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Recommendations of the SEAC on 11.10.2018:

The representative of the project proponent and their consultant M/s. Vision Labs have attended the meeting and presented the case.

The Committee noted that this is a new Colour Granite mine. The Director of Mines & Geology, Ibrahimpatnam has issued In-principle letter on 21.03.2018 for the mining lease. The mining plan was approved on 30.05.2018. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Vizianagaram vide letter dated 12.06.2018 stated that there are two quarry leases (9.0 Ha. & 6.0 Ha.) within 500 meters of the proposed mine of 9.290 Ha. of M/s. Kishore Granites.

It is noted that these three mines together with the proposed mine, forms a cluster with a total extent of area- 24.290 Ha. <25 Ha. Hence, the present proposal falls under category 'B2' project. The project proponent submitted the cluster EMP.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- (i). Mining of minerals (<100 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The proposed mine is near to the inter States boundary. The State Boundary is 3.7 km from A.P. -Odisha State boundary. As per the MoEF&CC, GoI, New Delhi Notification S.O.No.141 (E),dated 15.01.2016, the General Condition is exempted for the minor mineral mining {<25 Ha for project or activity of mining of minor minerals of Category 'B2' (up to 25 ha of mining lease area)}.

The Committee recommended for issue of Environmental Clearance to this Colour Granite mining project for the proposed production quantities Colour Granite –26,534 m³ /annum, duly stipulating a condition that the Project Proponent shall maintain the setback distance 7.5 meters buffer zone all around the mine lease area for greenbelt development; obtain necessary permissions from the competent authority for the approach road and other conditions to be fulfilled. The project proponent shall allocate sufficient funds for implementation of CSR activities as committed by the proponent/representative along with the EMP: (providing RO Plant in Laxminarayanapuram village and plantation in the nearby villages).

The Committee noted that this is a new Colour Granite mine. The Director of Mines & Geology, Ibrahimpatnam has issued In-principle letter on 21.03.2018 for the mining lease. The mining plan was approved on 30.05.2018. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Vizianagaram vide



letter dated 12.06.2018 stated that there are two quarry leases (9.0 Ha. & 9.290 Ha.) within 500 meters of the proposed mine of 6.0 Ha. of Smt. M.Madhu Priya.

The Committee noted that this is a new Galaxy Granite mine. The Director of Mines & Geology, Ibrahimpatnam has issued In-principle letter on 20.06.2003 for the mining lease. The mining plan was approved on 27.10.2016. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Ongole vide letter dated 08.03.2018 stated that there are 5 quarry leases (12.696 Ha., 5.099 Ha., 2.125 Ha., 2.730 Ha. & 14.70 Ha.) within 500 meters of the proposed mine of 12.695 Ha. of M/s.APMDC. The proposed mine lease is in the Chimakurthy mines cluster with more no.of mines this cluster. The details of other mines have to be furnished by APMDC to ascertain the extent of cluster.

The Committee recommended to defer the case and the project proponent M/s. APMDC shall submit the details of all the mines/ mine leases in the Chimakurthy cluster in Chimakurthy Mandal, Prakasam District, for further appraisal.

Divi's Laboratories Limited (Unit - 2), obtained the Environmental Clearance for modernization of Bulk Drug Unit at MoEF&CC, New Delhi vide EC Order No. F.No.J-11011/316/2016-IA-II(I), dated 1st August 2017.The present proposal is for expansion of production capacity of Bulk drug Unit. [existing capacity as per EC order for bulk drug products -87 Nos. and R&D products and after expansion bulk drug products to 89 Nos. and R&D products].

The Chippada and Annavaram villages are notified as industrial areas i.e., IDA- Chippada for Chippada and Annavaram villages in Visakhapatnam District.

