

## Minutes of the 75<sup>th</sup> meeting of State level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Jharkhand held on 04<sup>th</sup> July, 2019.

The 75<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) was convened on 04/07/2019 in the office of SEIAA, Ranchi. The meeting was chaired by Shri S.E.H. Kazmi, Chairman, SEIAA, Jharkhand. The attendance in the meeting was as follows:-

1. Shri S.E.H. Kazmi, Chairman, SEIAA, Jharkhand, Ranchi.

The decisions taken in the 75<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting are as follows:-

1. Discussion on matter related to 72<sup>nd</sup> meeting of SEAC held on 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2019:-

- i. Letter dated 05.04.19 of Shri Niraj Kumar, Computer Operator, SEAC regarding enhancement of salary / equal pay for equal work / appointment of Accountant – cum – Assistant for Permanent / Contractual basis.

The work of SEAC is assigned by MoEF & CC vide GOI notification no. S.O.-1533(E) dated 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2006 which is as follows:-

- a) Screening
- b) Scoping
- c) Appraisal

Creations of secretariat for SEIAA has been assigned to Govt. of Jharkhand vide GOI notification no. S.O. 3010(E) dated 27.12.2012 and S.O. 3415(E) dated 09.11.2016 by stating “The Govt. of Jharkhand shall notify and agency to act as secretariat for the authority, Jharkhand and the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee, Jharkhand and shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facilities in respect of all its statutory functions”. The proposal for the same has been sent to Department of Forest, Environment and Climate Change, Govt. of Jharkhand vide SEIAA’s letter no. 28, dated 17.01.2019 and reminder for the same has been sent to Govt. of Jharkhand vide letter no. 245, dated 03.06.2019.

- ii. Regarding review of EC granted earlier, without getting proper clearance from NBWL / SBWL. (40 projects, list attached as annexure-I)

The Authority considered the recommendation made by SEAC in letter and spirit as well as records available in the file and it was observed that;

- i. In 28 cases (sl. no. 1, 2, 5-10, 12, 16, 17, 20-26, 28-37) out of 40 cases, the information related to the distance from **protected** area is **not** available in the **respective** file.
- ii. In 3 cases (sl. no. 13, 14 & 15) out of 40 cases, the **information** related to the distance of the project from the boundary of protected area is available. As per availability of the report in file, these are situated at more than 10 km distance.
- iii. In 9 cases (sl. no. 3, 4, 11, 18, 19, 27, 38, 39 & 40) the certificate **indicates** that these project proposal **lies** within the distance of **10 km** of protected area. It was decided that PP shall obtain a certificate from concerned Wild Life DFO and submit it to SEAC by stating whether the said area is coming under ESZ or not within 30 days from the date of issual of notice of SEAC.

The Authority also **considered** the **fact** mentioned in the **SEAC** recommendation that **9 project** proponent have submitted the compliance in accordance with the **direction** issued by **MS, SEAC** vide letter no. **60 to 99** dated **24.04.2019** and prayer has been made which are as under.

- i. 7 project proponent (sl. no. 20, 21, 23-27) out of 9 have **requested** to **grant** him time to submit the **requisite** documents as sought by **SEAC**.
- ii. 2 project proponent (sl. no. 38, 39) have **submitted** the **acknowledgment** receipt which **shows** that they have **applied** for **clearance** from **NBWL / SBWL**.

Based on the fact mentioned above, after full deliberations it was unanimously decided that SEAC, Jharkhand may reconsider the matter related to NBWL / SBWL clearance on following ground and forward their recommendation.

- i. SEAC is requested that information related to the protected area/ ESZ in all cases should be obtained from concerned Wild Life DFO.

Hence, 40 project related to minor minerals should be transferred to SEAC, Jharkhand for appropriate action in the light of above observation.

2. **SEIAA considered the recommendations made by SEAC in its 72<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 for grant of Environmental Clearance to the following projects.**

- i. Kajra Stone Mine of M/s Vinod Kumar Jain (Partner: Sri Mukesh Kumar Jain and others) at Vill. Kajra, Kamdara, Gumla (2.02 Ha).
- ii. Kumhari Stone Mine of M/s Vinod Kumar Jain (Partner: Sri Mukesh Kumar Jain and others) at Vill. Kumhari, Basia, Gumla (2.02 Ha).



It was decided to grant Environmental Clearance to the above mentioned project proposals with the conditions recommended by SEAC.

3. SEIAA considered the recommendations made by SEAC in its 73<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 for grant of Environmental Clearance to the following projects.

- i. Abhishek Anand Stone Mines of M/s Abhishek Anand at Vill. : Mahuari, P.S. : Naudiha Bazar, Dist. : Palamua (2.36 ha).
- ii. Abhishek Anand Stone Mines of M/s Abhishek Anand at Vill. : Mahuari, P.S. : Naudiha Bazar, Dist. : Palamua (2.33 ha).

