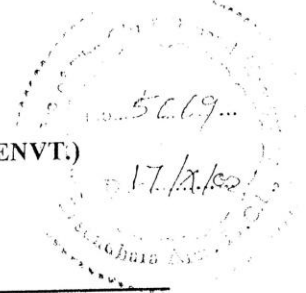

Sub: Grant of Permission in favour of M/s. MCL for Construction of
3 Nos. of Pick up weirs for drawal of water from Basundhara
river for supply of industrial water to the Coal mines and domestic
purpose of MCL.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to your letter No. 1463/1998, Dated 15/11/98 on the above subject and to state that the Govt. in W.R. Deptt. have been pleased to accord the administrative permission to M/s. MCL Ltd. to draw 3 MLD of water for industrial and domestic consumption from river Basundhara by constructing a weir subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The drawal will be in accordance with the provision of Orissa Irrigation(Amendment) Rules, 1998.
2. Mahapadi Coalfields will execute an agreement with the concerned Executive Engineer viz. competent authority in accordance with Orissa Irrigation(Amendment) Rules, 1998.
3. The Deptt. of Water Resources will not be responsible if the required quantity of 3 MLD water is not available during Dry season (lean period).






4. The Company will construct a temporary weir at their own cost to draw water and the design and drawing must be approved by the concerned Chief Engineer before construction of the weir by M/s.MCL.
5. M/s.MCL will dismantle the said weir after completion or during the construction of Dam project if required by DOWR.
6. The Company will pay the water rate/licence fee as fixed from time to time by Govt.
7. The flow meter should be installed at the cost of the company for drawal of water.
8. Any waste water generated will be treated by M/s.MCL at their own cost to acceptable norms before disposal.
9. The quantum of water drawn will be measured by the competent technical person to be nominated by concerned Executive Engineer from time to time.
10. There shall not be any disturbance with the present eco-system and other environmental set up with the minimum loss during transportation.
11. The R & R Action Plan/Welfare for Tribals if encountered shall be the responsibility of the company.