Earlier this proposal was appraised in the SEAC,A.P. meeting held on 06.04.2018 and the Committee noted that the proposed project falls under Item No. 5(f) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- Synthetic organic chemicals industry (dyes & dye Intermediates; bulk and the exemption of public consultation , as provided under Para 7(i) III.Stage (3)(i)(b) of EIA Notification, 2006.The Committee recommended for issue the Standard Terms of Reference



(TOR) with exemption of public hearing to the expansion of bulk drug production capacity from the existing bulk drug products: 87 Nos. and R&D products – 6319.5 Tons per annum to 89 Nos. and R&D products – 10739.5 Tons per annum.. The Authority in its meeting held on 24.04.2018 agreed with the recommendations of SEAC, A.P. for issue of Standard TOR with exemption of public hearing as it is located in IDAs - Chippada and Annavaram in Visakhapatnam District and for issue of Addl. TOR that the project proponent shall submit *the certificate of compliance of EC order of existing Bulk Drug Unit*. The SEIAA, A.P., on 14.05.2018 issued the TOR to the industry with exemption of public hearing as it is located in IDAs - Chippada and Annavaram in Visakhapatnam District and the Addl.TOR.

The industry prepared the EIA report and submitted the application for Environmental Clearance through online on 10.08.2018 and requested for issue of Environmental Clearance (EC).

The industry has not submitted the certified compliance report of the existing Environmental Clearance Order dated 01.08.2017. The industry submitted the Half- yearly compliance report to the MoEFCC, Regional Office, Chennai on 07.07.2018.

The industry, on 19.09.2018, requested the MoEFCC, Regional Office, Chennai for the certified compliance report of EC order dated 01.08.2017, but the report is not yet received.

The project proponent presented the final EIA Report with self Half-yearly compliance reports of the earlier Environmental Clearance issued on 01.08.2017 and the existing industry's CFO compliance reports. As per the EIA report, the existing bulk drug unit consented production capacity is 6,319.5 TPA , waste water generation - 1448.7 KLD , Treated effluent reused - 600 KLD and Sea discharge – 814 KLD. After expansion, the proposed production capacity is 10,739.5 TPA, waste water generation -3737KLD, Treated effluent reused – 1850 KLD and Sea discharge- 1887 KLD. As per the EC Order dated 1st Aug 2017 of the industry , the permitted Sea discharge is 814 KLD after meeting the marine standards through a dedicated pipeline from the industry to the sea. Now, after proposed expansion, the sea discharge will increase from 814 KLD to 1887 KLD for which they have to obtain the CRZ clearance for the enhancement of marine outfall discharge under CRZ Notification 2011.

The Committee after deliberations and taking the cognizance of the compliance reports of the industry, recommended for issue of Environmental Clearance for expansion to manufacture the Bulk drugs (89 products) and R&D products : production capacity from 6319.50 Tons per annum to 10739.50 Tons per annum duly stipulating a conditions (i) . The industry shall obtain the CRZ Clearance under the Coastal Regulation Zone Notification 2011; (ii). To take conservation measures for safety of sea turtles in the Gosthani River estuary.

- 3. It is pertinent to mention SEIA issued EC in the name of Madhava Swamy on 16.03.2009.*
- 5. During 2015 an amendment to mining lease was carried with higher quantity*
- 6. Accordingly the proponent Surya International had applied for EC for the enhance quantity,.*
- 7. As the EC was not in the name of the firm, the proponent was denied for expansion and recommended to have the change of name.*
- 8. As the MOEF regional centre Chennai issued the compliance of EC on the name of Surya International, SEAC recommended accordingly for change of name of EC.*
- 9. However on reverification, on the advice of SEIAA, it was observed that Surya International does not have EC on his name. Hence, the SEAC recommended that the proponent may be advised to transfer the EC on to the name of Surya International if they wish to come for expansion.*

In the light of the above observations, the committee recommended that the project proponent be informed to apply to the SEIAA, AP for the Transfer of Environment Clearance (ToEC), along with the reasons for delay in filing of application, as the mine lease was transferred in favour of M/s. Surya International Mine & Traders.

The project proponent shall allocate sufficient funds for implementation of CSR activities as committed by the proponent/representative along with the EMP: (providing RO Plant in Mallareddypalli village and plantation in the nearby villages).

Decision of SEIAA: Agreed with recommendation of the SEAC, A.P for issue of EC.

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Recommendations of the SEAC on 13.10.2018:

The project proponent and their RQP have attended the meeting and presented the case.

The Committee noted that this is an existing Laterite Mine. The Mine lease was granted through G.O Ms No. 5, Inds & Comm [MIII] Dept. dt. 04-01- 2002 and commenced mining from 2002. The Dy. Director of Mines &Geology, Visakhapatnam, issued letter on 22.05.2018 for mining lease for the balance period upto 2022. The mining plan was approved on 22.05.2018. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Ongole vide letter dated.19.07.2018, stated that there is no mine existing within 500 meters.

