That he works only one still or more of a liquid capacity not exceeding 2214 litres and that 11. he does not work his still before sunrise or after sunset; except for limited periods on special occasions, when by special licence / permit from the Collector, he may be allowed to work more than one still, or to work his still or stills between sunset and sunrise. 111.

That, still shall be of Brass on condition of keeping it clean and that the capacity must be cut or engraved on every still. (Stills, and the worts shall be regularly fire-heated to remove IV.

That he sells no spirits but the produce of his still, except as specially licensed / permitted. ٧.

That he does not remove the produce of his still to any place, except to his shop therewith attached without a pass from the Collector and that he enters in the pass the quantity so VI.

That he does not sell spirit to any person at one time, in quantity exceeding the limit of retail

That he does not use in distilling or mix with the spirit kept or sold in the shop any noxious VII. substance such as Kuchila, aconite or dhatura or any objectionable article such as tobacco, pepper or kerosene oil intended to increase the intoxicating power of the liquor or to increase VIII.

That he shall put materials under fermentation in vessels of uniform size and load them with the same quantity in each. The vessels shall be serially numbered. Date of loading shall be

noted on a signboard attached to a pole fixed in front of each vessel.

That he does not sell liquor on credit.

That he does not sell or deliver any country spirit to any person apparently under the age of eighteen years, whether for consumption by such person or by any other person and whether for consumption on or off the premises.

- That he does not, during the hours in which his licensed premises are kept open for business, employ or permit to be employed, in any part of such premises where liquor is XI. consumed, either with or without remuneration, any person under the age of eighteen years.
- That premises licensed for the retail vend of out still liquor may be kept open from 10:30 AM to 10:30 PM throughout the year or this timing of the shop as the Govt. decides. XII.
- The licensee shall maintain an account of materials placed under fermentation and the country spirit distilled from day to day and also keep an account of daily receipt and sale in such forms XIII.
- That he must keep the vicinity of the outstill and drains perfectly neat and clean.
- That he shall utilize Mahua flowers as per MGQ fixed by the Government. XIV.
- That he must use clean and hygienic water in manufacturing outstill liquor and take sufficient care for XV. proper disposal of spent-wash, keeping in view the health aspects of cattle and other animals and protection XVI.
- XVII. That he, as far as practicable, sell liquor in pouches/ poly packs of 200 ml capacity each with relevant declaration thereon and transport the same to the attached branch shops in the manner laid down in letter No. 5257/Ex. dt. 6.8.2009 of Excise Commissioner Odisha, Cuttack.
- XVIII. That he must ensure periodical examination of poly packs/ pouches/wash/liquor by the competent authority
- That he must abide by the rules made under The Orissa Excise Rules 2017 and the orders, notifications made under the Odisha Excise Act 2008 from time to time and also the provision contained in the Excise Policy of XIX.
- That the licensed premises of the E.P. holder for retail sale of Oustill liquor shall remain closed on the 2nd day of October on account of Mahamta Gandhi's birth day and during Election/ Bye-election to Assembly or XX. Parliament / Municipal Elections / Zilla Parisad /Panchayat Sammittee/ Gram Panchayat Elections etc. for the period as would be ordered by the Election Commission of India or State Election Commission. Such days have been specially declared as "Dry Days" and no compensation shall be payable on account of such
- That the State Government will not be responsible for providing the place / site for location of the shop. It will be the responsibility of the privilege holder to arrange suitable place and carry on the privilege granted XXI. to him. The place so arranged shall be free from objections from the public.
- XXII. That he must hang a signboard just in front of the shop showing the nature of shop, licence No with validity, name of the licensee etc . He shall affix/ hang a board containing the statutory warning "consumption of liquor is injurious to health".
- XXIII. All OS product i.e OS liquor should through Out Still Unit and branch shops should be of 70 degree UP
- XXIV. The MGQ of mahua flowers in all areas is fixed at 1 (one) quintals per Rs. 1000/- C. money.

N.B.- The violation of any of the above conditions or of the general conditions applicable to Excise Vend License will render this license liable to be cancelled and the Holder thereof liable to the penalties prescribed by the relevant law.
