	<p>The Proponent, M/s, Casa Grande Private Limited has applied for Environmental Clearance for the proposed construction of Residential Building with built up area of 42208.213 Sq.m at S.F.No: 15/1, 2, 16/2, 3, 17/3B of Varadharajapuram Village, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamilnadu on 03.10.2017.</p> <p>The proposal was placed in the 95<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06.10.2017. Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of EC to SEIAA, subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the normal conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The source of water is ground water/ Kundrathur Panchayat Union. The proponent should ensure that the water supplied conforms to the prescribed standards.</li><li>2. It is informed that excess treated sewage of 128 KLD will be used for irrigation of agricultural land nearby. The proponent should finalize alternate sustainable and environment friendly methods for the management of excess treated sewage in the event of problem being faced regarding utilization for agriculture.</li><li>3. Regarding CSR activities, the proponent should concentrate more on infrastructure facilities useful to the local community. They should include skill development and sports as some of the activities in this</li></ol>

regard. The proponent should conduct youth development programmes for the local community. More specifically, contributions need not be made to Adyar river maintenance fund to CRRT as they are not accepting such contributions.

4. The proponent should ensure that the Green Belt development proposed should be as per standard norms in terms of area, number of trees and the species adopted. Species like Neem, Poovarasu, Magilam, Arasu, Pungan, Naval, Marudhu and Illuppai may be planted. Exotics may be avoided.
