## Minutes of the 70th Meeting of State level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Jharkhand, held on 10th April, 2019.

The 70th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) was convened on 10/04/2019 in the office of SEIAA, Ranchi. The meeting was chaired by Shri S.E.H. Kazmi, Chairman, SEIAA, Jharkhand. The attendance in the meeting was as follows:-

## The decisions taken in the 70th SEIAA meeting are as follows:-

- 1. Discussion on matter related to 69th meeting of SEAC held on 1st, 2nd and 3rd April, 2019.
  - DSR related matter- Regarding..

The authority examined the recommendations made by SEAC. SEAC is aware that above matter was discussed in 68th meeting of SEIAA held on 19th & 23rd March, 2019 and Authority vide letter no. 145 dated 04.04.2019 has requested to Secretary Mines and Geology Govt. of Jharkhand to provide the DSR of all district of Jharkhand to SEAC as per the norms laid down by the MoEF & CC and copy of the same has already been provided to SEAC.

Hence after full deliberations it is decided that it was not feasible to reconsider the executed work. SEAC is also requested that project related to minor minerals be appraised in the light of Hon'ble NGT order dated 13.09.2018 and MoEF & CC, OM F No. L-11011/175/2018-IA-II(M), dated 12.12.2018. This decision had already been taken earlier in 65th meeting of SEIAA held on 7th January, 2019.

Bankuchia Stone Deposit of M/s K.K. Builders Pvt. Ltd. at Vill. : Bankuchia, Patamda, East Singhbhum (11.74 Ha), Jharkhand.

The authority examined the recommendations made by SEAC and after full deliberations it was decided unanimously that SEAC is requested to appraise the above proposal in the light of Hon'ble NGT order dated 13.09.2018 and MoEF & CC, OM F No. L-11011/175/2018-IA-II(M), dated 12.12.2018.

During perusal of certificate issued by DFO, Jamshedpur Forest Division, vide memo no. 3925 dated 19.11.2015 and memo no. 3505 dated 21.08.2017, it was found that the two different distance from forest land has been mentioned i.e. 250 mtrs. and 255 mtrs.

Hence it is advisable to have a field verification by the SEAC to ascertain distance of the proposed site from notified forest land. It is also advisable

that distance from Dalma Wild Life Century or ESZ can be clarified by DCF& FD Elephant project, Jamshedpur.

- 2. SEIAA considered the recommendations made by SEAC in its 69th meeting held on 1st, 2nd and 3rd April, 2019 for delist of the following project :-
  - Nadbelwa Sand Mining Project on Sukri River of Sri Bali Yadav at Vill. -Nadbelwa, Manika, Latehar (13.05 Ha), Jharkhand.

The Authority examined the recommendations made by SEAC in above matter and after full deliberations it was decided unanimously to accept the recommendations made by SEAC in this regard and delist the above proposal.
