PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES OF MEETINGS

Minutes of meeting of Public hearing conducted for environmental clearance of **Bhandahera (Ch 392.800) to Moondiya village (Ch 452.625) Section of Delhi – Vadodara access controlled (Greenfield) NH-148N from** by Project Implementing Unit (PIU), NHAI Kota on 04/09/2019.

In line with MoEf&CC EIA Notification dated 14/09/2006, Regional Office, Kota letter no. 1899 dated 25/07/2019 and District Collector, Kota letter. No. 3396 dated 01/08/2019, Public hearing for the development of **Bhandahera (Ch 392.800) to Moondiya village (Ch 452.625) Section of Delhi – Vadodara access controlled (Greenfield) NH-148N from** by Project Implementing Unit (PIU), NHAI Kota was conducted under the chairmanship of ADM, Kota at Morukala Rajeev Gandhi Seva Kendra, Panchayat Samiti Sangod , Tehsil- Kanwas, Kota, Rajasthan on 04/09/2019 afternoon 3:00 PM.

Details of attendees of public hearing were mentioned in Annexure – A. Advertisement for public hearing with venue and other details were published in English Daily news paper Times of India on 03/08/2019 and daily Hindi newspaper Danik Bhaskar, Kota on 02/08/2019.

Mr. Amit Juyal inaugurated the session welcoming the participants and briefed about the purpose of public hearing and the project details. Having briefed about the project, Sri Amit Juyal, with the permission of Chairman welcomed M/s Feedback Infra Private Limited to present project details to the participants.

Upon technical consultant from M/s Feedback Infra Private Limited, Mr. Raj Kumar Singh, elaborating various aspects of environment and assessed impacts for development, Attendees were requested to address suggestions and/or put forth their queries for resolution.

1. Mr. Shyam Vishnu, Village Chandranhadi

- The said land will supposedly take over the agricultural land, as land is the only medium of employment, therefore it is requested to consider the employment of the farmers.
- The D.L.C rate will be shown to effected farmer

2. Mr. Radeshyam Mina, Village Postman

- Requested to give information about compensation rate that will be given to farmers
- Requested to provide details about the land that going to be aquisitated
- Requested to give details about the acquired land due to the proposed project

3. Mr. Ramchand , Village-Bhudankadi

- During the project construction, people residing in the area, should get job.
- Requested to give details about the acquired land due to the proposed project
- Effected farmer should get compensation from DLC

4. Mr. R.K Aagrawal , Village Tumbad

- Due to land aquisitaion, part of his poli house will be effected, in that part both solar system and drip irrigation system is coming. Since both this item are important for the poli

house, without them it will be unusable. Compensation given by government has not given any details about this issue, so he has requested either give compensation of entire poli house or give facilities to transfer his poli house to different location.

- R.K. Agrawal is a retired person. After retirement, he has purchased the land in 2016, at the rate of 6,00,000 rupees per bigha. He is getting compensation of 2,00,00 for this land. Agrawal has requested to give compensation price of at least the original price when he has brought the land and also give separate amount for his poli house, solar system and drip irrigation.

5. Mr. Mahavir Prasad Mina, Village Dhavada

- Proposed road after construction will divide his land into two different segments on roadside. In this case he is enquiring about what facility will be given to move from one segment of his land to another.
- What will happen of the tube well and pipeline which is situated on the either side of proposed land.
- Government has decided the compensation price of the land there own. What is the source of income for the farmer whose land has been taken over due to proposed road? He also stated that there is no benefits from the proposed project for the local residents.
- Facilitate employment for the farmers from the government whose land has been acquired.
- Acquired land is coming under in joint accounts, but the right of land is belong to one person only. Therefore it is requested to give compensation rate to be given to one who has claim to the land.

6. Mr. PANNALAL, VILLAGE RICHHADIYA

- Farmer should get land. If government give a smaller amount compensation then, farmer would not be able to purchase the half of the area of land, which won't be profitable for local residents.
- Farmers should get desirable compensation price.

