INSTRUCTION FOR PROPONENTS

1. The Project Proponents are requested to circulate the documents related to their project proposal to the Chairman and Members of the SEAC, Odisha
2. Please indicate the item number of the Agenda while circulating the documents to the Members of the Committee.
3. The material circulated including presentation material should not deviate from the documents already submitted to the SEIAA, Odisha for consideration of project.
4. Presentations for ToR should be brief, precise and supported by topo-sheet. All important features such as National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuary, Mangroves, Biosphere Reserves, Heritage sites, Reserve Forests, Rivers, water Bodies, Highways, Railway line, Habitations etc. should be clearly indicated in an area of 10 km radius of the proposed site.
5. All cases for EC for industrial projects such as power plant, steel plant etc will be considered subject to confirmation of raw-material, *fuel, water linkage and effluent treatment schemes (along with copies of Agreements / MoUs)* as may be applicable. Copies of linkages shall be submitted and also distributed to the Members along with the required documents.
6. For Environmental Clearance the project proponents are advised to give their presentation starting with compliance with the provisions of ToR issued for the project under consideration.
7. In accordance with the circular No. J-11011/618/2010-IA.II (I) dated 30.05.2012 of MoEF, Govt. of India, in case of expansion project for which environmental clearance was issued earlier, the project proponent shall submit a certified report of the status of compliance of the conditions stipulated in the environment clearance for the ongoing / existing operations of the project by the Regional Offices of Ministry of Environment & Forests. The status of compliance of the conditions stipulated in the Environmental Clearance as highlighted in the report (s) will be discussed by the SEAC during appraisal of the project.
8. In case of building and construction project, a consolidated to the scale map showing details of structure like buildings, set back area / open space free from all activities, drainage pattern, parking, plantation and landscaping, garbage collection, rain water harvesting structure, STP and other facilities if any shall be circulated to all the members of the SEAC, Odisha along with the required documents.
