In exercise of the powers delegated to the undersigned by the Central Pollution Control Board vide Notification No. B-12015/7/92. Published in the Gazette of India NO. 746 dated 26/11/1992 and Administration order No. 45/1(1)/92-F&E/700 dated 8/2/1993, the Consent is hereby granted under Section 25, Sub-section (1) & (2) of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988, to **ESTABLISH** the industry at the above mentioned address subject to the following terms and conditions:-

PRODUCTS: Plasticizers viz DOP/DBP/DEH/DM/DOA/DIOP/DIHP - 10,000 M.T./year
(No other item).

CONDITIONS:
 The consent is valid upto **31/08/1997.**

2) The maximum daily discharge of effluent shall not exceed to the following:

SR. NO.	TYPE OF EFFLUENT	MAXIMUM DAILY DISCHARGE
1.	Domestic	1000 ltrs/day.
2.	Industrial	Nil.

3) The treatment facilities must be provided for the treatment of domestic and industrial effluent before commissioning of the industry so that the treated effluent quality must be capable of achieving the following limits:-

SR. NO.	PARAMETERS	LMITS
1.	pH	65-9.0
2.	BOD 5 20 C	Not to exceed 100 mg/l. mg/l.
3.	Suspended Solids	Not to exceed 100 mg/l. mg/l.
4.	Oil and Grease	Not to exceed 10 mg/l.
5.	Sulphates.	Not to exceed 1000 mg/l.

4) If at any time it is observed that effluent fails to conform to the limits prescribed, consent will be withdrawn prohibiting the industry to manufacture either existing or new products.

5) The industry shall comply with general conditions of Consent on the reverse.

6) The applicant shall submit separate application for obtaining Consent for operation/renewal under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 before 30 days of expiry of validity period of Consent.

7) The industry shall comply with Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1977 and submit monthly Cess Returns as contemplated in the Act, in the prescribed form.

8) **The applicant is required to treat the wastewater with best available technology so as to meet the above standards.**

9) **The applicant is required to submit a report regarding the adequacy of Effluent Treatment Plant from I.I.T. or any other recognised institute at the time of applying for consent to operate.**

10) **The applicant shall recycle the treated waste water after achieving the above standards and no seepage outside the premises shall be seen.**

11) **All the solid waste generated shall be collected and disposed off properly so as not to cause any soil pollution, surface/sub-surface water pollution directly or indirectly.**

12) **Utmost care shall be taken by the applicant to see that there shall be no**

SPILLAGE AND LEAKAGES OF any raw material and products.
13) Any upset condition in any of the plants of the factory which is likely to have the discharge/emission shall be reported to this office.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR CONSENT-TO DISCHARGE TRADE EFFLUENT

- 1) The storage and handling of all chemicals shall be in accordance with Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules, 1989. Special emphasis should be given on housekeeping to ensure that spillage or leakages do not occur.
- 2) The treated domestic effluents shall be discharged through soak pit percolation underground strata. Separate conduct system shall be provided for collecting industrial (Process, cooling, bleed water, floor and equipment washing, etc.) and domestic effluents. Terminal holes shall be provided at the end of each collection of treatment system with arrangement for the measurement of flow and for taking samples; storm water, drains shall be kept separate from the domestic/industrial effluent.
- 3) Any upset condition on any of the plant/plants for the factory which is likely to result in increased effluent discharge and/or result in violation of standard mentioned in condition No. 3 of consent order shall be reported to the Committee under intimation to the Director of Industries of Daman, Diu and Dadra and Nagar Haveli.
- 4) Utmost care will be taken by applicant to see that there shall be no spillage and leakages of any raw materials and products in all premises will be cement concrete with proper discharge outside the premises.
- 5) The applicant shall maintain good housekeeping both within the factory and in the premises, all pipes, valves, sewers and drains shall be leakproof. Floor washing shall not be allowed to find their way in storm water drains or open areas, subject to their conditions. Industry would ensure proper checking and stopping of any leakages/spilling etc. It would also ensure any nuisance or fugitive emissions are not generated in the process.
- 6) The applicant shall provide facilities for collection of samples by the Committee, staff or by any agency authorised by the Committee at terminal mainholes and terminal outlet.
- 7) The applicant/Company shall comply with and carry out directions/orders issued by the Committee, this consent order and at all subsequent times without any negligence on his/its part. The applicant/Company shall be liable for such legal action against him as per provisions of the Law/Act in case of disobedience of any order/directives issued any time and/or violation of the terms and conditions of this consent order.
- 8) The application shall not change or alter the quality/quantity, the rate of discharge, the temperature of the effluent and also the point of final outlet without the prior written permission from the Committee.
- 9) The treated effluent shall be recycled back or will be used for gardening and no effluent shall be allowed to discharge outside the premises.
- 10) The solid waste collected in the factory premises shall be disposed off scientifically to the satisfaction of the Committee so as not to cause any Air or Water Pollution problem. All solid wastes arising in the factory premises shall be properly graded and disposed off by:
 - (a) Land fill, in case of inert material. Care being taken to ensure that the material does not give rise to leakage which may percolate in ground water or carried away with storm run off.
 - (b) Controlled incineration, whenever possible in case of combustible organic material.
 - (c) Composting, in case of bio-degradable material.
- 11) Any toxic material shall be detoxification if possible, otherwise shall be sealed in steel drums and buried in protected areas after obtaining approval of this Committee in writing. The process of detoxification or sealing or burying shall be carried out in the presence of Committee's authorized person only.
- 12) An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Committee's officers during their visit to the factory.
- 13) The applicant shall furnish the visiting officers and/or the Committee any information regarding the construction, installation or operation of the establishment of Pollution Control System and such other particulars as be pertinent to preventing and controlling Pollution.
- 14) The industry would have to bear the expenditure as any by apportioned for the purpose of providing common treatment plants in the areas to treat the effluent to such a level as may be required.
- 15) Industry should be established in industrial zone/land only. If the industry is established in gasas, it should be on the ground floor only.
- 16) Notwithstanding anything contained in this conditional letter of Consent, Pollution Control Committee hereby reserves to itself right and power under Section 27 (2) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, to review any/all conditions imposed herein and to make such variation as deemed fit for the purpose of this Act by the Central Board.
- 17) The conditions imposed on above shall continue to enforce until revoked under Section 27 (2) of the Act.
- 18) The industry shall plant minimum 3 varieties of trees like Kanera, Jamun, Babul at a density of 1000 trees per acre over and above bulk plantation of trees in the area.
- 19) The above general conditions may be notified by the Administration from time to time and copies of such modified conditions will be communicated to the parties concerned by registered post.
- 20) **The applicant shall required to obtain consent under Air Act.**
- 21) **The applicant is required to submit a copy of S.S.I. registration at the time of applying for consent to operate.**
