	<p>Recommendations of the SEAC on 08.01.2019</p> <p>In the context of latest development consequent to the issue of judgment of Honorable NGT dated 11.12.2018, and MoEF&CC's OM No. F.No. L-11011/175/2018-IA-II(M) dated 12-12-2018, the SEAC had a detailed discussion on the guidelines to be followed hitherto in dealing with the cases of mine lease area upto 25ha.</p> <p>As the judgment of the Honorable NGT dated 11.12.2018 states "we also make it clear that till a fresh Notification is issued by the MoEF &CC, Notification dated 15.01.2016 will not be acted upon", it is resolved to follow the guidelines of S.O.1533, dated 14.09.2006 (EIA Notification 2006) along with the amendments prescribed in the MOEF&CC Notifications S.O. 2269(E), dated 01.07.2016 and S.O3977 (E), dated 14.08.2018. to decide/define the mine areas under cluster formation which are as follows:*</p> <p>"The leases not operative for 3 years or more and the leases which have got Environmental Clearance as on 15-01-2016 shall not be counted for calculating the area of the cluster. But these areas shall be included in EMP and Regional EMP."</p> <p>Hence, the SEAC recommends the above said guidelines for calculating the area of the cluster.</p> <p>It is further resolved that hereafter, the mining of major and minor minerals with an area less than or equal to 5 ha will be appraised by SEAC/SEIAA.</p> <p>*(para 5 of the MOEF&CC Notifications S.O. 2269(E), dated 1.7.2016).</p> <p>Decision of SEIAA: Legal opinion may be obtained from standing council of APPCB with respect to the above mentioned MoEF Notifications.