7. Mr. Bhopendra Singh Shekavat, Village Goyenda

- Land which is to be acquired is an ancestral land is the name of to relatives such as uncles, aunties and kids. As a result the acquired land is coming under in joint accounts, but the right of land is belong to one person only. Therefore it is requested to give compensation rate to be given to one who has claim to the land.

8. Mr. Sen Katariya, Village Aranyakheda

- The land which going to be acquired is ancestral land and farming has been done for three generations. Mr. Katariya has done installation of 9 borewell, out of this 4 is coming in acquired land. The installation has done by Mr. Katariya only. The compensation price is equally distributed among all members. Therefore it is requested to carefully think before giving compensation price.

9. Mr. Ghasilal, Village Pralaya

- Among the land to be acquired Mr. Ghosal building is also coming. The land does not have record of rights (patta) nor it have proper account. Therefore it is requested to give of different land along with patta.
- Local resident will not get any benefit
- The project proponent talked about reducing pollution through water sprinkler. The area is already suffering from water shortage, with the usage of water sprinkler, more shortage of water will occur.

10. Mr. Harilal Singh, Village Goynanda

- Land which is acquired by NHAI is irrigated land, however small part where his well is situated is not coming under the acquired land. Without agricultural land well will be useless. In order to construct well, he has spent seven lakh rupees. Therefore he has requested to provide compensation for well also.
- Administration has asked farmer for submission of documents related to land, but still now information related to farmer's land and well is not given.
- Compensation should be as per D.L.C rate. Allocated compensation rate of Ramgajmandi is higher than this area.
- Compensation should be as per farmer's business
- Farmers will not get any benefit from the proposed project.

Beside this Mr. Amit Juyal, Regional Officer, of Rajasthan Pollution Control Board requested Mr. Veerendra Singh, General Manager, NHAI to answer the queries/ problems/ request raised by people during Public hearing.

Mr. Veerendra Singh, Project Manager gave following replies—

- This public hearing is related to environment clearance. In order to spread information related to this public hearing, articles were published in two newspapers Times of India and Dainik Bhaskar and even pamphlets were distributed in order to reach local villages. As a result of this achievement about 100 villagers came for the hearing.
- Proposed project during its construction will not be using any groundwater. Instead Surface water source such as river and pond will be used. National highway authority of India has appointed M/s. Feedback infra private limited as the technical consultation for assessment of environment related issues and providing specific criteria for reducing the pollution. In fact if the criteria are correct then only environment clearance will be provided. Tree will be planted two times the ratio of the trees which going to be cut and amount for plantation will be given to forest department. Tree will be planted on both sides (Avenue **plantation**) as well as in the median. Rain water harvesting technology will also be installed so that ground water will also be recharged.
- During road construction priority will be given to regional resources.
- During construction local resident's people will get employment opportunity

- Compensation for land acquired for the improvement and rehabilitation shall be fixed as per LARR, 2013. If there is any problem related to compensation, then complaint can be given as per law through arbitration process.
- During land construction, if any property damage occurs, the compensation for that also will be given.
- If the acquired land belongs to joint account and the authority of the land belongs to one person only, then the issues will be resolved like any other land-related issues by the capable authority in the land department or subdivision authority.

Mr. Vasudev Malvatha, ADM, in order to gain special attention from NHAI authority spoke that main problem faced by farmers is that:-

- Issues related to environment will be settled with proper priority.
- Land acquisition process will be based on Land Acquisition Act 2013, and compensation will be given maximum.
- Compensation of both land will be given.
- Farmers' problem will be solved during practical process.
- During road construction, preference will be given to local farmers and resources.

Prior to the public hearing and during the public hearing, the Pollution Control Board or the District Administration did not receive any written suggestion / complaint related to the proposed project.

At the end of the public hearing, Mr. Vasudev Malawat, Additional District Magistrate and Mr. Amit Juyal, Regional Officer, Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board, Kota thanked the people and representatives present and announced the termination of public hearing.
