The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting.

The Member Secretary, SEIAA welcomed the Chairman and the Member of SEIAA. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEIAA, the Committee took up items agenda-wise and reviewed the recommendations of State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC). After detailed deliberations & discussions on the recommendations of the SEAC, the SEIAA recorded their decisions on case to case basis as under.

Agenda M/s. Emmennar Pharma Private Limited., Sy. No: 10, IDA, Gaddapotharam, Item: 01 Jinnaram (M), Medak District – Environmental Clearance - Reg.

After detailed examination of the proposal and recommendations of the SEAC, the SEIAA made the following observations:

The Government of AP (combined state) vide G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007 imposed restrictions on Establishment / Expansion of Bulk Drugs & intermediate manufacturing units in all the industrial estates / industrial development areas and 1 km around these industrial areas in the Medak District. Subsequently, the State Government vide G.O.Ms. No. 64, dt. 25.07.2013 amended the G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007. In the amendment order, expansions of production of all types of existing Bulk Drug & Bulk Drug intermediate manufacturing units are permitted, subject to the installation of Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) facilities".

Initially, the unit was established before 1991 under the name of M/s Reliance Rubber Works limited and used to manufacture Reclaimed rubber. Subsequently, the unit was taken over by the current management viz., M/s. Emmennar Pharma Pvt. Ltd., in the year 2003. In 2005, the unit changed its product from reclaimed rubber to Sucralose, L-Ectoine and R&D activity and obtained CFE & CFO from the APPCB. As per the Consent the industry is permitted for manufacturing Sucralose – 50 kg/day and L-Ectoine – 50 kg/day with Bio-Technology process only and with a condition that process should not involve chemical synthesis and also not to manufacture commercial products of Bulk Drugs/Intermediates. It can be noted from the above that the existing activity of the industry is Manufacture of Bio-technology products only. Hence, the unit cannot be considered as Bulk Drug / Bulk Drug Intermediates manufacturing unit.

Now, the industry claims that their process is partially fermentation process and mostly chemical synthesis. But, they were not permitted to carryout chemical synthesis, as per their Consent.

Further, the industry is manufacturing Sucralose which is a drug supplement and listed in Pharmacopeia, as informed by the proponent. But, as per GO No.64, lifting of ban is for the existing Bulk Drug and Bulk Drug Intermediate manufacturing units with Zero Liquid Discharge facility. If it has to be considered as a 'Bulk drug' to consider under G.O. Ms. No. 64, the industry has not obtained any Ex-Post Facto EC, as all the defaulting industries were to obtain EC under EIA Notification, 1994 as per Circular dt. 14.05.2002 of the MoE&F, GoI. Accordingly, many defaulting units have obtained EC / Ex-Post Facto EC during 2003 – 2005/2006. But, this industry has not obtained any EC, mentioning the products as Bio-technology products.

The industry has changed the line of activity from Reclaimed Rubber to Bio-technology products in the year 2005 and now proposed expansion by again changing the line of activity from Bio-technology products to Bulk Drugs & Intermediates through Chemical Synthesis. But, keeping in view of the provisions of G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007 of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP and G.O.Ms. No. 64, dt. 25.07.2013 of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP, the proposed Expansion has to be treated as a New activity / unit only due to change in category, which cannot be permitted due to Ban.

Also, the industry is not manufacturing the existing products but doing the job works by manufacturing un-consented products, which is not a permissible activity.

After detailed discussions and keeping in view of the provisions of GOs issued by the State Government w.r.t. Ban; Circulars/Office memorandums issued by the MoE&F, GoI, & S.O.No.804 (E), Dt.14.03.2017 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI, w.r.t. Violation, the SEIAA concluded that proposed Expansion of the industry is to be treated as a New industry only which cannot be permitted due to Ban (G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007 of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP).

In view of the above, the SEIAA decided to Reject the proposal.
