Of India dated 8th August 2019, the project Proponent is required to furnish the clearance certificate from Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife (SCMBWL) for the establishment of proposed cement plant located within the 10 km. of the National Park/Wildlife Sanctuary before formal Environmental Clearance is issued in his favour. Accordingly the Project Proponent of the said Clarence is issued in his favour.

During the meeting of Expert Appraisal Committee it was found that distance between above two Mining blocks was much less then minimum 500 Mtrs. Accordingly the JKEAC rejected both the cases for Grant of Environmental Clarence under B-2 category on the ground that both the mining blocks formed cluster and the Project Proponents need to apply afresh under B1 category, prepare a joint EIA/EMP report and undergo public hearing and other formalities required for environmental clearance under B1 category.

The JKEAC recommended issuance of Standard Terms of Reference combined with some additional specific terms of reference as listed in the Minutes of the meeting of JKEAC held on 20-01-2020 for preparation of EIA/EMP report.
