**Decision of SEIAA –** Similar case has been disposed of by EAC MoEF by issue of ToR with express condition to submit DSR along with EIA study report. We may advise SEAC accordingly to issue TOR with a condition to submit DSR with EIA.

**Decision of SEIAA** – We may request SEAC to examine whether there is a real need for such a project for Deogarh town and whether the same purpose of solid waste management may not be addressed by grounding small scale facilities on a dispersed scale.