The Project proponent stated that the Mine lease was granted through G.O Ms No. 5, Inds & Comm [MIII] Dept. dt. 04-01- 2002 and commenced from year 2002 and the same was in force



upto 30-05-2022. The Mine was operated from 2002 to 2005 from 2005 onwards, mining operation were not carried out because of local approach road and lessee financial crises, as well as low demand in the market. At present, the mine is not in operation. The Deputy Director of Mines & Geology, Visakhapatnam, vide Ltr No 491/SM/AKP/2018, dated 22-05-2018 issued Order of Quarry lease for Laterite mine for unexpired lease period over an extent of 7.50 Ha., in Survey No 98/1&2, 99, 101/1&2 and 102/P at Pedajadumuru Village, G. K. Veedhi Mandal, Visakhapatnam Dist, Andhra Pradesh in favour of M/s. Modimamba Minerals, Mg. Partner: Sri. S Govinda Rao for the unexpired lease period upto 30-05-2022. Now they have applied for obtaining EC for the proposed production of 3,21,156 TPA. It is noted that this mine was operated without EC during the period the period 2002 to 2005.

The committee observed the following deficiencies

1. The land documents could not be produced to the extent of the land claimed.
2. Even the land documents showed to a limited extent also do not have any mention of mining lease.
3. Production quantities varied in the ADMG letter and the letter claimed by the proponent.

Hence, the committee recommended to write a letter to ADMG for clarification on the production as well as the calculation of the extent of mining lease land. Also as it is a major mineral the committee sought the clarification regarding the possibility of it being a violation case.

Decision of SEIAA: Noted.

The mining lease was granted on 22.07.1996 by the Industries Com.(MI) Department, Govt of A.P., vide G.O.Ms.No. 15, dated: 22.07.1996 for lease period of 20 years. The Mine lease was executed by the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Nellore vide Procds.No. 2717/M1/96, dated: 18.01.1997, from 18.01.1997 to 17.01.2017. *Now, applied for 1st renewal of mining lease.* The Project proponent stated because the mine workings were closed since 2004-05, no mining scheme was submitted. Now the new mining plan prepared and approved by the Dy. Director of Mines & Geology, Guntur on 24.10.2016 for the mining scheme of 5 years. In the mining plan, it was mentioned that the maximum production during 1st scheme of mining (1997-98 to 2001-02) is 3010 TPA. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Nellore vide letter dated.27.03.2018, stated that there is no mine existing within 500 meters. The total extent of proposed mine lease



area (5.685 Ha.) is less than 25 Ha. Hence, the present proposal comes under category 'B2' project.

The PP submitted the letter issued by the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Nellore vide letter: Lr. No. 2717/M2/1996, dated 22.03.2017 stated that the production during 1997-98 & 1998-99 is Nil, 1999-2000- 990 Tons & 2000-01 - 650 Tons, 2001-02 to 2016-17 is Nil.

The mining plan was approved on 12.06.2018. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Tadipatri vide letter dated July, 2018, stated that there is no mine existing within 500 meters.

The total extent of proposed mine lease area (24.018 Ha.) is less than 25 Ha. Hence, the present proposal comes under category 'B2' project.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- (i). Mining of minerals (<100 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

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Recommendations of the SEAC on 13.10.2018:

The representative of project proponent and their consultant M/s. SV Enviro Labs & Consultants have attended the meeting and presented the case.

The Committee noted that this proposal was earlier appraised in the SEAC, A .P., meeting held on 26.09.2017 .The committee noted that earlier, the project proponent submitted the EC application on 10.02.2015 & June 2016.The same was placed before the SEAC meetings held on 10.02.2015 and SEIAA meeting held on 16.02.2015 and noted that it is a violation case. A letter was addressed to EFS&T on 22.04.2015 for taking credible action.

A case was filed against the project proponent in the Hon'ble Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Nellore vide calendar case No. 147/2016. The credible action was received from the government on 09.05.2016. Earlier TOR issued on 13.07.2016. The public hearing was conducted on 03.08.2017.

The project proponent submitted the application for EC with final EIA report on 19.09.2017 along with the copy of the counterfoil of penalty amount paid of Rs.1,00,000/- to the Hon'ble Court, II Addl. Magistrate of I class , Nellore.

