes are not suitable for co-incineration, the same will be sent to TSDF facilitator. The evaporation salts will be sent to TSDF.
- ❖ Noise is anticipated from motors, compressors, centrifuges and DG sets. DG set shall be provided with acoustic enclosure. Motors and compressors shall be mounted properly to ensure reduction of noise and vibration. Employees working in noise generating areas shall be provided with appropriate personnel protective equipment.
- ❖ There is a potential for direct/indirect employment of about 30 people during construction phase and 110 during operation phase. The impact area will have positive benefits due to the project. The project shall have positive impact on socioeconomic environment due to provision of employment both direct and indirect

and also allocation of 2% of the profits towards CSR activities to be spent for the development of surrounding villages.



- 4) He informed that they are going to take pollution control measures such as construction Effluent Treatment System (ETP), Air Pollution Control Measures (APCM) with an investment of Rs.2.0 Crores besides ensuring Zero Discharge System (ZLD) and 100% recycling the treated water.
- 5) The company will ensure 2% of their profits for CSR activities and the same will be spent in the surrounding villages for the benefit of village development.
- 6) As suggested the government the management will take up plantation in the surrounding area.

While concluding the proceedings of the Public Hearing, the District Revenue Officer thanked the public for cooperating in conduct of the public hearing and expressing their views, suggested the management that as proposed the management should provide 2% of their profit under CSR budget and the same is to be utilized for permanent social beneficial activities, operate the plant in a sustainable way safeguarding the environment and public health, to ensure green cover in the plant as well as in surroundings and provide the proper skill development training to the local persons to make them suitable for job worthy and provide employment.

It is also informed that all the proceedings of the hearing was recorded and will be sent to the SEIAA, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India for taking further necessary action in respect of Environmental Clearance.
