Minutes of the 11th Meeting of SEIAA held on 09-09-2019

The meeting chaired by the Chairman, State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttarakhand (SEIAA) Dr S.S. Negi was attended by following:

- i. Shri Shailendra Singh Bisht, Member, SEIAA, Uttarakhand.
- ii. Shri G.S. Pande, Member Secretary, SEIAA

The meeting started with welcome address by Chairman, SEIAA,

Following agenda item was discussed and decisions taken :-

- 1) Consideration of pending proposal of meeting of 8th March, 2019.

The Authority deliberated on the pending applications of project proponents who had not submitted required documents as indicated in 6th meeting of SEIAA held on 6-7 March, 2019 (minutes issued vide letter no- 141/SEIAA dated- 8th March, 2019). It was observed that Cluster Certificates have now been submitted & District Survey Report (DSRs) include necessary required information. On examination it was found that E.Cs have already been granted in respect of eight similar applications in 8th and 11th meeting of the Authority. After discussion it was considered appropriate that the SEIAA may accept the recommendations of SEAC in respect of following project proponent:-

M/s Gopal Singh Bisht R/o- Parvatiya Enclave, Village - Manpur, Tehsil - Kashipur, District - Udham Singh Nagar. (2.80 Ha)

- 2) M/s N.B. Minerals Village Dundu, Tehsil Didihat, District – Pithoragarh.

The report of the committee in the matter has not been received. After deliberations it was decided that after the report is received it will be considered in the next meeting on 16th September, 2019.

- 3) M/s Campus Activewear Pvt. Ltd. at Plot No- C-9, C-10, Selaqui, Tehsil- Vikas Nagar, District- Dehradun.

The site was inspected by the Dr. S.S. Bisht, Member SEIAA, on dated 3-08-2019. The report submitted by him was discussed and it was observed that it is a case of violation. It was decided that the matter of E.C of M/s Campus Activewear Pvt. Ltd may be forwarded to SEAC to proceed as a case of violation as per MoEFCC notification dated 8th March, 2018.

- 4) Consideration of application of M/s SJVNL at Mori, District-Uttarkashi.

The EC has been accorded by MoEF&CC, New Delhi on 16th June, 2016 for 60 MW Naitwad Mori HE Project and it has been informed that out of two quarry sites located in Devta Range and Sandra Range only one site in Devta Range, Bhasala Compartment No. 1, 2 & 3 shall be exclusively used only for mining of aggregates for construction of 60 MW Naitwad Mori HE Project. The PP M/s SJVNL at Mori, District-Uttarkashi have requested EC for mining of R.B.M. in demarcated area of 1.755 Ha out of 3.5 Ha in Devta Range, Bhasala Compartment No. 1, 2 & 3. The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance subject to terms and conditions.

5) Review of preparation of DSR by the State Government.

SEIAA has received the DSRs (R.B.M.) for 10 districts (Dehradun, Pauri, Garhwal Uttarakashi, Rudrapur, Haridwar, Tehri Garhwal, U.S. Nagar, Champawat, Chamoli & Pithoragarh) and DSRs (Soapstone) for 2 districts (Pithoragarh & Bageshwar) in the first week of September 2019. On preliminary examination certain crucial discrepancies have been observed by the Authority which need to be corrected. After deliberations it was decided that a meeting in this matter may be organized on 16th September, 2019 with concerned officers of Mining Department for doing needful.

6) Environment Clearance for Aviation Fuel Station of Indian Oil Corporation at Jolly Grant Airport, Dehradun.

Indian Oil Corporation have sought clarification regarding setting up of Aviation Fuel Station at Jolly Grant Airport, Dehradun. As the matter relates to clarification on EIA Notification, 2006 it was decided to refer this to MoEF&CC.


7) Miscellaneous matters.


(i) Application of M/s Naari Pharma Pvt. Ltd for proposed bulk drug and intermediates manufacturing plant at plot 14-15-16, and 55-56-57 sector -5 IIE Panth Nagar Rudurpur, US Nagar. In this proposal ToR has been issued by MoEF&CC. The Bulk Drug and intermediates are active ingredients with medicinal properties. The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance subject to terms and conditions recommended by it and strict compliance of THE MANUFACTURE, STORAGE AND IMPORT OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICAL RULES, 1989.

(ii) M/s Katyani Associates, 40-D, Race Course, Dehradun. It was brought to the knowledge of the Authority that this project is already operational without prior EC and was found to be a case of violation. It was decided that the matter of E.C of M/s Katyani Associates, 40-D, Race Course, Dehradun may be forwarded to SEAC to proceed as a case of violation as per MoEF&CC notification dated 8th March, 2018.