The MoEF&CC issued Notification vide S.O.804(E), dated 14th March 2017 on the procedure to be followed while dealing with the cases of violations of the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006.

The Committee opined that the credible action for EIA - 2006 violations, against this mine was initiated, before the issue of procedure on violation cases by MoEF&CC, New Delhi (i.e before 14th March 2017) and hence recommended for issue of EC. Also the aforesaid notification dated 14th March 2017 was challenged before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras vide W.P.No.11189/2017 and W.P.M.P.No. 12134/2017. The Hon'ble High Court has stayed the Notification in the month of May, 2017.

The Committee recommended for issue of Environmental clearance to this Mica, Quartz and Feldspar mining project for the production quantities Quartz – 12000 TPA,Feldspar-30000 TPA, Mica - 3,000 TPA, without prejudice to the orders/directions of the Supreme Court/any Hon'ble High Courts/NGT etc., and also stipulating a condition that the project proponent shall maintain the setback distance 7.5 meters buffer zone all around the mine lease area for greenbelt development and other conditions to be fulfilled.

The SEIAA,A.P., in its meeting held on 04.10.2017, the Authority decided that this aspect to be examined legally and hence deferred.

The Ministry of Environment Forest &Climate Change, Govt.of India, New Delhi – Office Memorandum issued on 16th March 2018 stated that the project proponents of violation cases have to submit their proposals within 30 days time.

M/s. Sri Bhagavan Mines submitted the application through online on 31.03.2018 and requested for the Environmental clearance. Also the project proponent submitted the Notorised affidavit through online on 27.08.2018.



The committee noted the SEIAA, A.P., obtaining the legal opinion on processing of violation cases.

The Committee recommended to defer the case till the receipt the legal opinion on violation cases, for further appraisal.

Decision of SEIAA: Noted.

This proposal was earlier appraised in the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its meetings held on 19.10.2013. During consideration of the said proposal, it emerged that the proponent started mining operations without obtaining necessary environmental clearance, thereby violating the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. The SEIAA, A.P. addressed a letter to the Special Chief Secretary to Government, EFS&T Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Secretariat, Hyderabad on 06.02.2014 for initiating credible action on the violation and for taking legal action against the unit and requested to information credible action to the SEIAA, A.P. The credible action taken report not received from the Govt. to the SEIAA, A.P.

The Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) issued notification S.O. 804(E), dated.14th March, 2017 prescribing procedure to deal with violation cases. As per Notification, all the violation cases as on date of Notification i.e., 14th March, 2017 shall be to be dealt by EAC only at MoEF&CC, New Delhi. It was subsequently MoEF&CC amended the notification vide S.O. 1030(E) dated 8th March 2018 and issued Office Memoranda dated 15th & 16th March 2018 stated that the project proponents of violation cases have to submit their proposals within 30 days time.

The matter on the violation cases was discussed in the SEAC meetings held on 12.05.2018 & 23.06.2018 and the SEIAA in its meetings held on 02.06.2018 & 02.07.2018 and decided that (i).*All the violation cases shall be filed with an notarised affidavit / sworn in affidavit by the proponent, in the prescribed format to the Member Secretary, SEIAA, Andhra Pradesh for consideration of TOR / EC as per the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and O.M dated 30.05.2018 issued by the MoEF&CC, Govt Of India., and (ii). The proposals (violation cases) received after 14th April 2018, shall be returned to the project proponents, since the time limit prescribed by MoEF&CC, Govt of India, in its O.M dated 16.03.2018, got expired by 14.04.2018. As per the decision of Authority, all the proposals (violation cases) received after 14th April 2018 were returned vide letter dt: 31.07.2018.*

The Project Proponent submitted the EC application through online on 31.05.2018 (after 14th April 2018) vide proposal No. SIA/AP/MIN/26257/2018 by enclosing penalty amount of Rs. 40,000/- paid to the Hon'ble Judicial of 1st Class Tekkali on 27.09.2017. And the same was



returned to the project proponent through online on 01.08.2018 as per the decision of the SEIAA,A.P. in its meeting held on 02.07.2018.

The committee further noted that APPCB issued stop production orders to M/s. M.S.P. Granites vide order dated: 22.05.2018 for operating the Mine without EC and CFE / CFO of the Board.

