




The units in the park make garments and there are no use of chemicals and generation of effluents except for generation of sewage from the water used by the employees which are about 7000 within the park and from laundry operation. As far as solid waste is concerned, there is only one source i.e cloth cutting which produces 2.45 TPD which is sent for reuse in member units.

Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the committee decided to recommended the proposal to SEIAA for grant of Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the normal conditions:

1. It is proposed to use 310 KLD comprising treated sewage and treated effluent for avenue plantation. The proponent informed that 11000 trees already exists in the Kolappalur panchayat which will get the benefit of the irrigation. However, the proponent should produce agreement documents with the concerned panchayat and also give an undertaking to the effect that it is his responsibility to ensure safe transport of the effluent to the avenue plantation area without causing any pollution surrounding the textile park.
2. Regarding CSR activities, the proponent should concentrate more on infrastructure facilities useful to the local community. They should include skill development and sports as some of the activities in this regard. The proponent should conduct youth

	<p>development programmes for the local community.</p> <p>3. Total plot area is 32.12 ha (79.33 acres) out of which 15% of the area should be allocated for green belt development. Whereas the proponent has allocated 2.52 ha only which is inadequate. Hence, the proponent is instructed to allocate 4.818 ha covering all sides of the project area. Species like Neem, Poovarasu, Magilam, Arasu, Pungan, Naval, Marudhu and Illuppai may be planted. Exotics may be avoided.</p>