It was decided to grant Environmental Clearance to the above mentioned project proposals with the conditions recommended by SEAC.

4. SEIAA considered the recommendations made by SEAC in its 73<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 for grant of ToR to the following project.

- i. LPG Bottling Plant of M/s Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. at Vill.-Konra, Tehsil : Barhi, Dist. : Hazaribagh.

It was decided to grant ToR to the above mentioned project proposal with the conditions recommended by SEAC.

5. Decision on matter related to:-

- i. **DSR related matter- Regarding.**

SEIAA vide its 71<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 has sought the legal opinion from retainer on the issue of DSR.

The said legal opinion have been submitted by the Advocate Shri Bhanu Kumar, Jharkhand High Court. Hence after full deliberations it was unanimously decided that legal opinion as submitted by the Advocate should be forwarded to SEAC for appropriate action.

- ii. **Kawabar Stone Mine Project of Sri Binod Kumar, Vill. :Kawabar, Dist. :Koderma (0.81 Ha).**

SEIAA vide its 71<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 has sought the legal opinion for of issual of ToR or EC whether the present distance criteria from forest (RF/PF) can be implemented with retrospective effect.

The said legal opinion have been submitted by the Advocate Shri Bhanu Kumar, Jharkhand High Court, whereby he has suggested that present distance criteria from forest can not operated with retrospective effect.

Hence after full deliberations it was unanimously decided that legal opinion and above project file should be forward to SEAC for appropriate action.

- iii. **Hon'ble NGT order dated – 29.04.2019 in O.A. No. – 837/2018 Sandeep Mittal Vs Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change & Ors. regarding.**

SEIAA in its 71<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 sought the legal opinion on above order of Hon'ble NGT that in which way the above orders affects SEIAA and what action is required from the SEIAA, Jharkhand?

The said legal opinion have been submitted by the Advocate Shri Bhanu Kumar, Jharkhand High Court, whereby he has suggested that SEIAA, Jharkhand ~~was~~ not been impleaded as party before Hon'ble NGT in the aforesaid case. Therefore, at present no specific action is required on part of SEIAA. However, he has advised to circulate a copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble NGT to JSPCB and Department of Forest, Environment and Climate Change, Govt. of Jharkhand and to other stake holders so that necessary and effective steps may be taken for developing a mechanism for monitoring and compliance of projects.

Hence, after full deliberations it was unanimously decided to forward the copy of above order of Hon'ble NGT to JSPCB, MoEF & CC, Regional Office and Department of Forest, Environment and Climate Change, Govt. of Jharkhand for the same.

- iv. **Decision on Scrutiny Fee with regard to violation cases.**

In the SEIAA, Jharkhand a total of 84 project proposals are applied **under violation** of E(P) Act 1986, out of which 42 project proposals (list attached as **annexure-II**) were applied **later** in this office but in the **light** of Hon'ble NGT order dated **07.07.2015** Environmental Clearance **could not** be issued in favour of these cases.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide S.O. 804(E), dated 14.03.2017 has decided to proceed or grant of EC/ToR to the projects related to violation of E (P) Act, 1986 at the central level.

In view of instruction given by Govt. of India through aforementioned notification, the SEIAA, Jharkhand had issued a notice through which all the applicants were informed to submit the application to the central level within the stipulated time frame.

Subsequently, the power of execution of the violation case of E (P) Act, 1986 is again assigned to SEIAA's by MoEF & CC vide S.O. 1030(E) dated 08.03.2018 and the instructions were issued to provide a window period till 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. Thus, the pending applications at the GOI level and new application were submitted or transferred to this office.



In these 42 cases, EC or ToR could not be issued in the light of Hon'ble NGT order dated 07<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 and these cases ~~is~~ again applied for the sake of same hence after full deliberations it was unanimously decided that scrutiny fee of these cases will not be charged for appraisal.

- v. **(a) Dangawar (b) Ranideva (c) Dewarikala (d) Badepur (e) Birdhwar & Kolhua Sand Mining Project of Sri Upendra Singh, Dist. Palamu.**

In pursuance of direction given by SEIAA, a written reply was received by giving duly notice to District Mining Officer, Palamu and project proponent Sri Upendra Singh. The report was put up before SEIAA, which was considered in the meeting and it is being unanimously decided that PP has excavated more sand than the capacity prescribed in Environmental Clearance, which <sup>has</sup> also been confirmed by the project proponent himself.. So far as transport permit relating to production beyond the prescribed capacity is concerned, it is being regulated by concerned DMO's office. The provisions of approved mine plan were not complied properly and the information regarding extraction of mineral was not compiled properly and not acted upon as per provisions of granted Environmental Clearance. The information of this effect should be sent to the Director, Mines, Govt. of Jharkhand so that they would take appropriate action after verifying these points at the level of the department.

Hence, it was unanimously decided that related Environmental Clearance must be cancelled with immediate effect and project proponent as well as the concerned Department should be informed accordingly.