The Project proponent filed a Writ Petition No 19509 of 2018 in the Hon'ble High Court, A.P and the same was disposed by the Divisional Bench of Hon'ble High Court and issue the following order vide dated: 23.07.2018. *“Therefore, the competent authority will take up Ex.P-3 and if any application is filed for consent to operate, that will also be taken up, and decided upon in accordance with law. Needless to say, no such decision shall be rendered adverse to the interest of the petitioner without giving an opportunity of pre-decisional hearing. Let this be done within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment and any application for issuance of consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act”*. The project proponent submitted the representation to the APPCB and also to the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Tekkali, Srikakulam District by enclosing the Hon'ble court orders. 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Recommendations of the SEAC on 13.10.2018:

The representative of project proponent and their consultant M/s. Team Labs and Consultants have attended the meeting and presented their proposal along with final EIA report.

The Committee noted that M/s. The Andhra Sugars Limited., was established in 1990 and involved in manufacturing of synthetic organic chemicals. It is propose to expand manufacturing capacity of Hydroxy Terminated Poly Butadiene (HTPB), UH-25 (UDMH-75% + HH 25%), Monomethyl hydrazine (MMH) and inclusion of Isrosene. These chemicals are manufactured for exclusive use as propellant for satellite launch vehicles like PSLV and GSLV by Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO). The existing industry manufacturing the synthetic organic



chemicals (3 products) – 1239 Kg and proposes to increase the production capacity from 1239 kg/day to 12650 kg/day with 4 products in Phase I& II.

This industry is located in the notified industrial area i.e., Venkatarayapuram Industrial Area Township, West Godavari District.

The proposed project falls under Item 5(f) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- Synthetic organic chemicals , bulk drug and intermediates, dyes & dye intermediates etc.) and the exemption of public consultation, as provided for under Para 7(i) III. Stage (3)(i)(b) of EIA Notification, 2006.

The Standard Terms of Reference (TOR) was issued on 14.05.2018 with with exemption of Public hearing with additional TOR : Condition-wise compliance on Consent For Operation (CFO) of the existing Plant.

 - b. An application seeking prior environmental clearance for the projects/activities listed in the schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006, henceforth shall be made by the project proponent before commencing any construction activity, or preparation of land, or mining at the site, as given below:
 - i. For building/construction projects (item 8 of the Schedule), in the prescribed **Form-1** given in Appendix I, along with Supplementary Form 1A as given in Appendix II, as prescribed in EIA Notification, 2006 and a copy of the detailed conceptual plan;
 - ii. For mining projects of minor minerals up to five hectares under Category "B2" - In the prescribed **Form-IM** given in Appendix VIII, as prescribed in EIA Notification, 2006 along with a copy of Feasibility Report and the District Survey Report;
 - iii. For all other projects - In the prescribed **Form-2** enclosed with this OM along with copy of EIA/EMP report as per the generic structure given at Appendix-III of the EIA Notification, 2006. Step-1:

The project proponent of Mining Project shall submit the information on the following:

1. The Project Proponent shall give an undertaking by way of **affidavit** to comply with all the statutory requirements and judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated the 2nd August 2017 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 114 of 2014 in the matter of Common Cause versus Union of India and Ors. before grant of ToR/ EC. The undertaking inter-alia include commitment of the PP not to repeat any such violation in future. In case of violation of above undertaking, the ToR/Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be terminated forthwith.
2. The details of mining operations in violation of the following :
 - a. without Environmental Clearance (EC), or in excess of the quantity approved in EC,
 - b. without Consent to Operate (CTO) or in excess of the quantity approved in CTO and
 - c. without Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining or in excess of the quantity approved in Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining.
 - d. without Forest Clearance.
 - e. Any other violation.
3. The details of credible action initiated (if any) and penalty amount paid to the Hon'ble District Courts. (Calendar Case details).
4. Details of the legal cases against the Mining Project (Name of the Court, Case No. & Order/direction of the court, if any and its relevance with the mining project).
5. Details of past production of mine since its inception duly authenticated by Department of Mines & Geology, Govt. of A.P.
6. To submit the KML/Shape Files of the mine lease area at the time of presentation before SEAC.

Step-2:

1. Category - B1 Projects: The SEAC, A.P., will appraise the mining project proposal and recommend for the appropriate TOR (Terms of Reference) with public hearing and additional Specific Terms of Reference (STR).
2. Category - B2 Projects: The SEAC, A.P., will appraise the mining project proposal and recommend for the Specific Terms of Reference (STR) without public hearing in addition to the EMP. **This is subject to clarification to be obtained from MoEF&CC, GoI, New Delhi.**

Step-3:

1. **Category -B1&B2 Projects : Assessment of ecological damage** with respect to air, water, land and other environmental attributes. The collection and analysis of data shall be done by an environmental laboratory duly notified under the Environment



(Protection) Act, 1986, or an environmental laboratory accredited by NABL, or a laboratory of a Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) institution working in the field of environment.

2. Preparation of EMP comprising remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan corresponding to the ecological damage assessed and economic benefits derived due to violation.
3. The remediation plan and the natural and community resource augmentation plan to be prepared as an independent chapter in the EIA report **by the accredited consultants.**
4. **Category -B1 Projects :** The project proponent shall submit the **final EIA report** along with the remediation plan and the natural and community resource augmentation plan.
5. **Category - B2 Projects :** The project proponent shall submit the **EMP report** along with the remediation plan and the natural and community resource augmentation plan.

Step-4:

1. The SEAC, A.P., will appraise the final EIA report/ EMP report and recommend the quantum of the Bank Guarantee for the compliance of the remediation plan and the natural and community resource augmentation plan. The same will be finalised by the regulatory authority - SEIAA, A.P.

Step-5:

1. The Project Proponent shall submit the Bank Guarantee to the amount of remediation plan and Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan with the State Pollution Control Board.
2. The bank guarantee shall be released after successful implementation of the EMP, followed by recommendations of the SEAC and approval of the regulatory authority.

Step-6:

The SEAC,A.P., will recommend for the issue of Environmental Clearance (EC) / Terms of Reference (TOR) duly stipulation the conditions imposed by MoEF&CC Office Memorandum dated 30.05.2018 in addition to other conditions in the EC/TOR.,to the Project Proponents in violation cases.



Annexure-III

Check list for violation cases:

- The details of the Mine lease granted/ In-principle letter issued by the competent authority of Mines & Geology Dept. Govt. of A.P.
- Mining Plan approved by the competent authority of Mines & Geology Dept. Govt. of A.P.

The undertaking inter alia include commitment of the PP not to repeat any such violation in future. In case of violation of above undertaking, the ToR/Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be terminated forthwith.
- The project proponent shall be required to submit a **bank guarantee** equivalent to the amount of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan with the SPCB prior to the grant of EC. The quantum shall be recommended by the SEAC and finalized by the regulatory authority. The bank guarantee shall be released after successful implementation of the EMP, followed by recommendations of the SEAC and approval of the regulatory authority.
- The details of the action initiated against the project proponent under the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and further no consent to operate or occupancy certificate to be issued till the project is granted Environmental Clearance.
- The project proponent shall be liable to pay the compensation against the illegal mining, if any, and as raised by the State Government at any point of time, in terms of the orders dated 2nd August, 2017 of Hon'ble Supreme Court.



- Other conditions, which could be in conformity with the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court and/or regulations/guidelines issued by the Ministry to deal with such cases, may also be stipulated at the ToR stage itself.
- Compliance of the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 02.08.2017 in the Writ Petition (Civil) No. 114 of 2014 in the matter of Common Cause versus Union of India and Ors.
- Validity of LOI/mine lease along with the documentary proof.
- Details of past production of mine since its inception duly authenticated by Department of Mines & Geology, State Government.
- To submit the KML/Shape Files of the mine lease area at the time of presentation before SEAC.
- Certified cluster certificate from Director of Mines and Geology.
- In compliance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the project proponent required to first approach the Mines and Geology Department of the State Government for certification regarding payment of 100% cost of illegally mined mineral to the State Government in terms of the section 21(5) of the MMDR Act, 1957. The amount so payable to the State Government for the ore/mineral, would inter-alia, account for the mining operations in violation of the following :-
 - without Environmental Clearance (EC), or in excess of the quantity approved in EC,
 - without Consent to Operate (CTO) or in excess of the quantity approved in CTO and
 - without Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining or in excess of the quantity approved in Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining.
 - without Forest Clearance.
 - Any other violation.
